The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Eleazer occupied a house which stood on the corner of the highway from Brewster, N. Y., to Danbury, Conn. The spot is marked by a huge rock which formed one side of the dwelling. Three of his children were born there. On May 5, 1794, he purchased 130 acres, a portion of the present Ryder farm on the westerly side of Peach Lake, where he built the houses that form the present residence and to which he removed. He was an energetic and industrious farmer, weaver, merchant and marketman. It is said that he often obtained the money to pay for his hired help on the farm by working with his loom at night. He kept a country store on his premises and further supplied his own and his neighbors' wants by driving a market wagon thrice a week to Sing Sing, transporting the surplus products of the community to the Hudson river, the avenue of trade with New York, and returning with the manufactures that that locality produced.

In his will, he wrote: ...April 7, 1773. I, Jacobus Ryder, of Gravesend, in Kings County. I direct my executors to pay all debts, I leave to my wife Jannettie full possession of all my estate until my son Laurence is of age, but if she marries "she shall take out of my estate all the household furniture that she brought in." My executors are to take in possession all the estate without lessening the same. I will that my son, Bernardus Ryder, shall have the farm of his grandfather, Bernardus Ryder, late of Gravesend, deceased, where he now lives. The 4 acre lots excepted, of which I give him 1/2 with his brother Laurence, except the meadows, which I give to my son Laurence. I leave to my son Bernardus "my Big Dutch Byble," together with all my library of books, and my silver Tankard marked B. R. A. And he is to pay legacies as follows: That is to say, £500 in 2 years after my wife's death, to my daughters, Elizabeth, Adriantje, Phebe, Altie, Jannettie, Seytie, and Ida. And my daughter Ida is to have out of the £500, £50 before any division, and the remainder to my seven daughters. Except that my daughter Elizabeth, to whom I have paid £50, shall have £50 less, and my daughter Adriantje to have £30 less. I leave to my daughters, Phebe and Jannettie, "my Neck lot and a half, which I bought of the heirs of Coert Voorhees." I leave to my son Laurence all the rest of my lands in Gravesend, with all silver cash and books, and all farming utensils, and 2 negroes. And he shall pay to his sisters £200 in 4 years, after the death of my wife. My two sons shall have my Sedge lots and meadow lots as they were drawn, and my lot on the West meadow Bank. He was an energetic and industrious farmer, weaver, merchant and marketman. It is said that he often obtained the money to pay for his hired help on the farm by working with his loom at night. He kept a country store on his premises and further supplied his own and his neighbors' wants by driving a market wagon thrice a week to Sing Sing, transporting the surplus products of the community to the Hudson river, the avenue of trade with New York, and returning with the manufactures that that locality produced.

(The foregoing group seems to be the same as the testator refers to later as "my daughters and granddaughters") The place where James Emmons now lives to be sold. Executors: William Smith and John Palmer. Signed: "X" his mark.²

Another abstract version: "William Rider, of Cakeate, Haverstraw Precinct, Orange County, farmer" mentioned Martha, daughter of my lawful daughter Phebe; my two twins Elizabeth Suckey and Millee; Lydia; boys William, Joseph and John; my Jemima; my wife (not named). [The will is confusing because relationships are not clearly stated.] Named William Smith and John Palmer executors. Witnesses were Matthew Coe, wheelwright; Isaac Smith; John Cox, yeoman, both of Haverstraw Precinct.¹
