The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

He was in Captain John Bacon's company, Colonel David Rosseter's regiment, at Stillwater, in 1780. After the revolution he settled at Williston, Vermont. In 1790 the first federal census shows that he had in his family at Williston, Chittenden county, four males over sixteen, two under that age, and six females; his son Stephen was head of a family, consisting of wife and two sons under sixteen, and his son Content had only two males over sixteen in his family.

He married Sarah Chamberlin at Richmond, Massachusetts. He had six sons, all of whom settled in Richmond, Vermont: Stephen, Content (Chamberlin), Joseph, John, Isaac, Amos.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, James Halliock, of Southold in the County of Suffolk, being weak of body. I leave to my son James the house and land whereon I now live, bounded south on the road, west on a lane, north on Daniel Alditch, and easterly on Richard Howell and Micah Howell, containing about one hundred and twelve acres. Also, another piece of land containing thirty acres, bounded westerly by the heirs of the late Capt. Conkling, easterly by Capt. Richard Howell, southerly by Isaac Reeve, and northerly by the road. Also, all my meadow ground in Southold or elsewhere, with all edifices, building, fences, ways, easements, and appurtenances, provided my son James shall pay to my two sons, Jeremiah and Benjamin, £50 each when they arrive to the age of twenty-one years. Unto my son William my lot of land bounded westerly on Samuel Hudson and Daniel Worner, southerly by Thomas Conkling, easterly by the land late of David Horton, north by the road, containing about ninety acres. My executors are to sell ten or fifteen acres of the above piece of land for the payment of my just debts. Unto my Son Thomas one piece of land adjoining westerly to Zerobable Halliock, south and east by Micah Howell, and north by the road, containing about thirty acres. To my two sons, Jeremiah and Benjamin, £50 each; to be paid them by my son James when they shall arrive to ye age of twenty-one years, respectively; or on his neglect, by my executors. To my wife Mary three cows, and to keep fifteen sheep of my stock until my youngest child shall arrive to ye age of ten years, after that six sheep; which I freely give her. All my indoor moveables (except my silver tankard) two fat cattle, my fattening hogs, and a sufficiency of grain and produce now growing, for an ensuing year. All which I freely give her during her widowhood. To my two daughters, Mary and Abigail, £5 each. To my son William my silver tankard. All the remainder of my personal estate to be sold. I make my wife, Mary Halliock, my two brothers, Zerobable and Joseph, executors. Dated September 22, 1774. Witnesses, Parker Wickham, Mica Howell, yeoman, Richard Steer Hubbard, yeoman. Proved, December 14, 1775.

In his will, he wrote: "...I, John Hallock, of Brookhaven, in Suffolk County, being this 16 day of the 9th month, called September, in the year 1764, far advanced in years, and sick and weak, but through Divine mercy I have my understanding and memory as quick and sound as can be expected, and knowing that in a short time I must yield unto Death, and am willing to set my house in order." I will and devise all my houses, lands, meadows, and Rights of land which I have in Brookhaven to my executors to be sold in the best manner they can, and turned into money. I leave all my apparell to my two sons Edward and Samuel. I leave to my son Samuel and my son-in-law, Abraham Underhill, £200 to pay for the land that my son Edward bought of Jesse Hallock, on condition that my son Edward release and give up a piece of meadow for which I gave him a deed of gift. I leave to the children of my deceased last wife Phebe £100, as follows: To her son-in-law, John Haviland, £7, "which he oweth me," "And the remainder, which is £93, I will to the children of my last deceased wife Phebe which she had by her second husband, Abner Hunt (names not given). My executors are to take so much money as they think necessary and put it at interest for my sister, Abiel Hallock, so long as she shall live. After her decease, my executors are to put £50 at interest for the support of my cousin, Clement Willets, during her life, "and after her death, the interest to go to support the poor amongst Friends belonging to the monthly meeting of Westbury." "My executors are to pay to Abraham Lawrence, of Flushing, £35 that I have promised to pay for my son Edward, being what I suppose is yet due out of £100." Of all the rest of my estate, I leave to my daughters, Sarah Hunt and Abigail Powell, each 1/8. To the children of my deceased daughter, Hannah Satterly, 1/8. To the 3 children of my deceased son, John Hallock, viz., Samuel, Daniel, and Phebe, 1/8. To my daughter, Catharine Powell, 1/8. To the children of my deceased daughter, Phebe Underhill, 1/8. To my son Samuel 1/8, and to my daughter, Amy Underhill, 1/8. I make my loving friends, Richard Willits, of Jericho, in Queens County, John Whitson, 2d, of Bethpage, and Thomas Pursell, of Bethpage, executors, with power to sell, and they are to be reasonably paid. Witnesses, Samuel Willis, Benjamin Tyler, Daniel Jones. Proved, September 11, 1765.

