The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Jacob Ferdon was probably from the vicinity of La Rochelle, a Huguenot stronghold in France. Jacob was Secretary of the Dutch West Indies Company. There is no record of him ever being in New Netherland.

Mary Thomas Badye probably came to America after 1634, and prior to her second marriage. She probably came with her mother and step-father, Cornelis Lambertse Cool.

Mary Thomas Baddy's mother, Aeltje Brackhoengie married (1) Thomas Baddie; m. (2) Cornelis Lambertse Cool; m. (3) Willem Bredenbent.

Mary Thomas Badye was wealthy and gave a silver communion service to the Dutch church of Brooklyn.

She was "of Meppel in the province of Drenthe, a resident of Flatlands ("N. Amersfort") at the time of their marriage. He was of N.Y. In the NYC Ref Ch m. record they are "Jacob Verdon, j.m. Van N. Yorck, en Femmetje Willems, j.d. Van Meppelen, woonende tot N. Amersfort." In the translated Flatbush Ref Ch record of their betrothal, they were: Jacob Verdon, young man from N. York, residing there, with Femmetje Jans, young lade from Maspeth, residing in Amersfort.

They were both members of the Ref. Church at Flatbush, hailing from Brooklyn. Jacob (with seven children) appears on the census of 1698 as a resident of New Utrecht. They later removed to Schraalenburgh, NJ, where he died.²

He signed his name Jacop Fardon.²

In his will dated 3 Apr 1740, proved 17 March 1743 he wrote: In the name of God, Amen. I, Jacob Fardon, of Scraalinburgh, in Bergen County, New Jersey, yeoman, being very ancient, yet of sound mind, this April 3, 1740. I leave to my eldest son Thomas £10 and no more, and it is my will that he shall pay to my executors the sum of £275 for which he has given his bond to me, dated August 30, 1715. My executors are to pay my daughter Mary the sum of £6 yearly, after the death of her husband, Frans Vanderburgh. I leave to my son-in-law, Jacob Bennitt, £100; If he dies, then to his children. I leave to my daughter Jannettie, wife of Adolphus Brower, £100. To my daughter Femmittie, wife of Barent Bloom, £100. To my daughter Dericke, wife of Andries Westervelt, £100. All the rest of my estate, real and personal, I leave to my 3 sons, William, Jacob, and Johan, and make them executors. Witnesses, Abraham Harring, Hendrick Gisner, David Ogden. Proved, March 17, 1743.¹

Jacob was a carpenter and they lived in Dumont, NJ except for the years 1852-1855 when he was a cartman living at 132 Perry Street, NYC.

In 1843 Jacob acted as the trustee for his mother-in-law, taking title to the lands she was allotted by a division with her husband. On 8 June 1858, Rachel received a deed from her mother and Jacob, as trustee, for an acre of land on the north side of present East Madison Avenue, opposite Chestnut Street, in Dumont, probably the house where they were living with Rachel's mother and sister Margaret in 1850.

Jacob B. Ferdon, 38, carpenter, and Rachel, 32, were listed in the 1850 Federal Census, living in Hackensack Township, Bergen County, NJ. Listed living with them were: James, 12; Margaret, 10; Daniel, 7; Abraham D., 4; and Henry, 1.

Living with Jacob and Rachel in Hackensack Township, Hackensack P.O. at the time of the 1860 Census (Jacob was listed as a carpenter) was Margaret Durie, 65, widow.

On 2 April 1766, Zachariah Ferdon, Jacob Ferdon, and John Ferdon were among the subscribers to the Glebe for Poughkeepsie.¹

John Ferdon Jr. was on the Poughkeepsie tax lists in February 1753, then without the "Jr." from June 1753 to 1769, and then again as John Jr. from 1770 to 1778. On the 1771 list he was listed between John Miller and Gulian Ackerman.

Poss his will: In his will dated 14 Aug 1779, probated 1 Nov 1779 "John Ferdon, of Poughkeepsie Precinct, Dutchess County," mentioned son Johannis; youngest daughters Elizabeth and Gertruy; daughters Mary, Catharine, Phebe; son-in-law Henry Scott. Made brothers Zachariah Ferdon and Jacob Ferdon executors. Witnesses were Johannis Ferdon, Zachariah Ferdon, Richard Snedeker.

Annatje may have died before her husband wrote his will on 14 Aug 1779; however a "Widow John Furdon" was a patient of Dr. Stephen Thorn of New Hackensack in 1791.

His land is cited as a boundary in the following deed: On 11 February 1804 (recorded 15 March 1804, Bergen Co. R:399) David Anderson of Harington, and Geertye, his wife, conveyed to Stephen Powles of the same place, for £215, about 40 acres of woodland in Harington at a place called Closter Mountain, beginning at NW corner of David Naugel's Mountain Woodland; mentioned are edge of Steep Rocks thence to Hudson River. Bounded N by land of John W. Ferdon and John

Parsel; S by said David Naugel; W by Johannes H. Blauvelt; E by Hudson River. Signed by David Anderson, Gertye Anderson (her mark). Witnessed by David A. Demarest, John D. Haring.³

John Ferdon (probably this John Ferdon) dated his will 5 Dec 1817 at which time he lived in the clapboard house at what is now 102 Blanch Avenue, Closter, Bergen County, NJ. His estate then included 165 acres of farm, dairy, and dwellings. The original and larger tract on which the house at 102 Blanch Avenue stands was purchased in 1749 by Wilhelmus Ferdon, and then included almost 500 acres of land.¹

William Ferdon of Orangetown, eldest son of the decedent, was granted Letters of Administration on the Estate of John W. Ferdon of Harrington, Bergen Co., N. J., whose will was probated in Bergen County. Jul. 30, 1841.

