The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

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**DuBois**

There were 3 apparently unrelated DuBois families in early New Netherland.

1. Louis DuBois of Kingston and New Paltz.
2. There was a Jacques (James) DuBois who married Blanche Sauzeau. Their will was dated Feb 6, 1675. They were from Marenes in Saintonge. The inventory of goods of the widow ordered April 2, 1690 mentioned 120 acres at New Rochelle.
3. There was another Louis DuBois that I think is also unrelated to the Louis of Kingston. This is the Louis DuBois of Staten Island who was a blacksmith and who married in 1696 Ester, the daughter of Auguste Grasset. (see "Auguste Grasset of La Rochelle, London, and New York City" by Neil Thompson in the National Genealogical Society Quarterly, vol 66 no. 1 pp 3-15.) He also had a son Louis (Lewis) who was a blacksmith whose will was dated 8 July, 1741.

Abraham, age 21, and his brother Isaac, 18, were associated with their father as members of the twelve Patentees of New Paltz in 1677. On 1 Sep 1689 Abraham DuBois took the Oath of Allegiance in the County of Ulster by order of his Excel-

lency the Governor.

In his will, written in Dutch and dated 1 October 1730, probated 22 Oct 1731, he wrote: (Written in the Dutch language.)-- In den Namen des Heeren, Amen, October 1, 1730. I, Abraham DuBois, of New Paltz, in Ulster County. It is my will that all my debts be paid in due time. My wife Margaret shall have and enjoy for life 1/3 of the proceeds of my real estate. My oldest son Abraham, for his right of primogeniture and obedience, shall have £200. And he shall not pay any rent for the land belonging to me on the Raritan river, in New Jersey, to the south of the land of John Cook, during my life and my wife's life, and then it shall go to him and his heirs; and it shall be appraised, and he shall pay the value to my other heirs, deducting the improvements made by him, since his settlement. I leave to my son Joel, all that parcel of land in New Paltz Patent, on the south side of the Paltz Kill, between the lands of the heirs of Abraham and Jan Hasbrouck. Also the large meadow and the lots in the Cripple Bush, Wassamakers land, and my house, barn and lot, in the village of Paltz, and the sheep meadow; and the land on the north side of the Paltz Kill, from the "dray heck" (turn stile). And he is to pay the amount at which it is appraised, deducting his proportion. I leave to my daughter Sarah and her husband, Roelof Eltinge, all my land on the north side of the Paltz Kill, which they now occupy, and all my land on the south side of the kill situate between Solomon and Daniel Dubois, which they now occupy. And they are to pay the appraised value except their equal share. I leave to my daughter Leah and her husband Philip Fires, during their life, 1/2 of that parcel of land at Canastage, next to the said Fires land, and then to her heirs, and they are to pay the appraised value. All of the rest of my estate I leave to all my children, Abraham, Joel, Sarah, Leah, Rachel and Catharine. But my daughter Catharine is only to have one half as much as the rest. My children are not to sell their lands to any strangers, before they shall have acquainted their brothers and sisters and given them the refusal. I make my son Abraham, and my son-in-law, Roelef Eltinge, and Major Johans Hardenbergh, executors. Witnesses, Daniel Dubois, Thomas Beekman, John Crooks, Jr. Proved, October 22, 1731.

In his will, dated 22 Jan 1755 Somerset Co., NJ, Abraham Dubois mentioned Children--Abraham, Francyntje (wife of Bragon Hoff), Marytje (wife of George Ryerse), Cathrine (wife of David Gano), Elizabeth (wife of Stephen Gano), Rebecca (wife of Frederick Van Vliet). Grandchildren--Mary and Susannah Jubert and Abraham Dubois. Land in said Co., 2,200 acres, divided into 6 lots. Personal estate. Executors--Sons-in-law Hoff and Reyerse. Chretien settled on lands at Wicres, France about 10 miles southwest of Lille where his farm is still pointed out. He was probably born about 1590. He is described as a gentleman of the family of du Bois, Seigneurs de Beaufermez and de Bourse.

Chretien du Bois of Wicres in Artois, Pas de Calais, France, was born in 1597 and died prior to 10 October 1655. Owing to the systematic mutilation of the records of Huguenot families of the nobility, neither his parentage nor issue can be definitely proved. It is believed that he belonged to one of the five quite well known families stemming from Geoffroi de Bois and his wife Sidonie Tesson of the Cotentin Peninsula in Normandy who were alive in the middle of the 11th century. From records in the Netherlands, where many Huguenots gained sanctuary, it is certain that Louis and Jacques s, both Walloons, were sons of Chretien du Bois.

In his will, he wrote: I, Cornelius DuBois, of the Precinct of New Paltz, Ulster County, Esq. I leave to my wife Margaret for life a negro slave and a negro wench, and one cow and so much of my household goods as she may judge she may have

