The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In 1658-9 and 1660, Johannis de Decker was a member of The Council of the Province of New Netherlands.

At the early age of 21 years he was registered as a notary in Dordrecht, on 7 Oct 1647, and later he was registered as a notary of Schiedam in 1650, 1653 and 1654 (A.D; H.D.B. 3:587) and as states attorney (C.D.N.Y. 14:301).

In Apr 1655, Johannes arrived in New Amsterdam on the ship *Swarte Arent* (Black Eagle), having served as supercargo on the voyage, and bearing a letter dated 23 Nov. 1654 from the directors of the Amsterdam Chamber of the West Indies Company, addressed to Governor Pieter Stuyvesant and recommending of de Decker as one "Whose abilities we admit deserve of better and higher position, for besides being a well conduced man, experience in business, having served faithfully for some years as procureur (States' attorney) and notary at Schiedam, he is a young man of sound judgment and writes a neat and manly style. You may try him and employe him provisionally in the office, or in some other place, for we have concluded that he shall remain there in the Company's service, recommending that upon the first ocasion offering, you give to the said Decker a proper and decent appointment, for we are confident that the Company and you will be benefited by his good and faithful service (C.D.N.Y. 14:304)

In accordance with these instructions, the director general and concil, on 16 June 1655, appointed him presiding commissary at Fort Orange (Albany) replacing Johannes Dyckman, who had become insane. From 13 July 1655 to 17 July 1656 de Decker's name appears in the court minutes of Fort Orange as Commissary Officer here, ex officio plaintiff" (he signed his name J. de Deckere or J. Deckere).

Johannes De Decker returned to Holland in 1657 on private business and on 20 May and 22 Dec. 1657 the Directors wrote a letter concering his return from Holland: "...We trust that the company andyou will derive great benefits from his performance of these varrious duties and if his private affairs had not detained him here, he would have sailed in the ship Wegh, but he was obliged to delay his departur.. Johannes de Decker... is about to sail with his wife, lately married here, in one of these shilp, St Baptiste, unless the sudden and unexpected front has taken him unaware.. in that case, he will surely leave in one of the ships now preparing to sail... in the spring."

When Johannes de Decker signed his name to his marriage banns in Dordrecht on 27 Oct. 1657 he spelled his name "De Decker," but his uncle Abraham some years before used a final e when he signed his own banns, Deckere.

Decker and his wife returned to Holland in 1659 and shortly before his departure for Holland, de decker had acquired on 21 July 1659, from Hendrick Jans De Boer, a lot which he resold on 1 Oct 1663 to Johannes De Witt. It is described as a lot on the Island of Manhattan, city of New Amsterdam, in the rear of the lot of Hendrick Jans Smith, (the site is now 41 Pearl Street. (Icon., 2:385).

In 1662 his father-in-law, at his daughter's request, wrote a letter for de Decker's discharge from the Company's service.

On 15 May 1664 De Decker had secured a patent for 60 morgens on Staten Island. In 1670 Johannes de Decker was banished to Amsterdam, where most likely his son, Mattheus de Decker was born. They returned in 1671. His oldest son, Jacobus was baptized on 17 Nov. 1658 in New Amsterdam.

Jan sailed as a lad from Bremerhaven, Germany to Santa Cruz and Curacao in the West Indies where he served Jacob Hay. Hence he came to New Amsterdam in 1644 on the Dutch ship "De Bleuwe Hean" (The Blue Cock) and later settled in what is now Albany. He then moved to the Esopus (Kingston) area and became a Lieut. in the local militia. In 1661 Jan was on the muster roll of the garrison of Wiltwyck.²

Jan Broerse was on the muster roll of the garrison of Wilwyck in 1661. In November of that year he sued Christyntie Capoens, daughter of Dirck Holgerson (Volckertsen) and widow of Jacob Huys, for labor he had done for her husband, Jacob Huys, in the West Indies. Jan Broerzen, pltf. produced a declaration of Adrian Huybersen Sterrevelt, who stated, it is within his knowledge that Jan Broersen served Jacob Hay as a boy about seventeen years ago in the West Indies, both at Santa Cruz and Curacao without having received, to his knowledge, any pay therefore: Also a declaration of Tryn Herders declaring that she had been with him to Jacob Hay, and speaking about money was refused any by him.³
