

-- ELSWORTH --

The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

He is most likely the man who came to Dutchess County and was listed in Town of Clinton in the 1790 census at 2-1-1 between Hewlett Peters and Lemuel Conklin. He evidently married a first wife, name unknown and probably had two or three children. He then married 2nd between 1782 and 1789, as her 2nd **Sarah Smith**, the widow of George Peters of Town of Clinton. She was born 31 Oct 1732, dau of Abel and Ruth (Jackson) Smith.¹

In his will, dated 2 Sep 1796, probated 30 May 1805, Ahasuerus Ellsworth, of the town of Clinton, left use of estate to widow Sarah, reverting to Ahasuerus Ellsworth Peters, son of Hewlett Peters, and to nephew Dr. George Gibbassy. Executors: Abel Peters, Jesse Oakley, and Hewlett Peters. Wits: Jacob Smith, Richard Caurelion (?), and William Garter.

In the NYC Ref Ch record of the (1) marriage and banns, they were: Clement Israels, j.m. Van N. Yorke, en Anna Maria Engelberts, j.d. Van Mitspatskill, beyde woonende tot N. Yorke.

In his will, he wrote: I Clement Elsworth, of New York, shipwright, being sick. All debts and duties which I owe in right or conscience to be paid. I leave to my grandson, Clement Elsworth, eldest son of my son, Theophilus Elsworth, late of New York, deceased, 6 shillings, in full of all claim as my heir at law. I leave to my wife Mary, £15. Of all the rest of my estate, I leave 1/5 to the children of my son Theophilus, 1/5 to my daughter Sarah, 1/5 to my daughter Anna Mary, 1/5 to my daughter Elizabeth, and 1/5 to the child of my son John. And he is to allow out of the same to the rest of my children, for the lot of ground lying near the Cripple Bush, already received by my son John. I make my brother, William Elsworth, shipwright, and my sons-in-law, Cornelius Kierstede, silversmith, and John Brestead, cooper, executors. Dated November 20, 1723. Witnesses, Anthony De Mill, Hendrick Anthony, Henry De Meyer. Proved, February 29, 1726. [Note.--The Cripple Bush was a swamp, through which Jacob Street now runs. The region still bears the name of "The Swamp."--W. S. P.]

If she should marry again then she is to have one half of estate for life, and the rest to my children. I make my wife sole executor, and my brothers Clement and George Ellsworth, overseers. Witnesses, Abraham Moll, Johanes Poulies, William Huddlestone. Proved before Lord Cornbury, January 10, 1704/5.

In her will, she wrote: I, Anna Van Slyck, of New York, widow of David Van Slyck, "being greatly advanced in years." To my two daughters Josentie, wife of Richard Bidder, and Elizabeth, wife of Thomas Wendover, all my household stuff and wearing apparell. Of all the rest of my estate I leave 1/2 to my daughter, Josentie Bidder, for life, and then to her two children, Anna Collister and Dorothy Bidder, widow of Richard Bidder, Jr. The other 1/2 to my daughter, Elizabeth Wendover, and I make my two daughters executors. He was living in the East Ward in 1703, and, besides his wife, had a family of four sons and two daughters, and two slaves. He was a butcher, and was admitted a freeman 18 Dec 1716.²

In his will, he wrote: August 8, 1727. I, George Ellsworth, Sr., of Turtle Bay, New York, "being well stricken in years, but in good health." After payment of debts, I leave all the rest of my estate, of houses, lands, and goods, to my wife Ariantie during her life, if she remains a widow, But if she remarry with any person whatsoever, then my estate to be sold at publick vendue, and 1/3 of the proceeds are to go to my wife. I leave to my eldest son Theophilus, my Great Dutch Bible. To my daughter Ariantie, a bed and bedstead, and so much as shall be sufficient to buy her a new wedding suit of apparell. All the rest of my estate I leave to my children, Theophilus, John, George, Ashuerus, and Ariantie. I make my wife, and my sons, Theophilus and Ashuerus executors. Witnesses, Gerard Beekman, Joseph Latham, Edward Pennant. Proved, February 11, 1733/4.¹

The proclamation of their marriage banns was found in the Archives of Amsterdam: 1 June 1647, Theophilus Elswaert from Bristol, mariner, 22 years old, having no parents [then living], living in the Smitstechje [Little Smith Alley], & Annetje Jans from Amsterdam, 24 years old, living on the Boomsloot. In the margin: the banns have been published in the English church.³

Stoffel Elswaert (Theophilus Elsworth) from Bristol made an agreement on 25 April 1652 before Notary J. de Winter at Amsterdam with Dirck Claesz Boot, skipper of the '*de Romeyn*', to sail to New Netherland "for adventure and half the profit".

He acknowledged having received from the latter 154 gl. in advance.¹

He was a mariner and a shipwright.

On July 8, 1656, Stoffel "Eduwartsen" bought of Cornelis van Tienhoven, "a lot in the Smith's valley on the East river," on Pearl Street (VM-1861:587). This is the same property which he disposes of in his will. The tract of land mentioned was on the north side of Pearl street, and extended from Ferry street to the Brooklyn Bridge, or near it.¹

In his will, he wrote: 9th of April, 1706. I, Theophilus Ellsworth, of New York, being in health. My debts are to be paid "and the funerals of my body being such only as shall become a Christian, to be likewise paid." I leave to my eldest son Clement, as a bar to all claim as heir at law, a certain lot or parcel of land lying or being on the northeast side of that my large lot or parcel of ground within the bounds of this city of New York containing 30 feet in breadth to the highway and in the rear next to the Swamp belonging to said city, 19 feet 9 inches, and is bounded on the northeast side by land of the widow Clopper, on the south west side by other lands of mine. I leave the rest of my land there to my three sons Clement, George and William, an equal share in breadth, front and rear. My son George is to have the one-third part next to the land of William Beekman, being the southwest part. The next third is to William, and the other third, being the north east part, to Clement. And they are to pay to my grandson Theophilus Ellsworth, son of my son Johanes, deceased, £12. All the rest of my estate I leave to my three sons George, Clement and William, and to the children of my son Johannes deceased, and the children of my daughters Elizabeth, Judith and Christina. My executors are to sell all estate except what is above specified, within twelve months. For the time I have lived with any of my children, they shall receive for each year's board the sum of £15. I make my sons Clement and George and Samuel Staats and Captain Johanes De Peyster, executors. Witnesses, Giles Shelley, Burger Mynderse, William Huddleston. Proved, February 21, 1715/16.²

To my daughter, Elizabeth, a negro man or £45, and to my son, Cornelius, the same, and also all household furniture (except wrought plate); Also 6 large silver spoons and 6 tea spoons. I leave to my son Theophilus, a negro man or £45. To my son, Verduyn Ellsworth, a negro man or £45, and also £70 when he is of age. My executors are to pay for the maintenance and schooling of my sons Theophilus and Verduyn, £30 yearly. All the rest of my estate, real and personal, I leave to my children, Ariantie, Elizabeth, Cornelius [a correction to the transcribed wills changes this name to Cornelia], Theophilus, and Verduyn, and 1/6 to my four grand children. I make my son-in-law, Thomas Seymour, of New York, mariner, and my son-in-law, John Beekman, merchant, and my daughter, Cornelia, executors. Witnesses, John Earle, John Roosevelt, Jr., E. Blagge. Proved, November 22, 1745.¹
