The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

On 23 April 1779 (recorded 12 December 1805, Bergen Co. W:254) James Board and Garret Lydecker, two of the Commissioners appointed to take charge of Estates of Certain Fugitives and Offenders; judgment against Peter Earle, late of Hackensack, who did on or about 15 December 1776 join the army of the King of Great Britain, therefore, conveyed at Public Vendue to Highest Bidder, Elias Brevoort of the County of Bergen, for £140, 12 shillings land in Bergen County, beginning at road and west from the court house; mentioned lot of Archibald Campbell; line of John Demarest. Bounded N by Archibald Campbell; W and S by John Demarest; E by Road. Signed by James Board, Garret Lydecker. Witnessed by David Board, Peter Wilson.¹

On 15 January 1787 (recorded 21 December 1805, Bergen Co. W:250) Jacobus Brinkerhoff, Albert Brinkerhoff, and George Brinkerhoff of Old Hackensack in the Precinct of Hackensack, conveyed to Elias Provort of the Town of Hackensack, blacksmith, for £61, 18 shillings, 8-1/4 acres Wood Land in Menocah Woods, being part of a neck of land called the Read Neck, beginning at corner of Seba Brinkerhoof. Bounded S by Seba Brinkerhoof; W by John Bont; NE by land called the Lydecker's Tract; E by land now held by the Allens. Signed by Jacobus Brinkerhof, Albert Brinkerhof, George Brinkerhof. Witnessed by James Chapple, Cornelius Terhune.¹

On 11 June 1788 (recorded 12 December 1805, Bergen Co. W:258) William Van Emburgh and Elizabeth, his wife, of the Precinct of New Barbadoes, conveyed to Elias Brevoort of the same place, for £160, land in Precinct of New Barbadoes, between the Town of New Barbadoes and Pollifly on Public Road. Formerly known as the Doctor's Woods; mentioned are the [Ryson?]; land of John Earle; Archibald Campbell. Signed William Van Emburgh, Elizabeth Van Emburgh. Witnessed by Tobias Ryckman, Peter Wilson.¹

On 2 May 1793 (recorded 12 December 1805, Bergen Co. W:245) Caleb Williams of the Town of Hackensack in the Township of New Barbadoes, silversmith, and Sarah, his wife, conveyed to Elias Bravoort of same place, blacksmith, for £100, 1/4 acre and 32 Rods and 26/100 Rod in the Town of Hackensack in the Township of New Barbadoes, on W side of public road, beginning corner Elias Bravoort; mentioned small crick or brook; land of Archibald Campbell. Bounded E by said main Public Road; S by land of said Caleb Williams; W by small crick; N by said Archibald Campbell and said Elias Bravoort. Signed Caleb Williams, Sarah Williams. Witnessed by Isaac Van Derbeek, Petrus Haring.¹

Hendrick Jansen came to America from Brevoort in the diocese of Utrecht (not Bredevoort in Gelderland as per Nelson). He lived at Flatbush and later occupied from 1659 to 1665 the Kyckuyt (or Lookout) farm; he was then called Hendrick Jansen Kyckuyt. He then moved to Newtown.

Hendrick Janszan Van Brevoort, along with Marritje Hendricx, witnessed the baptism 21 May 1693 NYC Ref Ch, of Jannetie, dau. of Dirck Slÿck & Hendrickje Hendricx.

12 Aug 1695 (Brooklyn, Kings Co., NY Conveyances, Book 2, p. 68) -- Hendrick Janse van Brevort of New York, age about 65 years, and John Hendrickse Brevort of New York, aged about 50 years, take oath that in 1659 they resided on the plantation of David Jochems in Bushwick "now occupied by John Miserole, Sr." Both sign by mark. Ack. Aug 12 and Rec'd 7 Oct 1695 by Henry ffilkin, Reg.²

I leave to my eldest son Henry £20, for his birthright, whereby I do entirely cut him off as being my heir-at-law. I leave to my daughter Janettie, wife of Thomas Sickelsen, of the out ward of New York, my new cupboard, commonly called a "kass." I leave all my clothing to my two sons Henry and Elias. I leave to my daughters Maria, wife of Zachariah Sickelson of New Harlem, and Janettie, wife of

Thomas Sickelson all the clothing of my late wife Anettie. All my real estate is to go to such of my children as shall be able and willing to pay .400 for the same, to be paid to the rest of my four children. Witnesses, Peter Arkell, Jan Willense Room, John Conrad Codwise. Proved, December 21, 1714.¹