occasion for. I leave to my son Cornelius for life all my real estate in New Paltz, except what may be sold by my executors, with all buildings. After his death, to his heirs and to my daughters, Tryntie, Janettie, Jacomintie, and Saretie, and to my grandchildren, Nathaniel, Wilhelmus, and Polly Dubois, children of my daughter Rachel, deceased; And to my grandchildren, Dirck Wynkoop and Leah Wynkoop, children of my daughter Leah, deceased; And to my son Cornelius and my daughter Tryntie, and my daughter Janettie, and my daughter Jacomintie, and my daughter Saretie. I leave to my son Cornelius eight horses, and he is to pay for them £80 in gold or silver, and as many of my slaves as he may think best, and he is to pay for each of them £90 in gold or silver, at eight shillings for a Spanish dollar. I leave to my daughter Saretie a negro wench, and she is to pay for her £80 in gold or silver. I leave to my son Cornelius my two seats in the Church at Shawangunk. I leave to my grandson, Cornelius Hasbrouck, one seat in the Church at New Hurley. I leave to my grandson, Cornelius Dubois Hasbrouck, one seat in the church at Marble town. All the rest I leave to my children and grandchildren, and all the rest of my real estate and all my privileges in the New Paltz Patent of getting hay, stone, and timber. My executors are to sell to best advantage all that certain lot of land of sixty-six acres in Ulster County, being part of a tract of 1,056 acres granted to me by Patent, July 2, 1739, as surveyed by Johannis Bruyn; Also all the land I have in said Patent adjoining to the above and lying on the southwest side of the Platte Kill. And the money is to be divided among my children and grandchildren. I make my son Cornelius, and my son-in-law, Jacob Hasbrouck, Jr., and my grandsons, Josia Hasbrouck, Nathaniel Dubois, and Cornelius Hasbrouck, executors." My son-in-law, Cornelius D. In his will, he wrote: I, Gualtherus Du Bois, minister of the Dutch Reformed Protestant church, in New York, being in perfect health, Thanks be to God for the same. I commit my body to be interred in a most Christian-like manner. I leave to my eldest son Gualtherus my watch and gold seal ring, over and above what I bequeath to him. I leave to my son Gualtherus and my daughter Elizabeth, all my linnen and woolen, and all that belongs to the furniture of my house, and my horse and chaise, and all my Dutch books and manuscripts belonging to my library, except my plate. I leave to Peter and Gualtherus, the children of my son John, 1/2 of my Latin books. The other half I give to Gualtherus Du Bois, son of my deceased son Isaac. He came to America with his wife Catherine Blanchan in 1660. He first settled in Kingston, then New Paltz, where he was one of the founders and sat upon the Duzine, the governing body. His grandson Daniel built the DuBois Fort which still stands today on Huguenot Street in New Paltz.<sup>2</sup>

Louis served in the 2nd Esopus War and was the leader of New Paltz, New York, Patentees. Louis fled from his home in France to Mannheim, Germany before 1650. Louis was a Huguenot and fled France to avoid religious persecution. He and his family came to Kingston, New York in 1660. They then moved to Hurley, New York in the same colony as Kingston. The wife and three children of Louis, were taken captive by the Esopus Indians in the massacre of June 7, 1663. They were rescued after three months in captivity in the Shawangunk Mountains, by an expedition commanded by Captain Martin Greiger [Cregier?]. Catherine DuBois was singing the 137th Psalms, that of Babylonian captivity, when rescued. Captain Greiger, in his journal of the Second Esopus War, states that, Louis DuBois while working in his field, was attacked by three Indians, and although wounded and unarmed, slew one of the Indians with a piece of palisade, whereupon the others fled. Louis DuBois was appointed Magistrate of Hurley, N.Y. on August 10, 1669 by Governor Francis Lovelace. The site of New Paltz, N.Y. was bought from the Esopus Indians on September 15, 1677 by Louis DuBois. A patent was therefore granted the "Twelve Patentees" by Governor Edmond Andross, September 29, 1677. Louis DuBois was chosen Elder of the French Church at New Paltz when Rev. Pierre Daille visited there. In 1686, Louis DuBois returned from New Paltz to Kingston where he purchased a house and lived at this location ten years until his death in 1696. The vast real property holdings in New Paltz were divided among his children.<sup>3</sup>

In his will (written in Dutch) dated 27 March 1694, probated 26 March 1696, Luis Dubois of Kingston, Ulster Co. [NY] mentioned wife Catherine; son Abraham £6 for his right of primogeniture; sons Jacob, David, Solomon, Lewis and Matthew (youngest son, per codicil); children of deceased son Israel; children of daughter Sarah, wife of Joost Janse. Made wife Catherine executor. Wit. John Ward, Stephen Van Somer, W. De Meyer. In a codicil dated 27 Feb 1695/6, specifies particular land parcels to his children. Wit. to codicil: Wilhelminus De Meyer, John Rutsen, Jan Barham, Matys Schlecht.<sup>1</sup>

Also 1/2 of 1/3 of all that certain tract of land which was conveyed to me by the Trustees of Rochester, in common with Moses De Puy and Frederick Schoonmaker,

situate in Rochester on the south and southeast side of Rondout creek or Kill. Also 1/2 of 1/3 of all the mines and minerals in the same. My executors are to put the same at interest until they are of age. "I also leave to my daughter Esther 3 seats in a Pew No. 15 in the Church at Rochester." I leave to my said 5 grandsons 1/2 of 1/3 of all that certain tract of land which was conveyed to me by the Trustees of Rochester, in common with Moses De Puy and Frederick Schoonmaker, in Rochester, on the south and southeast side of Rondout Kill or creek. Also 1/6 of minerals. I also give to my daughter Esther and my 5 grandchildren all my slaves, stock of horses, black cattle, sheep, and swine, and all household goods, and all money due to me, and all the rest of my movable estate. My executors may make a division or sell. I leave to my grandson Philip one seat in the Pew No. 15 in the Church at Rochester so long as he lives there. But if he removes to some other town or place the said seat shall revert to my daughter Esther or her heirs, and they shall pay for the seat £2 10s. I leave to my grandson Isaac a seat in the said Pew No. 15 on the same terms. "I leave to my grandson Cornelius one seat in a Pew back of the door." And to my 5 grandsons all my wearing apparell. I make my daughter Esther and my son-in-law, Lewis Bevier, and my nephew, Simon Du Bois, and my cousins, Jacob Hasbrouck, Jr., Abraham Hasbrouck, and Abraham Dujon, executors.
