The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In his will, he wrote: "...23 of May, 1763, I, Dirck De Witt, being sick, do revoke all former wills, and thus begin anew to make disposition as followeth." All debts to be paid in a reasonable time. It is my will that my 4 children, Annatie, Elizabeth, Catharine, and Gertie, shall have between then all my estate except 3 acres of ground where my house and barn now stand. And they shall also divide all my loose and movable estate. It is my will that Jacob and Teunis Oosterhout, children of my daughter Annatie, shall have 1/2 of her share of my estate. It is my will and desire that my wife Ariantie shall remain in possession of my whole estate, real and personal, during her life. But if she comes to marry, she shall deliver up the estate to

my children. It is my will that my 3 daughters, Anattie, Elizabeth, and Catharine, should make and fix a price upon my house, barn, and 3 acres of ground, and they have accordingly valued the same at £200. And after the death of my wife, they shall ballot and draw for the house and lot, whose the same shall be, and the one to whom it shall fall, shall pay to the others £150. My 4 daughters and 2 grandchildren are to be heirs of all the rest of my estate. I make my daughter Elizabeth, Petrus Kool, Jacob G. Louw, Johanes Rosekrans, and Theunis Oosterhout, executors. "This done at Rochester, in Ulster County." Witnesses, John Tock (or Jack), Petrus Burger, John Schoonmaker. Proved, July 9, 1764.

22 Jan 1664 --Elias Janzen appearing declares, that there was a pound of candles in the mill, which was missed, and that Jan de Witt would have it that he took them; whereupon he gave him for answer, that it was not true and that perhaps a dog had been in the mill and eaten them; saying he must not lay them to his charge, for perhaps he was as honest as he. After which the abovenamed de Witt came behind, where he sat on this mill stone and struck him, so that the blood followed; and that this was seen by no other person than by Jan Teunisen.¹

Jan Teunisen, pltf. v/s Jan de Witt, miller, deft. Pltf. says, that he had contracted to make a vault in the bay, for which he had been paid and was hard pressed to finish it--that deft. would not allow him his journeyman, though he offered him a man in his place. Deft says, he could not agree to that as he did not want another in the mill. And whereas parties cannot agree herein with each other, it was therefore proposed, if it were not better, that Jan de Witt should keep the mill alone a month more or less, on condition of paying his partner a certain sum for his share for the time he keeps it to himself, which they both agree to; And whereas they cannot agree with each other on what the abovenamed de Witt should give for the time he alone had the mill, Burgomasters and Schepens decree, that each shall choose a man to reconcile them therein, to which they have no objection and Jan de Witt on his side therefore chose as referee Burgomaster Paulus Leendersen van der Grift, and Jan Teunisen Schepen Jacob Backer, who have accepted it.¹

Jan Teunisen returning, the declaration of Elias Jansen hereinbefore written, was read to him and he is asked if it were true? Answers, Yes and that he should not like to get such a blow and he made his nose bleed with the blow.¹

Footnote: Jan de Witt and Jan Teunisen from Leerdam were partners and owned the windmill, which was situated in the present City Hall Park "on the line of the Great Highway," now Broadway. They dissolved partnership, De Witt retiring the following May. --O'C.¹

After her death £50, to go to her son John Hendricks. To Hannah, daughter of Hendrick Ten Eyck, by Petronella De Witt, £20, to Abraham Staats of Albany, £20. I leave all the rest of my estate to my dear and loved wife Johana De Bruyn, and make her sole executor. Witness Guysbert Vanderburgh, Benjamin Wynkoop, James Vanderlide. Proved before Richard Ingoldsby, Lieutenant-Governor, June 20, 1709. [Lancaster Symes was husband of Catherine DeHart, dau. of Matthias DeHart & Jannetje/Johanna Gerrits.]

In her 1709 will Johanna (Gerrits) De Wit De Hart De Bruyn mentions all of her daughters and their present husbands. She mentions by name her daughter Sophia's two children -- Johanna and Elizabeth -- and Sophia is to receive 50 pounds if

she returns from Jamaica and starts caring for her children. The children were those of "Edmond Thomas" and "Maria Sefia de Witt." "Sofia de Witt". Johanna was baptized on 22 October 1704 and Elizabeth on 19 March 1707. In 1709 they would have been 5 and 2 years old.
