The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

In the Brooklyn Ref Ch record of their marriage: "At Brooklyn Abram Pietersen Lot, young man born in the Flackebos, and Geertje Jans Dorlant, maiden, born in Bedvoort had their banns proclaimed, with the consent of the parents of the bridegroom and the bride" on 2 Aug 1695.

His will was dated 21 Jul 1760 and proved 4 Sep 1766 [WNYHS 7:27]. In it he wrote: I, Abraham Lott, of Jamaica, in Queens County, "being in perfect health, but being far advanced in age, and considering that I have but a short time to continue in this transitory life." I leave to my son, Rem Lott, all my horses, wagons, ploughs, and all my carpenter tools; also all my lands, meadows, and messuages in Jamaica or elsewhere; And he is to provide me a comfortable maintainance during my natural life, and he is to pay to the rest of my children £504, as follows: To my daughter Charity, wife of Nicholas Van Aersdalen, £72; To my son Hendrick, £72; To my son Jacob, £72; To my son Isaac, £72; To my three granddaughters [sic], the children of my deceased son Abraham, viz., Abraham, Matije, and Cornelius, £72; To my son John, £72. All the rest of my estate I leave to my children. I make my sons, Peter, John, and Rem, executors. Dated July 21, 1760. Witnesses, Benjamin Hinchman, Robert Hinchman, Benjamin Hinchman, Jr. Proved, September 4, 1766.

Abraham P. Lott was Colonel of the 3rd New York City Regiment, 1775; Delegate to the 3rd and 4th Provincial Congresses; Member of the State Assembly 1777-83; and Alderman of the City 1784.

Cornelia Rapalje was named in her father's unrecorded will of 4 Sep 1745 as the wife of Abraham Lott.

Abraham P. Lott of New York executed his will on 8 Apr 1793 (no probate) [WNYHS 11:212]; mention is made of his de-

