

-- **BOGARDUS** --

The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In his will, he wrote: May 2, 1711. I, Cornelius Bogardus, at present of the city of Albany, having undertaken to go on a voyage towards North Carolina, in company with my brother Ephraim Bogardus, and calling to mind the mortality of my body. I leave to my loving brother-in-law, Johanes van Vechten, all my estate, real and personal, belonging to me or coming due to me out of the estate of my deceased father, and I make him sole executor. Witness, Robert Livingston, Jr., Hendrick Fransen, Koenrad Ten Eyck. Proved June 8, 1719, and Johanes van Vechten having refused the executorship, by a writing dated October 3, 1718, Letters of administration are granted to his brother-in-law, Ephraim Bogardus.¹

Everardus Bogardus matriculated 27 July 1627, aged 20, at the University of Leyden, Holland, to pursue a course in Lieterature (Letters). On 9 Sep 1630 he was appointed by the Consistory of Amsterdam, Holland, a Comforter (or Chaplain) to the Sick at the Dutch West India Compan's station at Elmina on the Gold Coast, Guiana (then Brazil). He returned to Holland in 1632, and on 14 June 1632 he was ordained a minister of the Dutch Reformed Church by the Classis of Amsterdam, Holland, and he was sent to New Amsterdam on the *Zoutberg*, accompanying newly appointed Director General of New Netherland, Wouter Van Twiller, who succeeded Peter Minuit. They arrived in New Amsterdam in April 1633. On 8 July 1638, Everardus Bogardus was selected as the second installed minister of the Dutch Reformed Church of New Amsterdam. He being a very strict churchman, after a turbulent period, where he was constantly in conflict with Director Generals Wouter Van Twiller and his successor William Kieft, he resigned his charge on 22 July 1647 for the purpose of returning to Holland to defend himself against charges pending there and made by Director General Kieft and his Council. He sailed from

New Amsterdam 19 Aug 1747 on *The Princess*, Governor Kieft sailing on the same ship and day. The ship was wrecked on 27 Sep 1647 in the channel off the coast of Wales, and both he and Gov. Kieft were drowned.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Evert Bogardus, of Kingston, in Ulster County, being of sound mind. I leave all my real and personal estate to my beloved wife Gertruy during her natural life for her support. I leave to my nephew, Evert Bogardus, son of my brother, Nicholas Bogardus, my dwelling house and barn in Kingston and the lot on which it stands, also my other two lots in Kingston, after my wife's decease. I leave to John Elmendorph, son of my brother in law, Petrus Edmundus Elmendorph, all that parcel of land which was devised to me by my father in law in his will, Also the land which I purchased from his executors, all of which is situated and lying on the north west side of the road that leads from Kingston to the Green Kill; I also leave to my nephew, Evert Bogardus, my best gun and £10. I leave to my brother, Nicholas Bogardus, all the money that he is indebted to me, and he is to be discharged from the same. I leave to my brother in law, Charles Crooke, £100. To my sister, Anatie Decker, £100 All the rest of my estate I leave to my nephew, Evert Bogardus, son of my brother Petrus, and to my nephew Evert Bogardus, son of my brother, Nicholas Bogardus, and to my sister,

Maria Wynkoop, my brother in law, Charles Crook, and to John Elmendorph, son of my brother in law, Petrus Edmundus Elmendorph. All these to be paid after the death of my wife. I make my wife, and my brother in law, John Wynkoop, and my brother in law, Petrus Edmundus Elmendorph, executors. Dated May 10, 1746. Witnesses, Thomas Beekman, John Beekman, Jr., Charles Clinton. Proved, May 31, 1758.

Pieter Bogardus lived in Albany until near the end of his life, when he moved to Kingston, NY. He was a mariner. In 1673 he was a magistrate in Albany and in 1690 he was, with others, commissioned to treat with the Five Nations and to look after the defenses of Albany.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Peter Bogardus, of Kingston, in Ulster County. The eldest son of my youngest son is to have a double share of my goods, etc. I leave to my wife, Wyntie, all estate during widowhood. If she marries, then the land that was bought of Thomas Janse and Jacob Solomons, lying at the place called the Beaver Kill, shall go to my sons, Anthony, Ephraim, and Peter. And my land that was bought of John Thomas shall be for Ephraim Bogardus, and Peter Bogardus. Done in Kingston, February 3, 170 1/2. Proved, May 8, 1714. Whereas, in the said will no executor was appointed, and the will was some short time after his decease proved before the Judge and Justices of the inferior Court of Common Pleas of Ulster County, pursuant to an Act of Assembly of this Province. And whereas, Wyntie Bogardus, the widow, died without taking Letters of administration, They are granted to his son, Evert Bogardus, May 8, 1714.

In his will, he wrote: "...I, Petrus Bogardus, of Kingston, in the County of Ulster, being weak in Body, but of sound Memory Blessed be God therefor." I leave to my wife Rebecca all my estate, real and personal, during her natural life, "in case she so long remains my widow. But if she marries, then no more than the Law in such cases allows." I leave to my eldest son, Evert Bogardus, "for Primogeniture, my Pipe and Cane, to debar him from making any further claim on that account." I leave to my other 5 children, viz., Jacob, Petrus, Gerrytie, Marytie, and Catharine, £100 each, after the death of my wife. "In order to bring them upon a par with my son Evert as to what I have already given him." I leave to my daughter Catharine the same value of goods, and other things, which I have given to my other daughters as an outset. I leave to my son Jacob a negro boy named "Will," and he shall pay to my other children £50. I leave to my daughter Marytie, wife of Benjamin Low, a negro boy, and she shall pay £50. I leave to my son Petrus all my blacksmith tools. "I leave to all my children all my right in lands lying on New York Island, formerly in possession of Annatje Bogardus, deceased, and was confirmed to her children by Richard Nicolls, Esq., in the year 1667." To each 1/6 after the death of my wife. I leave to all my children all the lands which are descended to me from my brother, Evert Bogardus, deceased, and all the rest of my estate. I make my son Jacob and my sons-in-law, Coenradt Corns, Elmendorph and Benjamin Low, executors. Dated June 4, 1767. Witnesses, Coenradt Elmendorph, of Hurley, Johanis Wynkoop, Jr., of Kingston, Charles De Witt. Proved, September 25, 1775, before Joseph Gasherie. Confirmed by Governor William Tryon, October 17, 1775. [NOTE.--Petrus Bogardus was grandson of Rev. Everardus Bogardus, and his famous wife Annatie or Annake Jans. The allusion to her lands is a reminiscence of the contest between her heirs and Trinity Church.--W. S. P.]

 A Divorce granted to Wm Bogardus, Publique Notary of this place...Weijntie Cebrantz...hath comitted Adultery, It being proved that she hath borne a Childe in Holland long since she had the society of her husband" It goes on to say that for that reason, William Bogardus was "freed from any further tye or Obligation of matrimony to the said Weintie Cebrantz..." Dated: 5th day of April 1669. Re: the divorce, the Christophs note in end note 50: "The charge here against Wyntie could also have been brought against Willem; if it had been, he would not have been permitted to remarry."¹

Rev. Wm. R. Bogardus was minister at New Paltz Ref Ch, NY beginning 1817. He was a graduate of Union College, Schenectady, and of the Theological Seminary at New Brunswick, N. J.