In his will, he wrote: "...I, John Hallock, of North Castle, in Westchester County, mill wright, this 26 day of the 3d month, called March, 1757, being something indisposed, in order to settle my affairs, so as to prevent any contention, do make this my last will." My whole estate, real and personal, lands and meadows, and movables, are to be sold at public vendue. I leave to my wife Martha the use of £100 during her widowhood, but if she marries she is to have £35. I leave to my eldest son John, £300. To my second son James, £250. He supposedly came to New Haven in 1640, landed at Southold in 1640, went back to England and returned in 1642/3, but no direct evidence of his existence has been found.

Peter Hallock, the first of the family to come to America, and one of the New Haven Colony, landed at Hallock's Neck, Southold, Long Island, in 1640, and settled near Mattituck. He came over with a company of Puritans with the Rev. Mr. John Youngs. According to a tradition in the family, Peter Hallock was the first of the thirteen men who composed the company, to set foot on the shore among the Indians at Southold. For this reason that part of the village was named Hallock's Neck, and the beach extending from it Hallock's Beach, names which are still retained. He purchased from the Indians the tract of land since called Oyster Ponds, now Orient, and then returned to England for his wife and on coming back with her found that the Indians had resold his property. He then bought about ten miles west of Mattituck. His wife was a widow when he married her, and had a son by her former husband, Mr. Howell. The only child of the second marriage was William.

In his will, he wrote: I, Samuel Hallock, of New Marlborough precinct, Ulster County, being infirm in body. I order the Bounds of my land to be settled by my executors. All my just debts and just incumbrances on my lands by former mortgages to be paid. Unto my beloved wife Sarah, the use of my real and personal estate while my widow. If she, with the advice and assistance of my other executors, shall judge it best or think it necessary at any time to sell any or the whole lands for to pay debts or mortgages, it is to be done. The balance of my estate, after payments are made, to remain in my wife's hands to deal out at her discretion unto any of my children as need may require, so long as she is my widow. If she marries "she to take up with a good horse and saddle, a good bed and furniture and £100." My estate to be divided into ten equal parts: Elijah and John Hallock to have equally between them, four parts; Ama Sands, Phebe, Deborah, Forster, Clemment, and James Hallock, to have the remaining six parts equally. After such partition, Forster and James to receive the interest of their respective shares until they come of lawful age. They to be put to suitable trades. An account to be kept of what Ama Sands may have had before the distribution, and to be considered as part of her portion. What my wife Sarah may deal out discretionarily is also to be deducted from my children's respective portions. Ama Sands to be charged with £60 advanced. "If Friends conclude to build a meeting house on the three acres of land which I proposed to give for that purpose, and was viewed by a Committee of Nine Partners Monthly Meeting, I order that at such time as they shall build said house for their security that my executors or heirs give such a deed as shall secure Friends to hold such land free and clear." I make my beloved wife Sarah, with my trusty friends, John Young, Nehemiah Smith, Caleb Merritt, and Benjamin Anthony, executors. Dated December 27, 1782. Witnesses, John Moore, of New Marlborough precinct, farmer; Thomas Hallock; John Moore, junior, of said precinct, farmer. Codicil. Any one or more of my executors to have full power and lawful authority to sell lands or give conveyance; to collect debts, and every other thing to complete my will. Dated January 20, 1783. William died, leaving a will dated Southold (township), February 10, 1682, and proved October 21, 1684, which is preserved in the ancient records both of Suffolk county at Riverhead and of New York City. He left his property to his wife, four sons and his five daughters. To Thomas and Peter he gave the farm where he lived, giving Thomas the western half, except the "swamp lot," and Peter the eastern half, including the said lot and his dwelling house. To William he left land near Southold village, and to John land on Wading river. The will implies deep sorrow that his son John had married into and joined the pre-scribed Society of Friends.<sup>2,4</sup>

