

-- ECKERSON, ACKERSON, A-I --

The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

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**Eckerson/Ackerson**

This is a separate family from the similarly named Eckert/Eckhard family, the latter family probably of German origin and possibly descended from a 1709 German Palatine emigrant, with early settlers in Westchester County, NY.

The early records dealing with the Eckerson/Ackerson family often used a shortened form, such as Eckerse, Ekker, Ecker, Acker etc., which can lead to the confusion of these two families (Eckerson and Eckert) in the colonial period. Some of the individuals listed here may actually belong to the Eckert/Eckhard family.

The first in this country prob. was Thomas Huggeson (or Higgeson). His children seem to have used the patronymic surname, Thomaszen. His son, Jan Thomaszen about 1692 assumed (or, actually, re-assumed) the surname Huggeson/Higgeson, spelling it Ekkeson/Eckerson (and spelling variants).

The two surname spellings (Eckerson and Ackerson) are here filed interchangeably as though they were all spelled the same.

Abraham served in the Orange County, NY Militia during the Revolutionary War.

They lived in Clarkstown, NY, moving about 1805 to Bergen County, NJ. About 1815 they moved to Ohio.

On 14 November 1803 (recorded 27 March 1804, Bergen Co. R:430) David Ackerson of the Township of Franklin, yeoman, by and with consent of Rachel, his wife, conveyed to Garret A. Ackerson of the Town of Clarkstown, in County of Rockland, NY, for \$587.50, 40 acres of land in the Township of Franklin, beginning SW corner of said parcel being the NW corner of the land of Laurance Ackerman. Bounded W by land of the heirs of Corynes Van Houten, deceased, and land of Isaac Day; E by land of Abraham Ackerson; N by unimproved lands; S by said Laurance Ackerman. Signed by David Ackerson (his mark), Rachel Ackerson (her mark). Witnessed by Daniel Gero, Junr., John Acker.<sup>1</sup>

On 19 November 1803 (recorded 27 March 1804, Bergen Co. R:434) Abraham Ackerson of the Town of Clarkstown, Rockland County, NY, carpenter, and Derrikye, his wife, conveyed to Thomas A. Ackerson of the same place, masoner, for \$250, 20 acres of land in the Township of Franklin, beginning E corner of land of Elyas folly; mentioned are unimproved land; land of John A. Ackerson; land of John Ackerman; Publick Road. Signed by Abraham Ackerson, Derricky Ackerson (her mark). Witnessed by John Packer, John Hopper, Conroot Stor, Henry D. Carlough.<sup>1</sup>

On 15 January 1813 (recorded 27 January 1813, Bergen Co. H2:264) Abraham Eckerson and Dercey, his wife, of the Township of Franklin, conveyed to William W. Packer of the same place, for \$1,375., 44 acres more or less in the Township of Franklin; land of Elizabeth Van Houten; Laurence Ackerman and Peter Ward, deceased; public road; John L. Ackerman. Signed by Abraham Ackerson, Dirkye Ackerson (her mark), Witnessed by Michael Stur, Jno. A. V. Voorhis.<sup>1</sup>

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Garret Eckerson was a major of the State militia, stationed at Sandy Hook during the War of 1812 and afterwards a major-general. He was elected twice as a member of the Legislature. He was a farmer, and also had a cotton mill, a distillery, and a store on his premises.

He is probably the Garret Ackerson whose distillery stood on the west side of the Pascack Brook near what is today Mill Road, Park Ridge. It was founded prior to the War of 1812 as a distillery of cider. Ackerson manufactured "Apple Jack" here and sold it to the U.S. Government as part of rations for soldiers. A cotton and woolen mill buisness was later added, all of which was sold to James Schoonmaker in 1841.<sup>2</sup>

He served as prosecutor of the pleas in 1869, and as judge of Court of Common Pleas in 1877-1882. In 1879 he was appointed to the State National Guard judge-advocate-general, with the rank of colonel.<sup>1</sup>
