The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In 1847, Neeltje made a Revolutionary War pension application (W15933, National Archives Microfilm M804, roll 1853) based on the service of Lt. Daniel Outwater. She presented a family record listing the birthdates for 11 children: Petrus, Anna, Daniel, Gitty, Beljatte and Barent VanCleeck shown below, plus a daughter Elizabeth b. 23 Sep 1781 (between Daniel and Gitty), Joseph b. 15 Dec 1789, Catherine 14 Feb 1793, J____ (a son, died young) b. 1796, and Sarah b. 30 Nov 1798.

Daniel & Neeltje Outwater left Dutchess County and appear in the Adolphustown Census (Ontaria, Canada) in 1803.

On 8 March 1786 (recorded 9 December 1805, Bergen Co. W:1) John Outwater and Guilliam Outwater, both of Bergen County, Gentlemen, conveyed to Nehemiah Wade, Attorney at Law, of Bergen County, for £31, 2 shillings, 6 pence, 5 acres and 2 perches of woodland in the precinct of New Barbadoes in Munaghia Patent on W side of Quackseck at a place called John Earles Point, beginning NE corner of woodland sold by said John and Guilliam Outwater to Samuel Reading. Signed by John Outwater, Gilm. Outwater. Witnessed by George Vangesen, Yacob Paulesse.²

On 26 February 1791 (recorded 24 January 1806, Bergen Co. W:142) Guilliam Outwater of Hackensack Precinct, conveyed to Nehemiah Wade, Attorney at Law, of New Barbadoes Precinct, for £18, 9 acres large measure, a lot of Crupla swamp and woodland being within the bounds of a grant from Major John Berry to Rut Van Horn and others, now called the bounds of Munaghia, beginning line of Abraham and Powles Van Derbeek; Nehemiah Wade; Kalkoon Neck; Do. John Van Buren. Signed by Gim. Outwater. Witnessed by Abrm. P. Waldron, Resolve Waldron.²

On 18 May 1803 (recorded 9 July 1805, Bergen Co. V:211) Gilliam Outwater and Anna, his wife, and Jacob Outwater and Margaret, his wife, Abraham Sickels and Catharine, his wife, and Michael Vreeland and Altia, his wife, joint heirs to the estate of Altia Van Wagene, deceased, conveyed to John Outwater, property at Communipaw in the Township of Bergen, beginning at barn belonging to Nicholas Vreeland, deceased; mentioned dividing line of said estate in possession of David Lozier and in possession of Guilliam Outwater; bank of York Bay. Signed by Gilliam Outwater (his mark), Anny Outwater (her

mark); Jacob Outwater, Mary Outwater; Abraham Sickels, Catharine Sickels (her mark). Witnessed by Michael Vreeland, Cornelius Britten.²

On 5 June 1805 (recorded 1 July 1805, Bergen Co. V:168) Gilliam Outwater and Anne, his wife, and Jacob Outwater and Mary, his wife, and John Outwater and Elinor, his wife, and Michael Vreeland and Altye, his wife, of Gomonepaw in the Township of Bergen, conveyed to Abraham Sickels of Gomonepaw in the Township of Bergen, for \$468.75, a lot, house, and barn in Gomonepaw, bounded S by land of Class Vreeland; NW by land formerly belonging to Michael Vreeland but now my property; NW [sic] by land of heirs of John Van Horn, deceased; S by road and Bey. Signed by Gilliam Outwater (his mark), Anne Outwater (her mark), Jacob Outwater, Mary Outwater, John Outwater, Elinor Outwater, Michael Vreeland, Altye Vreeland (her mark). Witnessed by Daniel Van Reipen, David W. Barr.²

They probably lived on the homestead in Moonachie; their son John Outwater inherited it.

Their moderate wealth was derived mostly from the sale of farm products in Hackensack and New York. Jacob Outwater served as a Bergen County Judge in Hackensack between 1755 and 1758. In his will, Jacob warned his three sons that if they left the Dutch Reformed Church he would divide his properties evenly among his eight children instead of bequaething it to them alone.¹

By 1774, John Outwater had begun to acquire large tracts of land adjacent to the properties he had received from his father. In 1774 he was elected Sheriff of Bergen County.¹

John Outwater was a captain in the New Jersey State Troops in the Revolutionary War, and prior to that service he was in the Militia. He was a surveyor and a farmer. He was a Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Bergen County, 1800-1817.

On 8 March 1786 (recorded 9 December 1805, Bergen Co. At my widow's death or remarriage all remaining moveables to be divided in like manner. I make my grandson, Daniel Outwater, Barndt Van Kleeck, my trusty friend, Samuel Dodge, of the same county, executors. Witnesses, Johannes Schurri; Clement Cornell, of said county, yeoman; Antony Helst. Codicil. The fifteenth day of May, 1777, I, Peter Outwater, being weak in body; my wife Balitje having died, her legacy is to go equally to the above grandchildren. Unto Peter, son of my grandson, Daniel Outwater, my grey mare. My wench Mary, and my negro boy Jim, to the one of my grandchildren she may choose; my other wench Susan, unto the other grandchild. In the (2) banns record at Bergen Ref Ch, they were: "Tomas Franszen Outwater (widower of Tryntje Breestede) and Metje Pieters, Y.D. Groom living at Monachie; bride living at Bergen. Were married September 29, 1906, at Achquechnonk."

Thomas Fransen Outwater went from New York to Bergen County, NJ prior to 1691 and with Rutger Van Horn and Nicase Kip purchased the Moonachie portion, section 2, which he later alone acquired and occupied. Thomas Outwater's third of this property was described as a "stretch of land called Moochie Island between Berry's creek, Indian Path, Losing Creek, and the Hackensack River."

Some of the descendants of Thomas Fransen Outwater until 1922 owned one hundred acres of the original property which he purchased in Moonachie. The original house that he lived in was of stone and had the date 1717 cut in the cornerstone. It was built by Thomas Fransen Oudewater and stood near what is now Washington Avenue in Carlstadt. The family burial place was located about 300 feet from the house.

Thomas was a physician and a Bergen County Freeholder.

In the Bergen Ref Ch record of Tryntje's burial, she "lived at Monachje Co of Ackinsack, and bur. at Old Ackinsack.

Thomas Outwater was the clerk of Orangetown for 15 years, beginning about 1764.

Dr. Thomas Outwater, of Tappan, was a signer of the Orangetown Resolutions and seems to have been considered at first a "moderate" in patriotic feelings, but even that mild ardor cooled. A Jacob Outwater, perhaps even Thomas's father, delivered produce to the British.

Thomas Outwater was a Loyalist during the Revolution.

Thomas Outwater of Orange Town, in his will dated Nov. 7, 1804, probated Sep. 2, 1807. mentioned Wife, Frances, to have negro boy Will; Son, Jacob, family bible for birth right and lot which I hold in Byard's farm on York Island; Children of my daughter Mary - wife of James Bell. Executors: Wife, and Son, Jacob.

Frances Outwater of Rockland County, in her will dated Jun. 30, 1830. Codicil dated Jul. 5, 1830. Probated Nov. 18, 1835. mentioned Jacob Thomas Outwater; John H.
