The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

She is listed as 28 (26?), b. NY, and their (supposed) son, George W. Price, is listed as 5/12 yrs. old, b. NY. Living with them are Elizabeth Renalds, 20, b. Ireland (probably a servant), and James Renalds, 19, b. Ireland, laborer.

She was listed in the 1870 Federal Census, New York, Suffolk Co., Islip, Sayville P.O., p. 52, Dwelling 399, Family 434 -- Emily S. Price, 46, widow, Farmer, value real estate \$40,000, b. NY; Chas. E., 16, Farmer, b. NY; Estella, 13, b. NY. [PAW note: the handwritten surname in this census record looks like "Rice" and was probably indexed as such.]

They lived at one time near Stony Brook, or Smithtown, L.I., Suffolk Co., N.Y.

Emily Price is listed on a paper for Administration of the Court, concerning Samuel M. Nichols's death-dated in 1865.

Emily S. (Nichols) Price died intestate. The administration papers on her estate are recorded in the Surrogate's Court, Suffolk County, NY, Liber N, p. 250. Her heirs were Charles E. Price and Emma S. Kissam (wife of Edgerton Kissam), both residing in Smithtown, Suffolk Co., NY. Mention was made of another son, George W. Price, formerly residing in Islip, Suffolk Co., NY, who left his home "about six years ago & has not been heard from since, and is supposed to be dead & [the?] petitioners certify he is deceased and left no issue." An inventory of her estate was filed 29 Sep 1888, by Richard W. Smith & George H. Blydenburgh. The only property of the deceased consisted of a deposit in the Riverhead Savings Bank amounting to \$580.62.<sup>2</sup>

In his will, dated 9 Sep 1815, Michael Price devised his numerous real estate holdingd in New York City and elsewhere to his sons Stephen, William, Benjamin, and Edward; his daughter Elizabeth, wife of Lewis Moore, received only cash, possibly because he had settled property on her earlier.

In her will, dated 19 Dec 1831, Helena Price of the City of New York, mentioned only her sons, not her daughter Eliza.

He attended the public schools of New York City and the Lawrenceville (N.J.) Academy; pursued classical studies in Princeton College, but did not graduate; studied law; was admitted to the bar; appointed purser in the Navy in 1840 and was stationed in San Francisco; during the Mexican War served as an officer of the Navy on the steam frigates Fulton and Missouri and on the sloop of war Cyane with Commodore Sloat's squadron on the west coast of Mexico; prefect and alcalde of Monterey in 1846 and the first American to exercise judicial functions in California; naval agent 1848-1850; delegate to the first constitutional convention of California; returned to New Jersey; elected as a Democrat to the Thirty-second Congress (March 4, 1851-March 3, 1853); unsuccessful candidate for reelection in 1852 to the Thirty-third Congress; Governor of New Jersey 1854-1857; father of the public-school system of New Jersey; established a ferry from Weehawken to New York; engaged in the quarrying business and in the reclamation of lands along the Hackensack River; delegate to the peace convention held at Washington, D.C., in 1861 in an effort to devise means to prevent the impending war.<sup>1</sup>

Rodman M. Price bought the farm of Charles and Eliza May (Bischoff and Kahn say in 1862 he bought property of Alexander Hamilton), on Valley Road in Mahwah. He called his estate "Hazelwood-on-the-Ramapo."

Price was inaugurated Governor of New Jersey on 17 Jan 1854 and served a three year term. He was the only Governor of New Jersey from Bergen County.
