The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

On 6 August 1805 (recorded 9 September 1805, Bergen Co. V:342) Isaac Van Riper of the Township of Saddle River conveyed to Aurie Banta of the same place, for \$60, 1-50/100 acres more or less of woodland in the Township of Saddle River. Signed by Isaac Van Ryper. Witnessed by Rd. Outwater, Robert Glass.¹

On 21 August 1805 (recorded 10 September 1805, Bergen Co. V:339) George Banta of the Township of Saddle River and Elizabeth, his wife, conveyed to Aurie Banta of the same place, for \$60, 2 acres more or less in the Township of Saddle River, beginning E side of the Road leading from Christian A. Zabriskie's store to Slotterdam on the line of land of Doctor Alexander Rosegrant, bounded W by Passaic River at low water mark. Signed by George Banta (his mark), Elizabeth Banta. Witnessed by Alexander James, Stephen Hopper.¹

On 23 August 1805 (recorded 23 October 1805, Bergen Co. W:13) Alexander Rosegrant of the Township of Saddle River conveyed to Aury Banta of the same place, for \$140, 2 acres more or less in the Township of Saddle River beginning E side of road adjoining the River Passaic at SW side or lot of Cornelius Post Junior. Signed by Alexander Rosegrant. Witnessed by Richard Banta, Robt. Gavs.¹

On 7 September 1805 (recorded 9 September 1805, Bergen Co. V:333) Isaac Van Riper of Slotterdam in the Township of Saddle River conveyed to Aaron Banta of the same place, for \$200 each unto the other, whereas said Isaac Van Riper conveyed the house and lot whereon he now lives, to Mary, wife of said Aaron Banta, providing said Isaac Van Riper never begets heirs of his bodily issue, the use of Negro man named Joe and Negro woman named Poll, horses, wagon, plow, windmill, etc. Signed Isaac Van Ryper, Aaron Banta (his mark). Witnessed by George Banta (his mark), Abraham Willis.¹

On 7 September 1805 (recorded 9 September 1805, Bergen Co. V:336) Isaac Van Riper of Slotterdam, Township of Saddle River, conveyed to Mary Banta, wife of Aaron Banta of the same place, for \$1 and as per agreement of the parties of the second part to maintain said Isaac Van Riper during his life, 1-1/2 acres more or less, the house and lot he now lives in, in Slotterdam, late the property of Thomas Van Riper, deceased, beginning SW corner lot of said Aaron Banta at low water mark of Passaic River; mentioned line of Abraham Van Derbeck. Signed by Isaac Van Riper. Witnessed by George Banta (his mark), Abraham Willis.¹

On 11 October 1805 (recorded 9 November 1805, Bergen Co. W:101) John El. Vreeland and Yannaca, his wife, of Acquackanonk Township in the County of Essex, conveyed to John A. Post of Slotterdam in the Township of Saddle River, for \$310, 8-40/100 acres wood land in the Township of Saddle River, beginning at lot of Peter Terhune. Mentions conveyance from Isaac Van Ryper to said John El. Vreeland 30 August 1805. Bounded E by Peter Terhune; S by Jacob Hopper; W by Aurie Banta; N by said Jacob Hopper. Signed by John El. Vreeland, Jane Vreeland. Witnessed by Lewis Thibou, Abrm. Willis.¹

On 13 December 1805 (recorded 31 December 1805, Bergen Co. W:184) Isaac Van Riper of the Township of Saddle River conveyed to Mary Debaun, wife of Aurie Banta, for natural love and affection of his beloved friend, three horses, one wagon, slays, Plows, Fanning Mill, grain, household goods, etc. Signed Isaac Van Ryper. Witnessed by George Banta, Robert Glass.¹

On 16 December 1805 (recorded 29 December 1805, Bergen Co. X:14) Richard Banta of the Township of Saddle River, conveyed to Aaron Banta of the same place, for \$50, 2-1/2 acres strict measure in the Township of Saddle River, beginning at corner of lot of Aaron Banta, bought from Doct. Alexander Rosegrates. Signed by Richard I. Banta. Witnessed by Henry Lauback, John Outwater.¹

On 30 December 1805 (recorded 31 December 1805, Bergen Co. W:186) Isaac Van Ryper of the Township of Saddle River, conveyed to Mary Debaun, wife of Aurie Banta, for natural love and affection and for his better maintenance and support and livelihood, and \$1, about 4 acres more or less in the Township of Saddle River, between lands of Alexander James and William Van Lusden. Signed Isaac Van Ryper. Witnessed by Robert Glass, George Banta.¹

On 19 March 1806 (recorded 24 April 1806, Bergen Co. X:352) Charles Debaun and Mary, his wife, of the Township of Saddle River, conveyed to Aury Banta of the same place, for \$76.20, land in the Township of Saddle River, corner Henry Van Dalsem, Esquire; line of Jerry Van Riper. Bounded E by Henry Van Dalsem, Esquire; S by Cornelius Van Winkle; W by said Charles Debaun; N by Jerry Van Riper. Signed by Charles Debaun, Mary Debaun (her mark). Witnessed by Abrm. Willis, John A. Post.¹

Albert H. Banta was Freeholder of the township of Hackensack in 1772 and 1781. During the Revolutionary War he had property destroyed by the British, for which he received £634 in settlement from the U. S. Government.

He sold his farm at Schraalenburgh 5 June 1784 and moved to Kentucky, where he settled near Harrodsburg.

