The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

In her will, she wrote: I, Petronella Luursens, widow of Carsten Luerson Jr., deceased, being at this present time very sickly." I leave one half of my estate to my dear and well beloved father, Abraham Vanderheuiill, and to my brothers, Johannes and Hendrick Vanderheuiill, and my sisters Elizabeth, wife of Captain Martin Clock, Catharine, wife of Albert Clock, Maria, wife of Peter De Mill, and Femitie, wife of Benjamin Wyncoop, in equal shares. The other half I leave to my father in law, Carsten Luurszen, Sr., and my sister in law Maria, wife of Johanes Van der Spiegel, Anna, wife of John Oldworthy, Aeltie, wife of (???) Lassenby, Beeltie, wife of Albert De Vries, and Gertruy Luurszen, equally. I make my father, Abraham Vanderheuiill,

and my father in law, Carsten Luersen, executors. Dated August 23, 1702. Witnesses, Abraham Staats, Hendrick Van der Spiegel, Robert Morris.

According to their marriage banns, he was 22 and had come to Amsterdam from Wageningen in the Gelderland Province. She was 21, and she had come from Enkhuisen in the North Holland Province.

In 1640, Jacob, Stynje, and their baby daughter Styntie arrived in Fort Orange, New Netherlands (now Albany, New York) on the ship *Princess* owned by the Dutch West India Company. Jacob was the brother of Urbanus Luurszen.¹ Jacob Luurszen and his brother Urbanus Luurszen were both stonemasons.

Jacob and his brother Urbanus (with wife Jannetie Claes Boanes) came to America to work for Rensselaer, possibly as mechanics. However, some records include details of shipping by the Dutch West India Company in which Jacob Luurszen is specifically mentioned as an officer. New York Historical Manuscripts contains a September 6, 1641 declaration of officers of the ship *The Angel Gabriel* who urged the captain to head for New Netherlands because of the disabled condition of their ship, signed by Jacob Luurszen as Chief Boatswain.¹

Another account dated January 1, 1648, tells of a complaint filed against Roulaf Cornelius who inflicted five wounds on Corporal Jacob Luurszen as the Corporal was trying to separate Cornelius and Casper Steinmetsel during a quarrel.¹

On 32 Aug 1647 a power of attorney was issued from Jacob Luurszen, Fort Amsterdam. It is found recorded in folio 161e, Vol. 2, of the series of Colonial Manuscripts of the State of New York, in the State Library at Albany. It was given to "Aeltje Symons, wife of Symon Jansen Breet, in Amsterdam, to collect 151 guilders, 7 stivers and 14 pence due him, from the West India Company, for wages earned in New Netherland."³

On 28 Nov 1651 Jacob Luurszen took oath as a colonist of Rensselaerwyck. On 18 June 1652 at the Court of Fort Orange & Beverwyck, Jacob Luurszen petitioned for property in Beverwyck.

Jacob, like other Dutch settlers, was granted a lot in Beverwyck near Fort Orange on October 25, 1653. Records show that he built a house and had a garden there until his death on April 29, 1655. He was survived by his wife Stynje, daughters Styntie, Jacobyntie, and Agneit, and only son Luer.

On 7 Feb 1657 at the Court of Fort Orange & Beverwyck, administrators were appointed for the estate of the children of Jacob Luurszen, deceased.

"20 Jun 1646 [notary H. Schaef, 1323/178] Urbanus Luurs from Wagenem [= Wageningen], about to sail as a mastr mason on the "Prinses" [i.e. the ship "Princess Amelia"] to New Netherland, settles a debt."²

Urbanes Luurszen was the brother of Jacob Luurs.¹

Urbanus drowned on a return trip to the Netherlands along with deposed Dutch Governor Kieft aboard the ship *de Princes*.

A power of attorney was given by the widow of Urbanus Luyerszen who was from Wageningen, to collect wages from the West India Company. This document bears date of September 16, 1648. It was given by "Janette Claes, widow of Urbanus Luyerszen Van Wageningen, in his life time a stone mason, in the service of the West India Company beforementioned, for 221 guilders, 1 stuyver and 5 1-3 pence, earned by her deceased husband on the ship Princess," or de Princess.

In a prenuptial agreement before the Orphanmasters, "Janneke Bones, appearing before the Board is directed, whereas she intends to marry again, she must settle on her children their paternal inheritance. Answering she offers to give each child 50 florins, and states she has four children called Herman Urbanus, 17 years; Neeltje Urbanus, 16 years; Urbanus Urbanus, 10 years, and Teunis Teunissen, 8 years, for whom Abraham Clock and Evert Duyckingh are appointed guardians."⁴
