

-- **FREDERICKS** --

The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

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Frederick, Fredericks, Frederickse, Fredricksen

Several families are grouped under this heading and surname.

One was the family of Thomas Frederickson, whose children took the surname Thomas/Thomasen; Thomas's son Frederick Tomasen, m. Catryna Hopper and had children who took the surname Frederickse/Fredricksen. Apparently most of those in this family eventually took the surname "Cadmus."

Another separate and distinct family was that of the 1709 Palatine emigrant, Conrad Frederick.

Abraham Frederick, 37, farmer, and Mary Frederick, 33, along with their children, were listed in the 1850 Federal Census, living in the Town of Ramapo, Rockland County, NY. Listed living with them were: George, 11; Sarah, 10; Emma, 5; Mary, 3; and Edward, 4/12.

Koenraat Fredrik (Conrad Friderich) emigrated with the 5th party of 1709 (Rotterdam Lists) with a group of Palatines from the Nassau-Darmstadt region who eventually settled in New Jersey. These included the families of Koenraat and Bastiaan Meinsinger, Peter Wannemager and Adam Labag.

On the (Governor) Hunter List of 1 July 1710, are the names of Conrad Frederick aged 52, Anna Maria Frederick aged 45, John Peter Frederick aged 14, and John Conrad Frederick aged 13. According to Jones, the family remained in New York City in 1710/11.

Other sources claim that Conrad Frederick and his family came to the Ramapo Tract in as early as 1710 with a group of German Palatine immigrants. At any rate, he was definitely settled in the Mahwah area of Bergen Co., NJ by 1713, when as a settler on the Ramapo Tract, he received provisions including a bushel of wheat and 1 skipel of peas (9 Apr 1713); 6 fathoms of white roap (17 Apr 1713); 2 bushels of wheat (10 May 1713); and 2 bushels of indian corne (26 May 1713). The couple, with 2 children, were listed in the Simmendinger Register as living at Hackensack about 1716/17.

Coert Fredrik & Anna Maria Wysing, witnessed the baptism 10 Jan 1711 NYC Ref Ch, of Anna Maria, dau. of Lodewyk Peerts & Catharina Lapping.

A Bergen County Road Return dated 9 June 1744 to "alter a four rod road at Maawier in the precinct of Saddle River over the Land of Konraet Vreericks and Adolph Sioert" was recorded at the request of Adolph Sioert. Landmarks cited were the division line of Koenraet Vreericks and Johannis Slot; the highway by Samuel Bush Black Smith.¹ This may refer to this Conrad Frederick, or possibly to his son (John) Conrad Frederick.

In the marriage record they are: "Frericksen, Coenraad, y.m., born at Kanckna [Campgaw?], living at Tawacha [Towaco?], and Sara Hosck, y.d., born at Vyle Kill, living at Tawacha."

A Bergen County Road Return dated 3 July 1759 was recorded at the request of Coenraad Frederiks, regarding a road "in the precinct of Saddle River in the county of Bergen at a place called Mawier." The road to be continued "leads from Saml Bushes to Ramapough and Laroes Mills"; they altered the road that leads from Laroes Mills to the Road that leads from Ramapough to Hackensack that was laid out in the year 1758. The surveyors laid out "another Road from Saml. Bushes to the Burying place as the old Road formerly runs;" the surveyors altered "another Road that Leads to/from George Dearman's to the Burying place to Lay out another [four rod] Road beginning at the west Corner of George Dearman's House between the Line of sd. Dearman & Nicolaes Mysinger and so to the Road that Leads from the Iron Works to Hackensack."²

(Vol. II, p. 114)...While at Ramapo, Mr. Alexander found several other settlers who wished to take leases of the Proprietors and be protected against the Fauconier Company (including five who had already taken leases of Fauconier & Co.). On 13 April 1740 Derick Vandermaker (Wanamaker) and William Ramsay came to New York and showed Alexander and Ashfield two leases. [this appears to be an agreement to protect Elizabeth's rights to personal behavior and household goods, with land going to Weart Valentine], for \$1 from Elizabeth to Robert. Signed by Robert Fredericks, Weart Valentine, Elizabeth Fredericks. Witnessed by Thomas Bletcher, James Pike, and Jno. B. Fisk.¹

On 1 February 1804 (recorded 2 July 1805, Bergen Co. U:309) Robert Fredericks of the City of New York, conveyed to Weart Valentine of the same place, cartman, Trustee of Elizabeth Fredericks, wife of said Robert, in consideration of Articles of Separation) 23-78/100 acres in New Jersey, beginning SW corner of Morris Sharp on E bounds of Peter Demarest; mentioned land of Conrad Knact; S side of Hohaukus Brook; land of Albert Van Dien. Bounded W by Peter Demarest; S by Conrad Knact and Albert Wilson; N by Morris Sharp. Signed by Robt. Fredericks, Weart Valentine (his mark). Witnessed by James Pike, Jno. B. Fish.¹