On 5 June 1784, Albert and Lena Banta, of Hackensack Precinct, conveyed to Jacob Demott, of the same place, for £500, line of Walter Briggs, James Duncan and Matthys Demott...sold to Hendrick Hendrickse Banta, father of said Albert Banta, by Walter Briggs, 21 October 1736 and willed to said Albert Banta 8 December 1758, and confirmed by indenture from Samuel Durie, Hendrick Banta and Weyntje Banta, 4 January 1762. Signed Albert Banta, Lena Banta (her mark). Witnessed by John Stagg, Casparus Westervelt.¹

Albert and Sarah had 11 children (b. 1820-1839, NYC, except the last). Albert is shown as a cabinetmaker at 36 Lispenard in the 1822-3 NYC Directory and at 131 Spring corner of Wooster in the 1825-6 NYC Directory. Albert was a cabinetmaker in NYC, on Catherine St, near East Broadway in 1832, went to Augusta, GA in 1837 (furniture business), was a Lt in GA militia, returned to NYC in 1841 and was engaged as a hay and grain merchant.

Mary Ann was known as Grandma Banta to her descendants. A Bartholomew [Schaats] is shown as a cooper, at Wooster near Prince in the NYC Directory of 1822-3. In the 1825-6 NYC Directory, he is shown as a cartman, at the rear of Wooster, near Prince, while a second Bartholomew is shown at 101 Duane.

David Banta was a Freeholder of Bergen County in 1779-1780. During the Revolutionary War, when the British and Tories were annoying and injuring the residents in the vicinity of Hackensack, his farm being about a mile north of that village, he exchanged for a farm in Paramus with Cornelius Lozier, a Tory, agreeing to furnish substitutes for the latter's two sons (John and David) during the War. He moved to Paramus, where he lived three years. His widow received £710 for property destroyed by the British during the Revolutionary War.

Esther's father, Hans Dedrick, kept an inn at Bergen, which was the second one licensed in that town.

On November 30th, 1695 Derrick and his brothers joined in the purchase of a large tract of land on the palisades, running from Overpeck Creek to the Hudson River and fronting more than two miles on the river, containing about 3000 acres. This includes considerable parts of the present townships of Palisade and Englewood. "Sibah Epke, Cornelius Epke, Hendrick Epke, Derrick Epke" and six others were named as grantees. The deed is recorded at Trenton in Liber E, folio 245.

Dirk Epke Banta was a Surveyor of Highways, appointed 15 Oct 1717. He lived at that time at Winckleman, on the east side of the Hackensack River, between Old Hackensack and Hackensack.

Epke Jacobse Banta was a farmer who lived in the vicinity of Harlingen, an important seaport of Friesland, the most northern of the provinces of Holland. He emigrated in 1659 in the ship *De Trouw* from Harlinger in Friesland, with his wife and children. He settled at Flushing, where he was an innkeeper until 1669, in 1671 bought a mill formerly run by Benjamin Coe, was later (by about 1675) at Bergen, NJ, and still later near Hackensack (where he purchased land in 1681).

On 9 June 1686 he acquired 240 acres at what was later called Sluckup and Spring Valley in Bergen County, NJ.

A Bergen County Road Return, dated November 1743, was recorded at the request of Isaac Stegg, confirming a four-rod road which may be the replacement for the road nullified on 3 June 1743. The description of the route of this road refers to many of the same lands, with a few deletions and additions: beginning at a bridge by Hendrick Banta, John Cammiga's Barn, William Winters, orchard of Jacobus Blinkerhof, Abraham and Jacob Stegg's land, Albert Westervelt, house of Richard True-man, land of Barent Cool.¹

According to his tombstone, he was a Revolutionary soldier.

In March 1801 Hendrik Banta and his wife, Elizabeth Lake, were admitted to the membership of the Hackensack Ref Church.

Hendrick Banta owned a cider mill at Steenraupie (today's River Edge) and sold a barrel of cider to the troops "every other day."²

His father left him one-half of his farm at Sluckup (Spring Valley, NJ) and in 1790 he bought the remaining half from his brother John.

Guysbert Lake received bequest by will from his grandfathers Guisbert Longstreet and Daniel Lake. On 14 Dec 1790 Guysbert Lake of Hackensack, Hendrik Banta and Elizabeth his wife, and John Smith and Rachel his wife, "now or late" of Freehold, gave to Daniel Lake of Gravesend (prob their uncle) a release of his trusteeship under the will of John Lake.³

On 1 March 1806 (recorded 8 March 1806, Bergen Co. X:149) Henry Banta of Sluckup in the Township of New Barbadoes, and Elizabeth, his wife, conveyed to Coonrad Fisher of the Township of Franklin, for \$175, 4-1/4 acres strict measure of woodland at Persackanack in the Township of Franklin; beginning at James Ackerman's land. Signed by Henry Banta (his mark), Elizabeth Banta (her mark). Witnessed by Henry Van Dalsen, William Van Dalsen.⁴

On 1 April 1806 (recorded 3 May 1806, Bergen Co. X:383) Hendrick Banta of the precinct of New Barbadoes and Elizabeth, his wife, conveyed to George Deramus of the Township of Saddle River, for \$450, 15-1/4 acres, 17 square rods of wood land in the Township of Saddle River, beginning at land of Jacob Demarest. Signed by Hendrick Banta (his mark), Elizabeth Banta (her mark). Witnessed by Geo. B. DePeyster, John Anderson.⁴

In his will dated 3 Jan 1816, probated 3 Sep 1817 (NJA 42:23), he is of New Barbadoes Twp., Bergen Co., NJ. He mentioned wife Elizabeth; sons Cornelius (eldest), John, Gilbert, Wiert, Daniel, Hendrick; grandson Hendrick, son of Cornelius; daus. Nelly, Elizabeth, Rachel.
