

-- ARCHER --

The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

John Archer was Lord Proprietor of the Manor of Fordham. In 1654 he accompanied the early settlers from Fairfield, CT to Westchester Co.

He was a prominent shipping merchant, owning ships that plied between New York and England.²

Elsewhere, he is said to have emigrated from Holland to Virginia in 1656 and to have had a brief career there as a tobacco merchant. He soon removed to New Netherland where he was found in New Amsterdam and at Oost-dorp or the town of West Chester. Here he acquired his manorial estate, the patent for the Manor of Fordham being granted to John Archer by Gov. Lovelace in 1671.¹

A mortgage given by John Archer to Cornelius Steenwyck, of New York, in 1676, gave him full title and possession of the Manor of Fordham, which passed under his will and by certain deeds, to the Dutch church of NY.

John Archer (Jr.) was the second, and final, Lord of Fordham Manor.

Liber A, Westchester Co. Land Records, p. 120: License to marry. John Archer and Sarah Odell, granted Oct. 7, 1686. Certificate of marriage of John Archer of the Manor of Fordham, and Sarah Odell of the same place, Dec -- 1686, by John Palmer, Justice.¹

John Archer was born in Westchester County about 1660, the son of John Archer & Catherina Carle. His father was Lord of the manor of Fordham, but the Manor was mortgaged [to Cornelius Steenwyck, who in in will turned it over] to the Netherlands Dutch Reformed Church in New York. After the death of his father, that church took over and control of the land, where now Fordham University is situated, was lost to the Archer family.²

[Liber A, Westchester Co. Land Records, p. 45] John Archer of the Manor of Fordham, yeoman, to Margareta Stenwyck of the City of New York, widow, land in Forham, Oct 16, 1696. An indenture of mortgage to sd premises, bearing date the 24th of Nov., 1676, made by John Archer, dec'd, father to the sd John Archer, to Cornelius Stein wick of the City of New York, late husband of the sd. Margaret Steenwyck.¹ 17 Oct 1686, Margaret Stenwyck of the City of New York, widow, to John Archer of the Manor of Fordham, a home lot in Fordham now in the possession of the sd. John Archer.¹

John was apprenticed to Hartman Wessels, a surgeon, on February 1, 1677. He married first, Margarita Steenwick. They had no children. She must have died about 1686, because in December of that year, he married Sarah Odell, daughter of William Odell. They had seven children. Sarah must have died before 1715, because in that year, John married Mary Fowler, daughter of Henry Fowler. They had one daughter, and John died before 1718, when his widow married Samuel Drake.²

They were listed in the 1698 census of Inhabitants of Fordham and Adjacent Places: John Archer and his wife Sarah and five children: Benjamin, Jonathan, cathrin, mary, mary church.³

John Archer was elected, in 1703, a vestryman for the precinct of Yonkers.

The following advertisement may concern some of this John Archer's descendants. Advertised in *The New-York Mercury* [NYC], 03-16-1761, p. 1 (supplement) -- "To be Let on Ground Rent -- For the term of Twenty one Years. four :ots of Ground, belonging to the Consistory of the Dutch Church, situate in Dutch-Street, leading from John Street, to Fair Street, being nigh the Moravian Church; each Lot having a Tenement on it, which Tenements will be sold to the Person, or Persons, leeing the said Lots. For further particulars Enquire of John De Peyster, Junior, And on Wednesday the 25th of March inst., will be sold at publick Vensure, by the said Consistory, at the House of Johannis Vermillje, near the New Bridge, across Harlem River, the following Lands, lying in the Manor of Fordham, viz. Lot No. 1. Now in the possession of Benjamin Archer, containing, of cleared and Wood Lands, about 180 Acres. Lot No. 13. Now in the possession of Michael Odel, containing of cleared and Wood Lands, about 120 Acres. Lot No. D. Now in the possession of [blank] Valentine, containing, of cleared and Wood Lands, between 70 and 80 Acres; this Lot lies between Jacob Lent's Land and Bronk's River.
