The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

In the (2) marriage record, he was a widower from Fishkill; she was from Gravesend.

In his will, he wrote: March 16, 1754. I, Abraham Adrianse, of Rombouts Precinct, Dutchess County, being well in health. I leave to my eldest son, Rem Adrianse, for his birthright, £50. I leave to my wife Femitye "all she brought to me, the cubbor and linnen, and bed and furniture, and other things which she brought, though not distinct mentioned." I leave to my son John £30. "It is supposed that my wife is with Child, though not being certain, and how it is the Lord knoweth, and the children that she hath by me none of them shall be deprived of being an heir." After paying all debts, I order a piece of land to be sold that lyeth joining the farm of Jacob Fetswout on the north, and Joris Adrianse on the east and south, and west by Catharine Brett. I leave to my wife the use of the rest of my lands, houses, and goods, so long as she remains my widow. After the death or marriage of my wife, I leave all my estate to my daughter Femitye and my son Rem, the children of my first wife, and my son John, "being a child of this wife," "and the rest of the children she hath by me shall be heirs, though no names can be mentioned." If all my children die under age, then my wife is to have 1/2, and the other half to my brothers (not named). I make my wife and my brother Elbert, and Joris Adrianse, executors. Witnesses, Henry Wiltse, Johannes Wiltse, Jacob Wiltse. Proved, December 28, 1765, before Johannes Terbos, Judge of Common Pleas, and Capt. Cornelius Luister and James Dunken Justices. Confirmed by Sir Henry Moore, Governor, May 29, 1766.

In his will, he wrote: August 1, 1758. I, Joris Adriance, of Rumbout Precinct, in Dutchess County, yeoman, being sick. All debts and funeral charges to be paid by executors. I leave to my eldest son Elbert £30, and my Great Dutch Bible, the Psalm Book of his mother, and his mother's gold buttons for his birth right, in full of all claim as heir at law. I leave to my wife Phebe my cupboard and 20, Also a bond of Samuel Thompson and Samuel Thompson, Jr., payable May 1, 1759, and such an amount of goods and apparell as will equal her outset, "and she is to have a trundle bed and furniture for the use of the children," "and the use of my farm and movables for 1 year to see whether it will answer, and if it shall not answer, then my farm and lands to be sold to the best advantage at publick vendue." When my son Elbert is 21 years old he shall call the executors to account, and the money is to be divided among my children, Elbert, Cornelius, Joris, Sarah, and Theodorus, "And if my wife Phebe shall bair another son or daughter after my decease, as is lickle by the hand of Providence, it shall have an equal share." I make my brothers, Abraham and Isaac Adriance, and my brother in law, Cornelius Van Wyck, executors. Witnesses, Paulus Vandervoort, Gerrit Storm, Isaac Lent. Proved in Court of Common Pleas, before Matthew Dubois, Judge, and Johanes De Witt and John Bayly, Justices of the Peace, October 10, 1758.

He was still living in 1750. He emigrated on the "Roosenboom" (Rosetree) in 1663 with his parents, four sisters, and one brother. They settled first at Flatbush, second at Stuyvesant's Bouwerie, and then at Tappan, NY. Lambert, his brother, and father, were Tappan patentees, and in 1704 he acquired 248 acres near what is now Orangeburg, NY, and 648 acres in 1721.

Lambert and Margrietje were founders of the Tappan Church and he was its first Elder. In 1729 he was one of the five men who gave 97 acres of land to the Church. He took the Oath of Allegiance in 1687, and in 1704 served on a committee to examine the public accounts of the County.

Lambert Aertsen Van Thuyl by 1699 had assumed the name "Smit," probably from his occupation, or trade, of blacksmith.
