

-- HALLENBEEK, HAULENBECK --

The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Casper Jacobse [Hallenbeck] m. (poss Lysbet)

Kaspar Jacobsz was the original immigrant to America arriving sometime around 1650. Concerning his origins, little is known and much is speculated. Various genealogies written over the centuries stated that he was German, giving his place of birth as Schleswig-Holstein, while others stated that he was Dutch. What little we know has been gleaned from the antique records the Dutch kept before the colony of New Netherlands became the English colony of New York.¹

A.J.F. Van Laer, the renowned historian of New Netherlands and translator of many of the Dutch records, assumed that Kaspar's place of birth was the hamlet of Hollenbek in the Dutchy of Holstein, about twenty miles south of Kiel. This seems to be the place of origins that most of his researchers accept.¹

Kaspar Jacobs did not use the surname Hallenbeck -- this particular surname didn't come into existence until two generations later.

He was in Beverwyck by 1651, when his name appears on a legal document. He signed with the initials "K.Y." indicating that he spelled his name, most probably, Kaspar Yackobsz.

Signed by Garret Hawlenbeck and Hannah Hawlenbeck. Witnessed by Mary Earle, Guilliam Bertholf and Reynier Van Giesen.¹

On 12 May 1798 (recorded 25 Jan 1804, Bergen Co. R:324) Garret Haulenbeck and Hannah, his wife, of Bergen Woods, conveyed to Enoch Smith of same place, for £5, 15 acres being one certain part or moiety in Bergen Woods, Bergen Precinct, now in possession of said Enoch Smith, [a portion of] 15 acres belonging to estate of Phillip Smith of Seacaucus, dec'd, and bequeathed to said Enoch Smith by his Last Will and Testament. Signed by Garret Halenbeck, Hannah Halenbeck. Witnessed by Abel Smith, John Daly.²

On 12 May 1798 (recorded 30 Dec 1805, Bergen Co. X:27) Enoch Smith and Phebe, his wife, of Bergen Woods in Bergen Precinct, conveyed to Cornelius Buskirk and Deborah, his wife of Staten Island, and Garret Haulenbeck and Hannah, his wife, of Bergen Precinct, for £5, part of 15 acres belonging to Estate of Philip Smith of Seacaucus, deceased, and bequeathed to Deborah the wife of Cornelius Buskirk and to Hannah the wife of Garret Haulenbeck, beginning at road leading to Hoe-buck ferry. Signed by Enoch Smith, Phebe Smith (her mark). Witnessed by Abraham Lozier, John Daly.²

Jan Caspersen, one of the family who took the name of Hallenbeek, lived at Coxackie. His son-in-law, Jan Van Loon, was the owner of the Patent of Loonenburgh, a part of which is occupied by the village of Athens in Greene County. His descendants are numerous in that region.

On December 28, 1699, Jan became a justice of the City and County of Albany as a Coxsackie member. He was reappointed July 17, 1701 and again on March 7, 1702. He served as an elder of the Lutheran Church and church services were held in his Coxsackie home between 1705 and 1711. Jan was a deacon between 1711 and 1723.¹

In his will, he wrote: May 6, 1725. I, Jan Caspersen, of Albany County, yeoman. I leave to my eldest son, William Caspersen Hallenbeck, £3, in right of primogeniture. I confirm all deeds given in writing to my children. I leave to my wife Rachel, all the rest of my estate during her life. I leave to my son, Caspar Janse Hallenbeck, my negro man "John" and his wife; and he is to pay £45 to the rest of my children; Also all my clothing of linnen and woolen, and my books, Fuzees, swords, saddles, and bridles. To my daughter Elizabeth, wife of Jacob Evertsen, a negro boy. To my daughter Rachel, wife of Jan Jacobse Van Hoesen, a negro man. To my children, Marike, wife of Jurian Claw, and Rebecca, wife of Jan Van Loon, and to my daughters above named, all household goods after the death of my wife, and they are to have the £45 to be paid by my son Caspar Janse Hallenbeck. I make my wife, Rachel Casperse, and my son, Caspar Janse, executors. Witnesses, Abraham Cuyler, Nicholas Bleeker, Rutgert Bleeker. Proved, April 23, 1735, before Myndert Schuyler. At that time the widow, Rachel, was dead.
