The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

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Felter

The Hackensack Valley Felter family is said to have originated in Hamburg, Germany, where the name was Velta. The surname may be an evolving interpretation of Felter/Felten=Valentyn=Walter.

William Felter came to America in 1709/10 with the Palatines and settled in the Bergen Co., NJ/Orange Co., NY vicinity. He was known as "William DeHoogduitser."

Johann Wilhelm Velten made his initial appearance on the Hunter Lists 1 July 1710 with 3 pers. over 10 and one under 10. The household showed 2 pers. over 10 and 1 under 10 4 Aug 1710, and 4 pers. over 10 yrs. on 4 Oct 1710. Wm. Wallantin was in Col. Thomas Ffarmer's Regt., 5th Company, in NJ in 1715.

William Felter came to America in 1709/10 with the Palatines and settled in the Bergen Co., NJ/Orange Co., NY vicinity. He was known as "William DeHoogduitser." He purchased land in the southern part of Quaspack or the Pond Patent before 1750, and had a farm near what was later known as Valley Cottage, Rockland Co., NY.

Christina Schmidt was probably related (prob. a sister) to Maria Gertraud Schmidt, dau. of Gerlach Schmidt of Oberfis-chbach, the wife of Hermann Hoffman.

His will (William Felter/Felten of Orange Co.) was dated 25 Feb 1755, probated 30 Apr 1755. in it he mentions grandson Peter Felter; wife Susanah; daughter Maritie Trumper; grandson William Felter; granddaughters Elizabeth Trumper and Christina Hopper. He appointed Cornelius Cuyper and Lambert Smith executors. Witnesses were Thomas Meegh [Fernow gives this name as Johannes Much], Jacobus Snider, Jr., and Abraham Onderdonk.

In another version of his will abstract: ...I, William Felter (Felten), of Orange County, being at present in good state of health. I leave to my grand son, Peter Felter, £10, in full bar as heir at law. To my wife Susanah 1/3 of all my personal estate, and one of my best cows, and £8 out of the bond of Tunis De Clark, which he is indebted to me. I leave to my daughter, Maritie Trumper, 100 acres of land of my Plantation joining to the land of John Rider, and equal in breadth from one end to the other, and she shall pay £5 to my grand son, Peter Felter, and to Elizabeth Trumper £18, and to my wife Susanah 20 shillings a year so long as she remains my widow. I give to my grand son, William Felter [Felten], the remainder of my lands and tenements joining to the land of Johanes Muge, and he shall pay £5 to my grand son, Peter Felter, and £18 to Christina Hopper, and to my wife 20s. a year during her widowhood. The other 2/3 of my personal estate to my daughter, Maritie Trumper, and my grand son, William Felter [Felten], and my two grand daughters, Elizabeth Trumper and Christina Hopper. I make Cornelius Cuyper and Lambert Smith executors. Dated February 25, 1755. Witnesses, Thomas Meegh, Jacobus Snider, Jr., Abraham Onderdonk. Proved in Court of Common Pleas, in Orange County, held at Orangetown on Wednesday, the 30 of April, 1755, before Abraham Haring, Esq., Judge, and Thunis De Kay, Rulof Van Hoesen, and Isaac Abraham Blauvelt, Justices. F. Matthews, Clerk.