Thomas Verdon settled in the Gowanus section of Brooklyn, where he lived on a farm later owned by Anthony Hulst and still later by Henry Story and Winant Bennet.

He was a magistrate in Brooklyn, 1661-2-3-4. amd took the oath of allegiance as a resident of Brooklyn and a native of New Netherland in Sep 1687.

8 April 1656 -- Tomas Verdon requests by petition, as before, that Burgomasters and Schepens would be pleased to favor him with the office of Beer Carrier together with Barent Jansen, whereas he, being a native of this country, has been driven away from his [place?]. Whereupon it was endorsed and disposed--The petitioner Tomas Verdonck is accepted to the office of Wine and Beer Carrier, with Barent Jansen, and in place of the departed Beer Carrier, according to previously issued instructions, and has consequently taken the proper oath of allegiance in Court, and is confirmed in the aforesaid office. Done in the Court of Schout, Burgimasters and Schepens, absent Allard Anthony. This 8th April 1656.¹

Thomas Verdon was of Brooklyn at the time of his (2) m. to the widow of Tobias Teunissen (or Toemszen); they both joined the Brooklyn church in 1661.

19 June 1659 -- (prenuptial agreement before the Orphanmasters) Whereas Tomas Verdon, widower of Barbara Imbroeck, intends to marry again with Janneke Bones, widow of Tobias Teunissen; and as he has a little son Jacobus, by the said Barbara Imbroeck, about 3 years old, to whom, before the marriage the maternal inheritance must be proved, so that when he comes of age and married he may have what belongs to him. Therefore, the Orphan Masters of the City appoint as guardians and administrators Mr. Paulus Van der Beeck and Joannes de la Montagne, Junior, who are hereby authorized to make such an agreement with the widower on behalf of the child concerning huis maternal inheritance, debts and credits as equity demands, reporting the same to this Board on Saturday, June 21, at y O.C.A.M.. Done June 19, 1659."²

In a prenuptial agreement before the Orphanmasters 9 April 1659, "Janneke Bones, appearing before the Board is directed, whereas she intends to marry again, she must settle on her children their paternal inheritance. Answering she offers to give each child 50 florins, and states she has four children called Herman Urbanus, 17 years; Neeltje Urbanus, 16 years; Urbanus Urbanus, 10 years, and Teunis Teunissen, 8 years, for whom Abraham Clock and Evert Duyckinck are appointed guardians."²

On October 2, 1765, Wilhelmus Ferdon and his wife conveyed to Wilhelmus Ferdon Jr. a tract of 234 acres at Rockland, which may actually have been the stone homestead property at what is now 366 Fourteenth St., Norwood, Bergen Co., NJ.

Wilhelmus Ferdon served in the Revolution, from New Jersey.

On 5 May 1785 Gabriel H. Ludlow (executor of the will of Henry Ludlow, late of New York City), of New York City, conveyed to Wilhelm Ferdon, farmer, of Harrington, Bergen County, for £1215, 243 acres in Harrington Township...corner to Johann H. Blauvelt, Roelief Van Houten, Derick Vervalen, deceased...Henry Ludlow in his will dated 8 Jan 1780 named as executors: Gabriel H. Ludlow, William H. Ludlow, Richard Morris, and Charles Shaw. Signed Gabriel H. Ludlow. Witnessed by Johann H. Blauvelt, David Haring.¹

The name of Wilhelmus Ferdon appeared on the September 1779 Tax list of Harrington Township for 286 acres, 7 horses, 12 cows, 6 hogs, a slave, and a riding chair. At that time he also has the sum of 1125 pounds out at interest. This was the largest personal estate levy in all of Harrington Township in September 1779.¹

In his will, dated 23 Apr 1808, pr 29 Sep 1810, Wilhelmus Ferdon of Haring, in Bergen Co., yeoman, mentions wife Tietje, son John, daughters Bracye and Maria (wife of John Mabie); grandson Wilhelmus Mabie; Tietje and John (children of son Jacob, dec'd). Executors were son Johanes Ferdon and son-in-law Abraham A. Haring. Witnesses were Benj. Blacklidge,

Stephen Powls, and John Haring. Mentioned are a salt meadow bought of John Sneedon, woodland bought of Thomas Ludlow, land and buildings where daughter now dwells "at a place called the Slotte." Also mentioned are silver spoons and a silver bell, a clock, and slaves Bet and Shariton (and her male child, Toby).

An inventory of the estate (valued at \$134.70) was made 1 Oct 1810 by Benj. Blacklidge and Abraham Ferdon.

They lived at Piermont, Rockland Co., NY where he operated a woolen mill, producing blankets as well as yarn.

William Ferdon, 62, farmer (with property valued at \$75,000!), and Elizabeth, 57, were listed in the 1850 Federal Census, living in Orangetown, Rockland County, NY. Listed with them were John W. Ferdon, 22; Frederick Lindleton {Sindleton?}, 33 (b. Germany); Nancy Dikeman, 40, black; and Mary Mabie, 21 (b. Ireland).

William Ferdon, 75, farmer, owner of land, and his wife, Elizabeth, 72, mother of one child, were listed in the 1865 New York State Census, living in Orangetown, Rockland County, NY.
