

-- DATER --

The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Abraham Dater settled on land on the Island Road, about 3 miles from Suffern. He was in the iron business at Pleasant Valley (Ramapo Works). Merchant iron from his forges was carted to Nyack and then shipped by river to New York. By 1820 the business was Dater & Ward, Mr. Dater's son-in-law Thomas Ward having been taken into the business.

On 4 May 1811 (recorded 16 Dec 1811, Bergen Co. G2:1) John Tiso and Phebe Young, his wife, of the Township of Franklin, conveyed to Jacob Young of the same place, for \$887.50, a parcel in Franklin Township, part of lot 153 in Ramapough tract, beginning line of Benjamin Westervelt; Abraham Dater; heirs of Jacob Crouter, deceased; John Litchholt;

excepting a road called Franklin Turnpike Road running across the land. Bounded W by heirs of Jacob Crouter; E by John Litchholt; S by Brook and Benjamin Westervelt. Signed by John Tiso, Phebe Tice. Witnessed by Jacob I. Debaun, Gerrit Durie.³

He was probably the Abraham Dator who witnessed the following transaction: On 7 April 1798 (recorded 22 May 1805, Bergen Co. U:209) John Hopper, Esquire, of the Township of Franklin, conveyed to Andrew Hopper of the same place, for £28, two parcels: (1) 40 acres strict measure in Franklin Township, part of lot number 97 [94?] in the Romopock tract, which he purchased from James Parker and Walter Rutherford. (2) 26-59/100 acres strict measure, lot number 95. Signed by John Hopper. Witnessed by Abrm. Ryerson, Abrm. Dator.³

On 28 April 1823, Abraham Dator of Hempstead, County of Rockland, NY sold for \$750 to Adam Dator of Franklin, [Bergen County, NJ], 86 acres, bounded east by Samuel Campbell, south by Peter B. Westervelt and public road and lands of Adam Dator and James Westervelt. (Bergen U-2:417)¹

The will of James Christie of Mahwah listed as executor his brother-in-law Abraham Dator.

Martha Ann Zabriskie wrote in her memorandum book, under date of 4 Feb 1830, "Died Abraham Dator from the Clove."

The will of Abraham Dator of Ramapo, Rockland Co., NY was probated 18 July 1831 (rec. NYC). Letters of Administration were granted to Hannah Dator, widow of the decedent, Estate of Abraham Dator of Ramapo. Aug. 30, 1830

Abraham Dator of Ramapo, iron-master, in his will (No date, but in proving the will one of the witnesses stated that the will was executed Feb. 5th, last), probated Mar. 2, 1831 -- mentioned Wife, Mary; Son, George Washington, to be educated; Daus., Nancy Maria, Hannah, Henrietta and Catharine Jane, My real estate known as the Pleasant Valley Forge which consists of a two-fire forge, dam and one half the water privileges, with a mansion house, store, blacksmith shop, barn, shed and sundry dwelling houses for workmen and one half the grist mill, also 1,060 acres of land all in the Town of Ramapo, Executors: Wife, Mary, Jacob Sloat and John Ward.

Thomas Ward was appointed guardian for the minor heirs of Abraham Dator, Jr.

Mary Dator, 50, b. NJ, living in Ramapo Township for 34 yrs., farmer, was listed in the 1855 New York State Census, living in Ramapo Township, Rockland County, NJ. Listed living with her were: Hannah, 30, dressmaker; and Washington, 27. Both children were b. Rockland County.

He sold, on 14 April 1842 (recorded 20 Oct 1842, F-4:276), his share of his father's homestead farm for \$945 to his brother John Y. Dater.²

At the time of their marriage, he was from Ramapo, and she was from Saddle River.

They are listed in the 1850 Federal Census, Bergen Co., Hohokus Twp., Dwelling #552, Family #606. He is listed as a farmer, with real estate valued at \$5,000.

Abraham Dater, 59, farmer, and Maria Dater, 52, were listed in the 1880 Federal Census, living with their unmarried daughters, Mary C., 28; and Jemima, 22, in Hohokus Township, Bergen County, NJ (prob. in what became Saddle River Borough).

He appears to have lived in Pompton, NJ, and attended a Reformed Dutch Church there.¹

According to Tom Dater, writing in an e-mail dated 3 May 2002, Adam, married to a Maria, had four sons and no daughters. They were John (died very young), Adam, John, and Abraham. Adam went to Airmount, John to Theills in Haverstraw and Abraham to Sloatsburg and Franklin Twmsp and became Abram. From him my line descends, and from Adam, the

Mahwah Dators come. The three surviving sons of Adam named sons after their grandfather, and since all lived roughly at the same time, they were each confused with the other since in several cases they were referred to as Adam Jr.

His father, John Dater, deeded Adam 100 acres of his farm in the town of Haverstraw on the Minisceongo Brook, part of lot No 8 for \$1 and the tender affection I now bear him. This was the western part of the home farm.²

The family appears in 1820 and 1830 Rockland County Census records. They moved to Phelps Gorham Purchase by 1850 and owned a farm of about 110 acres in Hopewell, Ontario Co., NY in 1850, which was sold about 1867.

They were listed in the 1850 Federal Census, New York, Ontario Co., Hopewell, p. 34, enumerated 15 Aug 1850, Dwelling 242, Family 242 (all b. NY except as noted) -- Adam Dater, 55, Farmer, value real estate \$4100; Sarah [Dater], 39; Olivia [Dater], 16; Mary [Dater], 14; Jerome [Dater], 12; Sarah [Dater], 9; John McFarlane, 23, Laborer, b. Canada.

After her husband's death, Sarah lived with her son Jerome in Ontario County, NY.

The will of Adam Dater was dated 10 Oct 1829, probated 24 Nov 1829 (Bergen C:420). In it he mentioned wife Mary; children Hannah Eliza, John, Abraham, Henry, Jacob, and Martha, the last five being minors.¹

Mary Young m. (2) 28 April 1838 Ramapo Ref Ch, Mahwah, **Hassel Doremus**, a farmer living at the Goffle. He moved to Ramapo in 1852.

Henry Dater was prepared for College under the instruction of his pastor, the Rev. John H. Duryea, D.D., graduated from Rutgers College in 1847, and three years later from the Theological Seminary at New Brunswick, NJ. He was licensed to preach the Gospel 6 Aug 1850 by the Classis of Paramus, and having accepted a call from the newly-organized church at South Branch, NJ, was ordained by the Classis of Raritan. In 1853 he was called to the Reformed Church of Hyde Park, on the Hudson, which he served till the autumn of 1877, when he removed to Hawthorne, NJ.²

At the time of their marriage, he was of Branchville, Somerset Co., NJ; she was of North Paterson, NJ (Manchester¹).
