The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Anthony Hoffman was elected a member of the Provincial Congress of the City of New York 23 May 1774; was appointed Judge of Dutchess Co., NY 3 May 1777, and was one of the Regents of the University of the State of New York in 1780.

In his will, dated 6 Feb 1784, probated 13 Jan 1785 Albany, NY, Anthony Hoffman of Kingston, Ulster Co., mentioned: wife Catherine; sons Nicholas, Abraham, and Anthony; daus. Catherine, Saretie, Jannetje and Marritie; and child of my dau. Annetie, dec'd, viz: Saretie. Executors were son Anthony and sons-in-law, John Addison and Hans Kierstede.

Hermann Hoffmann emigrated with the Palatines (prob. 1709-1710). In 1710/11, Hermanus Hoffman aged 30 and Maria Gertrude Hoffman aged 30 were recorded at Hackensack at John Lotz's (Palatines in N.Y. City). In some records of Hack Ref Ch 1711-1718 he is noted as Hermann de Hoogduitscher ("Herman the German").

Hermanus Hoffman owned a plantation or farm on the east side of Quaspeck Pond [Rockland Lake, in Rockland Co.] near the south end.

In his will dated 15 Feb 1752, probated April 1754, "Harmanus Hoffman, of Orange County" being sick. "I give a large brown shift, and one large Pewter Platter, to my eldest son Harmanus, in full bar of all claim as eldest son and heir at law." I leave to my wife Gertruye the whole income of all my estate, real and personal, during such time as she remains my widow. And then I leave all my real estate to my two sons, and my personal estate to my daughters. I leave to my son Harmanus 106 acres of land on the south side of my plantation, and he shall pay to my daughter Christina £4 a year for three years, and he is to pay to my daughter Rachel £12. I leave to my son, Jury Hoffman, 106 acres of land, during his life, lying on the north side of my plantation. After his death it shall go to his lawful issue, and he shall pay to my daughter, Catrina Snyder, £12. I leave to my daughter, Leaya Geslon, £8, and to my son Harmanus "all my farm tackling, slay, Plough, etc." All my household goods I leave to my daughters, Catrina, Christina, Rachel, and Leaya. I make Lambert Smith, Abraham Onderdonk, and Johannes Snedeker, executors. Dated February 15, 1752. Witnesses, Johannes Mudge, Peter Geslon, William Fenton. Proved at Court of Common Pleas, at Orange town, Orange County, on the last Tuesday in April, 1754, before Abraham Haring and Cornelius Cuyper, Judges, and Isaac Abraham Blauvelt, Rulof Van Houten, and Thunis De Kay, Justices. Fletcher Matthews, Clerk. [NOTE.--The testator seems to have lived not far from Rockland Lake, in Rockland County, which was formerly known as "Orange, south of the mountains." --W. S. P.]

He probably lived in Ezen, Ostenbenzie, Holland. He arrived in New Netherlands ca 1657 and first settled in Brooklyn, then to Albany, before removing to Ulster County.

In the first marriage record, he is "Van Revel" and she is "Van Oetmarsen in Overysseel." In the second marriage record, he is widower of Lysbeth Hermans; she is "j.d. Van Esens in Embderl<sup>h</sup>" [East Frisia; today Lower Saxony in Germany]. He emigrated from Sweden.

Emmerentje Claeszen DeWitt was the sister of Tjerk/Dirck Claeszen DeWitt.

In 1658 when the Indians became threatening in the vicinity of Esopus, and the garrison of soldiers stationed there had orders not to attack the Indians except in defense of the fort, Martin Hoffman led the settlers against the Indians, driving them away. For this he was reprimanded by the officials, but the people living about Esopus praised him for doing as he did.

Soon after this, he moved to New Amsterdam, later to Albany, and finally returned to Esopus, then Kingston. He was owner of a small vessel, and by trade a saddler.

Colonel Martin Hoffman moved across the Hudson River into Dutchess County, near Red Hook, on land which his father, Captain Nicholas Hoffman, had owned. He increased his holdings, becoming a large landowner, and in 1755 he owned ten negro slaves. This was more than were held by any other man in that part of Dutchess County.

Part of his life was passed at Kingston, and he was Justice and Judge. He was the owner of a large tract of land at Tivoli, in Dutchess County.

Colonel Martin Hoffman commanded the Dutchess County militia for many years. He also held many civil offices, being a judge for some years.

In his will, he wrote: I, Martin Hoffman, Esq., at present residing in the Out Ward of New York, being of sound and disposing memory," January 16, 1772. "Whereas by an ante-nuptial Contract dated September 24, 1766. I have agreed that my wife Alida shall have £300 yearly, during her widowhood, I do confirm the same, and my executors shall put £5000 at interest for the same, and after her death it shall go to my estate." I also leave her the use of two negro slaves, "Violette" and "Bastian." After her death I give "Bastian" to my son Philip. I leave to my son Zacharias £1700 before any division. I leave to my son Philip £1700, and to my daughter Mary £700. I leave to all my children all my mines and minerals on any of my lands. My executors may sell all my real estate, and the house and lot left to my wife, after her death. From the proceeds they are to pay to my sons, Nicholas, Robert, Anthony, Herman, Zachariah, and Philip, each 1/9 and the same to my daughters, Cornelia and Mary. I make my wife and my son Nicholas and my son-in-law, Isaac Roosevelt, and my brother, Zachariah Hoffman, executors. Witnesses, Anna De Haas, Robert Benson, Gent., Egbert Benson. Proved, October 9, 1772.

In their Kingston Ref Ch marriage record, they were: Nicolaes Hofman, born in Kingstowne, and Jannetie Crupel, born in Horly.

Captain Nicholas Hoffman lived in Kingston. He bought from Anthony Crispel in 1707 the lot of land at the northwest corner of Kingston with a stone building on it. On this spot, which was the most exposed in Kingston, he built a large stone

house which could be used as a garrison house or fort against any Indians attacking Kingston. This historic house was badly damaged when the British cannonaded and barbarously burned the town in 1777. The house was afterwards rebuilt in somewhat different shape, and, containing as it did some of the charred original beams, became one of the most historic buildings in the Hudson River Valley.

Captain Nicholas Hoffman served in the militia of Ulster County, whose duty it was to protect the settlers against the Indians who went on the warpath whenever France and England were at war.
