The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

From obituary of Pierre Odell, in *New York Genealogical & Biographical Record*, Vol. 17, No. 1, Jan 1886, p. 57-58: Pierre Odell, Esq., died at Hastings, Westchester County, N. Y., on Thursday, July 30, 1885. His ancestry may be traced as follows: Mr. William Odell, the first of the family in this country, was at Concord, Mass. in 1639. He probably came to New England with the Rev. Peter Bulkeley, who was rector of the parish of Odell, in Bedfordshire, England, in 1620, Mr. Bulkeley's wife was Grace, daughter of Sir Richard Chetwood, and granddaughter of Agnes Wodhull or Odell — the names being the same — who married Richard Chetwood, Esq., father of Sir Richard. The Odell family had been settled in Bedfordshire for many generations and it is probable that Mr. William Odell was a resident of that part of England. He died at Fairfield, Conn., in June, 1676. William Odell the Jr., his son, was of Fairfield, and afterward of Rye, N. Y., where he owned a large estate. His wife was the daughter of Richard Vowles, Esq., of Fairfield, member of the Colonial Assembly in 1665-8-9. From this William Odell Jr., Pierre Odell was descended in the line of John 3, of Fordham, N. Y., whose wife was Johanna Turner; John 4, Jr., of Fordham, whose wife was Hannah Vermilyea; Jonathan of Greenburgh, N. Y., whose wife was Margaret Dyckman; Colonel John, of Greenburgh, whose wife was Abigail Browne; Colonel Jackson, of Greenburgh, whose wife was Anna Ward. Mr. Pierre Odell's father. Colonel Jackson Odell, graduated from Columbia College in the class of 1814, and during the war of 1812 served on the staff of Major General Pierre Van Cortlandt, having received his commission from General Clinton. He married Anna, daughter of Bartholomew and Elizabeth (Bonnet) Ward, and granddaughter of the Hon. Stephen Ward, Judge of Westchester County. Judge Ward's father was Edmund Ward, Esq., member of the Colonial Assembly, son of Edmund Ward, of Fairfield, Conn., and grandson of Andrew Ward, Esq., of the same place, who was magistrate in 1636. This Andrew Ward was originally of Watertown, Mass. where he was made freeman in 1634. Mr. Pierre Odell was born November 1, 1828, in the old family homestead, situated near Hart's Corners, in the town of Greenburgh. This house, which is still standing, has some historical interest as having been the headquarters of the Count de Rochambeau during the war of the Revolution. Mr. Odell received a business education during the early years of his life, but afterward engaged in teaching. He was much interested in agricultural pursuits, and attained considerable eminence as a horticulturist. He was a life member of the American Institute, and travelled extensively through the South and West, investigating the condition of the fruit lands. Mr. Odell was possessed of good literary ability, and at the time of his death was writing a biography of the Patriot Guides of the Revolution. He had the acquaintance of many distinguished men during his lifetime, and his fine conversational powers and genial manners made him many friends. He was greatly interested in politics, and took an active part in the late presidential campaign. Mr. Odell leaves a brother, William Dyckman Odell, and two sisters, Mrs. Margaret King, of Montgomery, N. Y., and Miss Elizabeth Odell. -- Rufus King.
