The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Benjamin Coe was born in Boxford England His mother died 9 days after his birth. He was born in a small rural parish in Suffolk County, England, He came to America with his Father, Step-mother (Hannah Dearsly) and his 2 brothers (Robert and John) and one sister (Mary). Benjamin and Mary are twins. Benjamin was first mentioned in land records of New Amsterdam, (Now Long Island), Feb. 18, 1655, as owning a house and lot, was a miller and farmer, did not participate too much in public affairs, although he served as town clerk of Jamaica in 1676, No doubt their were several daughters born to this couple, as land grants were to his daughters and their husbands. His recorded sons were, Benjamin, 1660-Joseph 1665- John 1670- William 1675-. Mr. Coe's last known record is on the ministerial subscription list for January 1, 1694, was not on the 1695 list and it is assumed he died sometime in 1694. No will nor burial records were ever found.¹

Benjamin was known as "Judge Benjamin." He was a judge of the Court of Common Pleas, a member of Assembly in 1778 (his father and he both being members at the same time), and was also elected in 1789. He was the first member from Rockland County in 1799 and was State Senator in 1807-12 and a member of Council of Appointment in 1811.

Benjamin Coe, husband of the decedent, was granted Letters of Administration on the Estate of Sarah Coe of the town of Haverstraw. Nov. 4, 1819.

My executors are to sell my cleared land, 12 acres, bounded south by David Springsteen, situate in the southeast part of Newtown; Also a piece of wood land near it, being 6 acres, and they shall take the rents of the land which I have leased unto Nathaniel Woodward and William Fish, and also sell enough movable estate to pay all debts. I leave the use of all the rest of lands and estate to my wife Phebe, for the support of the children. I leave to my son John, my lot of meadow and strip of upland, which I bought of John Pettit. All the rest of my houses and lands I leave to my sons, John, Samuel, and Benjamin, except those lands and meadows I bought of John Wood, and they are to pay to my youngest son, William, £200, when of age. I leave to my executors the house and land I bought of John Wood to be sold after 10 years and the money to be paid to my daughters, Abigail, Melicent, and Mary. But if my son John inclines to keep the same, he may do so, by paying to each of my daughters, £50. If my daughter Abigail, who is subject to fits, shall be incapable of getting her livelihood, her brothers are to support her. I leave to my sister Mary, wife of Joseph Smith, and Abigail, wife of William Thorman, and Hannah, wife of John Wood, all my Meadow at Morris Park in Jamaica. I make my wife Phebe, and my brother Robert, executors. Dated August 11, 1748. Witnesses, Nathaniel Woodward, Matthew Coe, Benjamin Hinchman. Proved, before Adam Larned, Esq., October 5, 1748.

John Coe was a judge of Orange County from 1764 to 1770, a member of the Provincial Assembly and the Provincial Congress in 1775, and a member of Assembly in 1778-80.¹

The homestead of Judge John Coe, opposite the English Church, was where the guard in charge of Major John Andre stopped for dinner while conducting their prisoner to Tappan.

In his will dated 4 March 1782, probated 25 Oct 1782, "John Coe, of Orange County, State of New York, Gentleman" mentions eldest daughter Abigail Gurnee; daughter Margaret Vandervoort; eldest son Benjamin Coe; daughter Hanna Smith; youngest daughter Sarah Coe; son Samuel; sons John Coe, Jonas Coe, Halsted Coe; youngest son Matthew Coe. Made sons Benjamin, John and Jonas executors. Witnesses were Gilbert Cooper, Peter Read, John D. Coe.¹

"But whereas my said daughter-in-law is now great with child and not yet delivered; if she bears a son he is to have an equal share, but if a daughter, she is to have equal shares with her sisters, Elizabeth and Mary Coe." I leave to my said two grand daughters, all my land and rights of land in Hempstead, and all my land and meadows in Jamaica, and all my movable estate not before mentioned. And my grand son Jonathan, is to pay to his sister Elizabeth, £10, when he is 21, and my grand son Benjamin is to pay £10 to his sister Mary. I make Lambert Woodward, of Newtown, and my daughter-in-law, Abigail Coe, executors. Dated July 12, 1743. Witnesses, William Furman, Joseph Smith, Jr., Benjamin Hinchman. Proved, November 5, 1750.
