The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

He was from Sweden, and was in New Netherland by 1660 when he was at Fort Orange. His name also appears on a list of

soldiers at Esopus 18 March 1660. In 1671 he bought a farm behind Kinderhook. He was a member of the Ref Church at Albany in 1683. He made his will in 1685.

Andries Hanse Barheit, "yeoman of ye Great Flatt neer Coxhacky;" had a lot of land next to Pieter Bronck's farm. Perhaps the same as "Andries Hanse de Sweedt, dwelling at Kinderhoek" in 1675.¹

Andries Scharp, with Aaltje Jansz, witnessed the baptism, 20 Jan 1695 Albany Ref Ch, of Abigael, dau. of Gerrit Jacobsz & Elisabeth.

Andries Scharp & Neeltje Scharp witnessed the baptism 22 Jan 1696 Albany Ref Ch, of Margriet, dau. of Jan Albertsz & Geesje Dirksz.

Gerritje was dead by 1699 when Egbert Teunise [her brother?] became guardian of her four children.¹

Andry Barreht was named collector of New Rochelle, Westchester Co., NY, in April 1702.²

In his will dated 22 Aug 1754, probated 19 Nov 1765 (confirmed 10 June 1767), Barent Barheit, of New York, cartman, mentioned wife Rebecca; cousin Andries Marselis; nephew Gerardus Barheit; nephew Barent Barheit; Johannes Van Hoosen; Andries Marselis; Johannes Van Hoosen (when he is of age); Rebecca Van Woort; cousin Cornelia Quackenbush; children of brother Andries — Gertrude, Catharine and Roles; Andrew Marcey, son of Margaret Marcey, dau. of my brother Andries. Made wife and friends Mr. Robert Morell of New York, tallow chandler, and Mr. Peter Lott, baler, executors. Wit: Richard Bydder, vintner; Abraham Eight; James Emott. This will was re-probated March 3, 1775. At that time the widow, Rebecca Barheit, was dead, also Robert Morell, one of the executors, and the surviving executor, Peter Lott, resigned, and Administration was granted to Andrew Marcelus, "nephew and next of kin to Barent Barheit."¹

Rebecca Barheit of New York, died intestate, and letters of administrations were granted on her estate 1 March 1775 to nephew, Andrew Marcel.²

In 1710 John/Johannes Barhyte had transferred property in New Rochelle which he had sold, and in 1720 a portion of his land lay next to Zacharie Angevine, with whom he made a public agreement about the fences between them; six years after he was chosen one of the assessors, and in 1760 he transferred to his son Andrew the island lying at the mouth of the harbor, then known by the name of "Goose Island," containing by estimation fifteen acres of land, with the houses, orchards, gardens, etc.

Deed (abstract) -- 10 Dec 1713, Johannes Berheyd of New Rochelle, yeoman, conveyed to Peeter Das sen. [elsewhere Peeter Daes], a 30-acre tract of land in New Rochelle, bounded n. by land of Daniel Sycard. [Signed] Johannes Berheyd (his mark).³

Deed (abstract) -- 17 Dec 1760. John Barhyt Sr., farmer, conveyed to loving son Andre Barhyt of New Rochelle, fisherman, for love, good will & affection, my land in New Rochelle lying at the mouth of the harbour known by the name of Goof [Good?] Island containing an estimated 15 acres, more or less. Signed John Barhair Sr. (his mark). Witnessed by Jacob Bleecker, Moses de St. Croix.³

In his will dated 24 Dec 1762, probated 18 Jan 1772, he wrote: December 24, 1762. I, John Barhyt, Sr., of New Rochelle, in Westchester County, being sick, I leave to my wife Judith £10, "and all the movables within the doors of my house," and the use of all my estate while she remains my widow. After her death or marriage my executors are to sell all. I leave to my son Andrew 5 shillings. To my daughter Hester, wife of Jacob Concklin, the best table. To the heirs of my late daughter, Judith, wife of Sevrance Acker, my best Looking glass. To my son John £5, he having received the rest of his portion. To my daughter Abigail, wife of Peter Alley, my best kettle. To my daughter Charity, wife of George Cornwell, my cupboard. All the rest of my estate I leave to my son Andrew, my daughter Hester, the heirs of my daughter Judith, and my daughters Abigail and Charity. "Provided that if my son Andrew does not behave himself well in the management of his affairs, my executors are to make use of his part for his wife and children." I make my wife Judith, and my son-in-law, George Cornwell, and Peter Alley, executors. Witnesses, Abigail Bleecker, Moses De St. Croix, mariner, Jacobus Bleecker. Proved, January 18, 1772.¹
