The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In January 1920 they were living in a house they owned on West Crescent Avenue in Allendale, Bergen Co., NJ. They lived in a house built about 1896 on a lot north of the Pulis house, given Hosey by his father. This house was the last house in the Borough of Allendale on the west side of Crescent Avenue.

They were listed in the 1900 Federal Census, New Jersey, Bergen Co., Borough of Allendale, District 1, p. 4, enumerated 4 June 1900, Dwelling 44, Family 47 -- Gamble, Hosey A., Head, b. Dec 1876, age 23, m. 3 yrs., b. NJ, his father b. NY, his mother b. NJ, Farm Laborer; [Gamble], Dora A., Wife, b. Oct 1874, age 25, married 3 yrs., b. NY, her parents b. NJ. They were listed just after the family headed by James (age 50) & Margaret A. (age 49) Gamble.

They were listed in the 1920 Federal Census, New Jersey, Bergen Co., Allendale Borough, District 1, p. 18, enumerated 23 January 1920, Crescent Avenue, Dwelling 223, Family 237 -- Gamble, Hosey, Head, Owned home, age 43, b. NJ, his father b. NY, his mother b. NJ, genral laborer; [Gamble], Dora, Wife, age 45, b. NJ, her parents b. NJ; [Gamble], Dorothy, daughter, age 16, b. NJ; [Gamble], Archibald, son, age 5, b. NJ. Listed just after them was the family headed by James (age 72) & Margaret (age 69) Gamble.

James Gambell was listed in the 1865 New Jersey State Census, living in Hohokus Township, Bergen County, NJ. He was listed between the George F. Hosey family and the Richard C. Straut family.

James and Margaret Ann Gamble lived in a house just north of 209 E. Crescent Avenue, Allendale, Bergen Co., NJ. This house is shown in Walker's 1876 Bergen County Atlas, where the house is labelled "Pulis." This Pulis family was headed by Abraham Pulis and his wife Margaret Straut, in-laws of James J. Gamble. All that remains of this house is a laid-up stone well close to Crescent Avenue.

Later, James Gamble and his wife Margaret Ann Pulis lived in the house at 209 East Crescent Ave., Allendale, which was built in 1895. They owned a large farm. The barns were on the east side of Crescent Avenue. The property extended to what is today (1992) the Allendale Nursing Home.

They were listed in the 1880 Federal Census, New Jersey, Bergen Co., Hohokus Township, District 5, p. 35, enumerated 25 June 1880, Dwelling 323, Family 365 (all b. NJ, all their parents b. NJ except as noted) -- Pulis, Margaret, 60, widow; Gamble, James, 31, Son in Law, b. L.I., his parents b. L.I.; [Gamble], Margaret, 31, Wife; [Gamble], Mary, 6, Daughter; Hosey G. [looks like Harry G.], 8, Son; [Gamble], Lucinda, 1, Daughter; Sarvent, John, 23, Single, Laborer.

In 1925 they had a smaller house built at 225 E. Crescent Avenue, Allendale, Bergen Co., NJ.

He was an officer and was wounded in the Revolution, serving from New Jersey. His home then was in Burlington, NJ. He was appointed by Gov. Livingston of New Jersey as a Brigade Major and adjutant of Gen. Dickinson's brigade of Jersey militia. He gave a lengthy account of his service in his application for a Revolutionary War pension in July 1832. Also in the Pension papers were included information about his life after the Revolution, but very little personal or family information. In that testimony he said that after the Revolution he had lived in New York, but for the last 20 years he had lived in Washington, D.C., where he then lived. His sons were all in the service of their country.
