The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Brant Peelen from Nykerck, with his servant, Barent Jansz, sailed from the Texel 21 March 1630 and arrived New Amsterdam 24 May 1630. His daughters Lysbeth and Gerritje Brants came to New Amsterdam on den Waterhondt.

Brant Peelen from Nykerck; was engaged as a farmer in Jan 1630 for the term of four yeras, at wages of f110 a year and in 1632 he was appointed schepen. He was married twice, first to Lubertje Wouters by whom he had three children; Lysbeth Brants, Geert Brants and Gerritje Brants and secondly at New Amsterdam, 3 Jul 1643, to Marritje Pieters, widow of Claes Sybrantsz. Marritje had 2 children by her first spouse, Claes, named Sybrant Claes and Aeltje Claes. Brant Peelen died before 1 May 1644 when Cornelis Segersz Van Voorhout succeeded him on his farm, called Welys Burg, on Castle Island.

He was at one time a resident of Schlichtenhorst in Gelderland, Holland. His sons Gerret/Guert Cornelisse and Mattheus Cornelisse sailed on the Dutch ship *Moesman* for New Netherland on 25 April 1659.²

Cornelis Van Nieuwkerke spent some time serving as a Magistrate in the New Netherlands, the Dutch colony on Manhattan Island. Suffering poor health, and homesick for his family, he returned to his native land and died there.

His sons, Guert and Matheus later came to America in 1659 and used the surname Cornelis/Cornelison, which later, in some branches, became Van Nieuwkerke/Newkerk.

The passenger list of the Dutch ship, *Moesman*, from Holland, which arrived in port 15 April, 1659, included the entry: "Guert van Nieuwkerke, his wife and suckling child and a 12 year old boy." This entry was in compliance with the edict that only male immigrants over the age of 16 were to be identified by name. Guert (Gerrit) was 24 years old when they came to America. His wife was Aeltje Gerrits, the baby was Gerritz Cornelis. The 12 year old boy was probably Gerrit's brother, Matthew. After their arrival in the New Netherlands, these two sons of Cornelis Killen, Gerrit and Matthew, adopted the surname Cornelison.^{1,5}

Gerrit obtained an 18 morgens (36 acres) tract of land on Midwout (Flatbush) L.I., from Antoni Hartman on 27 Oct 1661 (per Register of Early Settlers of Kings Co. L.I., pg.159). Gerrit sold this land to Arent Evertse on 10 March 1665. Gerrit might have lived in Bergen New Jersey area until he moved to Hurley, in Ulster County NY in 1669, where he obtained 85 acres of land.⁵

About 1669 he purchased a farmstead in the Hurley Patent in Ulster Co., NY. In 1670 he was listed in Capt. Henry Pawling's Company of Foot Militia, as from Hurley.

"His will, executed February 3, 1686, probated March 4, 1695/96, styled him of Hurley. The document is conclusive as to the seniority of the three sons and two daughters named."⁴ In the will he wrote: "... my ouldest son Cornelis & my second son Arie & my third son Jan & my daughter Nettie" to each an "Equall fffth part of all my goods & Chattells" "to be equally devided among these my said fffve Children" Only 4 children are shown by name, even though it says "ffive Children."⁶

In the (2) m. record they are "Matheus Cornelisse Van Nieuwkerk (widower of Anna Lubi) born at Slechtenhorst in Gelderland, and Catryna Poulus, Y.D. from Bergen, N.J., both living at Bergen."

Matthys Cornelisse Van Nieuwkerk accompanied his brother, Gerret Cornelisse to New Netherland in the ship *Moesman* in 1659.

Matthew went first to Flatbush Long Island, where he bought a farm bordering on Corlear's Flats. In 1665, he sold this and moved to Bergen. Five years later he married Anna, daughter of Jacob Luby, who had served under the West India Company. His first wife died in 1685, and the next year he married Catherine, daughter of Paulus Pietersen.

His descendants used the surname Van Nieuwkerk, Nieuwkerk, Newkirk.

Some of the data for this family may be confused with another contemporary Matthys Cornelise (q.v. "Cornelise"), whose children, bp. at Hackensack, retained the surname Cornelise.