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Johannes Lott, of the township of Flatlands, in Kings County, yeoman. "Knowing that it behoveth every man to set his worldly estate in such order if possible before he departeth this life, that no strife or Debate may arise about the same." All debts to be paid. I leave to my son Johannes all that certain message, dwelling house, and farm, or tract of land and meadow in Flatbush, bounded as follows: Beginning at the eastermost corner of the land of Joost Wyckoff, and from thence running with a straight line to a certain ditch in the meadow, "near a small island, so called, on the west side of a small sand bridge, upon the said ditch," and from thence running easterly along the ditch to the bay, thence along the bay "until it comes to a certain creek, called the Stroomkill," from thence along the said Stroomkill to the bounds of the land which was purchased by me of Peter Wyckoff, and so along the said bounds until it comes to the southermost corner of the land of Joost Wyckoff, and from thence along the same to beginning. Also 1/2 of a certain tract of woodland in Flatbush in the Neck, so called, which was purchased by me from the heirs of Martin Schenck; the whole being 41 acres; and bounded east by the Long Vly, so called, west by the division line, south by Johannes Lott, and north by woodland of the estate of Dominicus Van der Veer, being the south half; "Also a lot of meadow in Flatlands, at a place called Freezen hook," bounded west by a lot of meadow of Dirck Remsen, east by a lot of meadow of my own. It being one of the lots I bought of Peter Wyckoff. I leave to my son Petrus all that tract of land and meadow in Flatlands, beginning at the east corner of the land of Joost Wyckoff; and thence northeast along the fence, until it comes to the bounds between me and William Stoothoff, and thence along said bounds to the Bay, and so along the Bay to a certain ditch, near a small island, and so west along the ditch to the west side of a small sand bridge aforesaid, and from thence to the beginning; and adjoining the land and meadow I have given to my son Johannes; Also 1/2 of the tract of woodland above mentioned. Also a lot of meadow in the Great meadow, so called, bounded northwest by the upland of Gerritt Wyckoff, northeast by the meadow of Petrus Ammerman, and partly by Hermanus Hoogland, south by a creek, southwest by meadow of Gerritt Wyckoff. I leave to my son Jeromus all that tract of land in Flatlands, bounded south by the Stroomkill, west by Bernardus Ryder, northwest by Albert Terhune and Jan Ammerman, north and northeast by Joost Wyckoff, and east by my own land. It being land I bought of Peter Wyckoff. Also a tract of land and meadow in Flatlands, beginning at the east corner of Joost Wyckoff, and thence northeast along the fence to the bounds between me and Willem Stoothoff. From thence along the same to the land of Hermanus Hoogland, thence along his land and a piece of common land, to land of Joost Wyckoff, from thence to beginning. Also a tract of woodland in Flatlands in the Neck, so called, bounded northeast by the woodland of Aaron Van Pelt, northeast by woodland of Joost Wyckoff, southeast by the division line, northwest by Johannes Lott, being 15 acres. Also a lot of woodland in Flatlands Neck, aforesaid, bounded southeast by Dirck Remsen and Peter Wyckoff, northwest by woodland of Isaac Selaver, Thomas Ellsworth, Ulphiamus Van Sinderen, and Dirck Remsen, southwest by Johannes Lott, northeast by Division line, being 7 acres; Also a lot of meadow in Flatlands at a place called Freezen Hook, bounded east by Johannes Ditmars and west by me, being a tract I bought of Peter Wyckoff. And my son Johannes shall pay £1,450, and my son Petrus shall pay £1,150, and my son Jeromus shall pay £1,500. I leave to my sons, Johannes and Petrus, £1,100 each, and to my son Jeromus £1,750. I leave to my daughters, Neeltie, wife of Jacob Snedeker, Antye, wife of Stephen Lott, Maria, wife of Gavel Boerum, and Dorothy, wife of John Van Leave, each £1,000. I leave to the children of my son Hendrick, deceased, viz., Johannes, Roelof, Joris, Antye, and Catrina, £1,100. To the daughter of my son Joris, deceased, viz., Janettie, wife of Nicholas Cowenhoven, £550. To Maria, the daughter of my grandson Johannes, deceased, who was the son of my son Joris, £550 when she is of age. I leave to the children of my daughter Cathrine, late wife of Dirck Remsen, viz., Johannes and Dirck, £1,000. To my grandson, Johannes Lott, son of my son Hendrick, deceased, £5 for his birthright. All the rest of my estate to my children and grandchildren above named. I make my sons, Johannes, Petrus, and Jeromus, executors. Dated April 20, 1771. Witnesses, Jan Ammerman, Gerritt Stoothoff, Johannes Stoothoff. Proved, April 27, 1775.

But if she happens to marry, my executors are to take possession, for the best of my children, viz.: Hendrick, Mauris, Catharine, Antie, Maria, and Pieter. But if she remains unmarried she is to have the east room in my dwelling house, with the cellar and chamber, and 30 acres of land in the township of Flatbush, Bounded north by the Kings road that leads to Jamaica, and west by William Van Bursum. Being in breadth 2 1/2 Lots, and in length, south from the Kings road till it makes up 30 acres. And she is to have fire wood and fencing out of my woodland in Newtown. And she is to have hay from

my meadow in Flatbush. And one third of my orchard that joins to my dwelling house. I leave to my sons, Hendrick and Mauris, all my houses, lands, and meadows, in Flatbush or Newtown, when they are of age, or after the death of their mother, Catharina Lott. And they shall pay to my daughters, Catharina, Antie, and Maria, £600 each, in six years after they come in possession. I give to my son Pieter, all my farm or Plantations in Kings County, in the Town of Boswyck (Bushwick). I make my brother, Johannes Lott, and my brothers-in-law, Rem Remsen and Andries Onderdonk, Johannes Schenck, and Abraham Lott, executors. Witnesses, Joris Colm, Thomas Betts. Proved, June 4, 1730.

To my sister Maria my large Dutch Bible. If any legatee shall find fault about any Legacies given them such legatee shall be cut off from any share. Executors, friend Nicholas Schenck, of Flatlands, and my two cousins, Johannis I. Lott and Hendrick Lott, both of New Lotts. (Signed) Mouweris Lott. Dated October 11, 1784. Witnesses, John Van Der Veer, Esq., Hendrick Eldert, Isaac Eldert, yeoman, of New Lotts. Proved, Kings County, September 7, 1785. Confirmed, New York, September 14, 1785.
