The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

In his will, he wrote: "...I, Garrett Lefferts, of New York, merchant, being of sound mind, "but shortly intending a voyage to Sea, and considering the uncertainty of this transitory life." My executors are to pay all debts. I leave to my wife Elizabeth all household goods and kitchen furniture, and a negro woman and child, "and £50, to be paid by my executors as soon as they can raise that sum, over the debts." I leave to my brother, John Lefferts, Jr., my watch and wearing apparell. My executors are to turn all the rest of my estate into cash, and put it at interest for the benefit of my wife during widowhood. All the rest of my estate I leave to my brothers, Peter and John, and my sister Eida. I make my father, John Lefferts, Esq., of Flatbush, and my father-in-law, Baltus Van Kleek, merchant, and John McKesson, attorney at law, executors. Dated March 3, 1773. Witnesses, John Vredenburgh, peruke maker, Richard Wenman, John Myers. Codicil, March 3, 1773. If my sister Eida die without issue, her part is to go to her brothers. Proved, June 5, 1773.

In his will, he wrote: ...May 11, 1768. I, Jacobus Lefferts, of Bedford, in the township of Brookland, in Kings County, farmer. I leave to my wife Jannettie all my whole estate, real and personal, while she remains my widow. But if she marries, I give her a bed and furniture, and my best cupboard and £100. I leave to my eldest son Nicholas £5 for his birthright. After the death of my wife, I leave to my son Nicholas all that dwelling house, farm, and lot of meadow which I bought of Johanes Bockhout, as now in his possession, lying in Boswyck; Also a piece of meadow in Brookland meadow, so called, lying between the meadow late of Cornelius Vanderhoeven and a ditch; "Also a lot of meadow in said meadow by the middle stake," bounded east by Hendrick Suydam; And 1/3 of all my right of Commonage; "Also the easterly part of my land, commonly called the land by the Great meadow, lying next the land of Bockhout," with the exception of a strip of land leading to a watering place by the land of Jacob Bloom. I also leave him a negro man, And my son Nicholas shall pay £400. After the death of my wife, I leave to my son Leffert all that dwelling house where he lives, and the land adjoining, which I bought of Hendrick Fine in Bedford, in Brookland; Also another piece of land I bought of him, lying on the east side of a road that leads from Bedford to Flatbush; And all the west part of my land lying at the Great meadow, between the Kings Highway that leads from Bedford to Jamaica and the fence, and east to the watering place; Also 5 and 1/3 lots of woodland, being Nos. 13, 15, 16, 17, 18, and 1/3 of lot 12, lying in the 3d Division in Brookland; Also 1/2 of the salt meadow I bought of Hendrick Fine in Flatbush meadow; "Also a piece of meadow called the Imboght, in Brookland." I also leave him a negro man, And he is to pay £400. I leave to my son Barent all my dwelling house where I now live at Bedford, and all the land adjoining, bounded south by the Kings highway, or road from Bedford to Boswyck, Bounded north by Whitehead Cornell and John Rierson, west by Jacob Rierson; Also two lots in Bedford between Michael Vandervoort and John Noorstrand; Also 7 lots of wood land in Brookland, Nos. 19, 20, 21, 22, 24, and 2 lots by the Great meadow, by the lots of Jacob Bloom; Also my meadow in New-town meadow, which I bought of Scudder, lying between Abraham Duryee and Leffert Lefferts; Also my right in the Great lot of meadow in Brookland, also another lot and my right of Commonage; Also a negro man, and my waggons, ploughs, etc. I leave to my daughter Abigail, widow of Lambert Suydam, a lot of wood land, No. 27, and a negro man, and £500. I leave to my son Jacobus £400; To my daughter Aeltie, widow of Jacob Vanderbilt, £500; To my daughter Jannettie, wife of Stephen Thorn, £500. I leave to my grandchildren, Johanen and Jacobus Fine, children of my daughter Elizabeth, £250. I make my 4 sons executors. Witnesses, Bernardus Vandewater, Andries Andries, Simon Boerum. Proved, December 9, 1768.

In his will, he wrote: Jacobus Lefferts, New York, to my wife Lucretia, the house and lot of ground whereon I now live at the corner of Nassau and King Streets, New York, free and clear of the payment of the mortgage now existing thereon; Also £3,000; Also my phaeton, coach, and sleigh and horses, together with all my household furnishings; to my nephew, Jacobus Fine, œ1,500; Also to my wife, my negro girl, Sal, and my negro boy, Sam, until they arrive at the age of twenty-one years, when it is my will and pleasure that they shall be free, and released from further servitude; I also order that all my other negro slaves, male and female, be free, and released from further servitude at the end of six months after my death; in case any or either of such slaves shall be incapable of being made free according to law, at the end of said six months after my death, by reason of age or inability to gain a livelihood, then in such case the slaves rendered incapable of being made free shall be supported equally and ratably by the several persons to whom is hereafter given my residuary estate; I direct my executors, within eighteen months after my decease, to sell and dispose of all the residue of my estates not hereinbefore given; the moneys so arising to apply in manner following: The payment of all my debts, whether due upon bond mortgage, particularly to the discharge of the mortgage now existing upon the house and lot of ground devised to my wife Lucretia; Also the two legacies above mentioned; the moneys so arising from sale of my residuary estate, after the payments above ordered, to be made to James Lefferts, son of my brother, Leffert Lefferts; Jacobus Lefferts, son of my brother, Barent Lefferts; Jacobus Suydam, son of my sister, Abigail Suydam, and Jacobus Thorne, son of my sister, Jane Thorne, and their legal representatives. I appoint my wife, executrix; my nephew, Jacobus Fine, and my brother-in-law, Abraham Brinckerhoff, executors. Dated April 21, 1792. Witnesses, Robert Troup, Esq., Henry Bowers, Absalom Bainbridge, physician. Proved, July 28, 1792.
