The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In the (1) marriage banns record they are "Jacobus Peek, y.m., b. New York, and Sara Cornelese Banta, y.d., b. Ackinsack, both living here."

In the (2) marriage record they were: "Jacobus Peek, w. of Sara Banta and Rachel Sa...DeMarest, y.d. Both live Schralenburg."

Jacobus Peek owned a large farm, along Schraalenburgh Road partly in present Dumont and Haworth. He served as a Judge of the Bergen County Common Pleas and Quarter Session Court.

The following transactions may refer to this Rachel Peake (her land as a boundary): On 4 February 1790 (recorded 28 April 1804, Bergen Co. S:115) Daniel D. Haring of Schralenburg int he Township of Harrington, Taylor, and Agnietye, his wife, conveyed to James Christie of the Precinct of Hackensack, Carpenter, for £200, 34-8/10 acres of cleared land in Harrington at Schralinburg, beginning W side of Schralenburgh Road in line of said James Christie; mentions land of Johannes Peek. Bounded N by land late of Rachel Peek, deceased; E by Johannes Peek and part by said Road; S by James Christie; W by Cornelius Vandervort. Signed by Daniel D. Haringh, Angenitye Haringh. Witnessed by David Durie, John P. Durie.¹

On 17 December 1792 (recorded 28 April 1804, Bergen C. S;112) Cornelius Vander Voort of the Township of Hackensack, conveyed to James Christey, Esq. of Bergen County, for £215, 40 acres more or less in the Township of Harrington, SW corner of lot sold by said Cornelius Vander Voort to Daniel Haring. Bounded E by said lot; N by land lately the property of Rachel Peake, deceased; W by Daniel Demarest; S by said James Christy. Signed by Cornelius VanderVort. Witnessed by Isaac Nicoll, Walter D. Nicoll.¹

Jacobus Peek of Scralenburrah, Hackensack Precinct, Bergen County died leaving a will dated 19 Aug 1765, codicil 3 Oct 1767 and proved 24 Oct 1775 mentioning wife Rachel. Eldest son Johannes. Sons Johannes, Samuel, Jacobus and David. To my four daughters, and the children of my daughter Rachel deceased. Jane, wife of John Duree. Elizabeth, the wife of Johannes Blawvelt. Mary, the wife of Cornelius Smith. "and the children of my deceased daughter, Rachel, are Rachel, Mary[;]

and [my daughter] Anna, the wife of Lawrance Ackerman." [NJA 5:385]

Jan Peek came to New Netherland before 1650, perhaps from Belgium.

In the marriage record they were: Jan Peeck, j.m. en Marie Volckers, Wede.

Jan Peek was a tavern keeper, trader, and land broker. He kept a trading post on the Hudson River at "Jan Peeck's Kill" (today's Peekskill, NY). His wife operated a tavern. In 1664 she was accused of selling liquor to the Indians, fined 500 guilders, and banished from New Amsterdam.

In 1663, Maria and Jan were banished from New York for selling alcohol on the Sabbath and also to the Indians. She lived with her son Jacobus in Schnectady in her later years. Her husband, Jan was an Innkeeper in New Amsterdam and had a trading post up the Hudson River at "Jan Peek's Kill". In 1655 he sold two houses at Fort Orange to Johannes Dyckman for 1627 guilders.¹
