The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

All my whole estate is to remain in the hands of my wife Nelly during the time of her being my widow. If she marries, my executors are to sell all, and my wife is to have £100. I leave all the rest to my 5 children "now born, and the child as my dear wife is like to have" (names not given). I make Joseph Christopher, Daniel Gerbrantz, and my wife, executors. Witnesses, Peter Housman, Marcus Miner. Proved, March 11, 1773.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, John Haugewout, of New Lots, in Kings County, being in health, November 22, 1770. I leave to my son John £100. After all debts are paid, I leave all the rest of my estate to all my children, Leffert, Hermon, John, Cornelia, and Alche. My eldest son, Leffert, shall keep my son John's part, allowing him 10 or 12 pounds a year during his natural life. But in case of sickness or other misfortune, he is to allow him as much more as he thinks proper. I make my son Leffert and my trusty friend, Cornelius Wyncoop, executors. (Signed, Jan Eagewout.) Witnesses, Guysbert Bogart, Stephen Ryder, Titus Titus. Proved, April 21, 1773.

**Femmetje Hermans**

Pieter Janse Hoogwout emigrated to New Netherland about 1660, with his wife, Femmetje Hermanse, and two (or three) sons: Leffert Pieterse, and Pieter Pieterse. After his death, guardians were appointed at court at Midwout (Flatbush) for his two minor sons.

A Pieter Janse from Drenthe, shoemaker, his wife and four children, aged 15, 13, 9 and 1/2 years, sailed 15 April 1660 from Amsterdam on the *Bonte Koe* for New Netherland.<sup>1</sup> But it cannot be determined with certainty that this person was identical to Pieter Janse Haughwout.<sup>2</sup>

He was the immigrant, Pieter Janszen from Dyckhuysen in the Drenthe Province of the Netherlands. He seems always to have used his patronymic, Pieter Janszen. His sons did not all adopt the same surname; descendants variously used Haughwout, Hagewout, Johnson, [Janszen], Lefferts, and Hockabout.

In his will he wrote: ...November 27, 1745. I, Peter Hazewout, of Staten Island, being very sick, I leave to my wife Neeltie, all lands and tenements during her widowhood, and after her death to my two sons Peter and Nicholas; all my lands in Richmond County next adjoining to the land now in possession of Dowe Van Wogelum, with all meadows and messuages. I leave to each of my two younger sons, Egbert and John, £100. To my daughter Dirckje, £10. All the rest of my estate, real and personal, to my 5 children, Catharine, wife of Johans Brestede, Dirckje, Neeltje, Gertruyd, and Margaret. My daughter Catharine's part is not to be paid till after the death of her husband, "and her husband is not to intermeddle or have anything to do with the same," nor shall it be liable to pay any of his debts. I leave to my 4 daughters, Catrina, widow of John Brested, Dirckje, Nelly, wife of Anthony Brat, and Maritie, the house and land I bought of Thomas Dongan, lying in the Manor, and all the remainder of my movables. I make my son Egbert and John Merrall executors. March

"I having made my last will, and disposed of all my estate except £53 9s 6d which I had forgot to mention," All debts and funeral expenses are to be paid out of the same, and the remainder to my 4 daughters.