In his will, probated 1 June 1765, he wrote: ...Ye forth day or March Anno quo: 1748-9 I, William Hallack of Brook Haven in Suffolk County and Colony of New York Yeoman, being perfect in health and Memory, thanks be to God for the same therefore calling to mind the mortality of Man, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain my Last Will and Testament, that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soule into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend unto the earth to be buried in a Christian decent manner according to the discession of my Executors hereafter named nothing doubting but to receive the same by the Mighty power of God and as touching such world estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life, I give, demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form.

Imprimis. I give and bequeath to Dinah my dearly beloved wife all my moveable estate after my just debts and funeral charges are paid out of the same by my Exts and also my whole estate both personall and real during her Widowhood and no longer excepting the Lott whereon my son Jesses house now stands being about Sixteen rods wide and to extend across the road Westward the same wedth to the end of my bounds and likewise a lott of the same wedth on the other side the length of my bounds to my son William and the homestead between these two Lotts and hill fronting to Richard and David equally be-

tween them at the Decease or Marriage of their Mother.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my sons Jesse William Richard and David after the decease or marriage of their Mother all the remainder of their lands and Meadows equally except Jesse and his part to be ten pounds the best so judged by reasonable men.

Item. I give and bequeath to my four daughters Mary Dinah Sarah and Elizabeth all my moveable estate equally among them to be divided after the expiration of the said widowhood, it is my will that the part which falleth to my daughter Mary Long wife to William Long to be given to her and her own disposal and not his for her own use and also that she may Lodg the same in any of her friends hands for her use, and I do hereby make and ordain my wife Dinah Hallock and my son Jesse Hallock my Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and ever other former Testaments Wills, Legacies, Bequests and Executors Whatsoever by me in any ways before named Willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written. William Hallock. Signed, Sealed, Published Pronounced and Declared by the said William Hallock as his last Will and Testament in the presents of us the subscribers Samuel Davis George Davis Jesse Willets.<sup>1</sup>

There is but one mention of him in the Brookhaven town records and that is in 1749, when he was assessed 3s. 3d. county tax.

In May, 1775, there was circulated for signing in Suffolk County the "Association" adopted by the inhabitants of the city of New York. This paper, or declaration of principles, was generally signed throughout the county and William Hallock was among the patriots who attached his signature thereto.

Between May, 1775, and July, 1776, he removed from Brookhaven to Greenwich, Conn., where his brother Jesse had purchased some property in 1765. It must have been after May, 1775, for on that date he signed the Association in Suffolk County, and before July, 1776, for on that date a census of the inhabitants of Suffolk County was made in which his name does not appear. Although he was attached to no particular branch of the service during the Revolution, he took, notwithstanding, an active part in the hostilities against the British during their occupancy of Long Island, being in command of a number of large whale boats which, heavily armed and well filled with volunteers, would descend unexpectedly upon the rich outposts on the northern shore of Long Island and cause considerable damage.

His wife was Sarah Saxton of Huntington, Long Island, born in 1723, a sister of Hannah Saxton who married Zephaniah Platt, whose sons were among the original settlers of Plattsburgh, N. Y. William Hallock is supposed to have died in Green-

wich about 1782. His wife survived him and after his death went to Westchester County, N. Y., with her youngest daughter Anne, who there married Lodowick Hackstaff. She lived with Anne (Hallock) Hackstaff in Sing Sing and New York for many years and died in the latter place in 1806. She was a member of the Episcopal Church and family tradition says that she was buried in St. Paul's churchyard. The church records contain no mention of her interment there, but they are incomplete and many of the inscriptions on the tombstones have been rendered so obscure by time and the elements that the names cannot be deciphered.
