

-- **ROE, ROW, RAU** --

The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, David Roe, of Flushing in Queens County, being weak and indisposed in body. I leave to my son, Nathaniel Roe, all my housing, lands, and meadows in the town of Flushing, and my great cedar chest, which stands in my eastward room; And 1/2 of the provisions, cider, corns, etc., and he is to pay 1/2 of the funeral expenses. I leave to my son, John Roe, £20, and my negro boy, Sam, and the other half of the provisions, cider, corn, etc. To Elizabeth, Patience, and Mary, the children of my daughter, Elizabeth Totens, deceased, £10 each. I make my son, Nathaniel Roe, sole executor, and my friends, Samuel Bowne and Francis Doughty, executors in Trust. Dated December 26, 1702. Witnesses, Henry Taylor, Jonathan Thorne, James Clement.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, David Rowe, Senior, of Flushing, Queens County, Nassau Island, yeoman, do this 31st day of March, 1784, make my last will. I bequeath to my wife Sarah all household goods and other things I have had with her since I was married to her, also £100 paid her by my executors, each his equal proportion, within a year after my decease; also to her my Negro girl Kate and one cow; all to her in lieu of her dower and at her own disposal. To my two sons, Joseph and David Rowe, that land with the Buildings thereunto belonging in the Township of Flushing, bounded Westerley by a Road, Northerly by my brother Ezekiel Rowe and William Griffin, Easterly by Joseph Wright, and Southerly by Thomas Lowree and John Eagles. To my son Lawrence all the rest of my real estate in Flushing not otherwise disposed of, the dwelling house wherein I now live, Barn and all other outhouses, and the land adjoining; also a certain swamp and upland thereunto adjoining-

ing in Flushing bounded West by a Brook that runs to John Rowes, and North by a road that leads to the Bay side, Easterly by the land of Joseph Wood, and Southerly by John Thorn; also to said Lawrence a piece of salt meadow in Flushing bounded by Robert Lawrence, North, South and West and East by John Rowe; also another salt meadow in Flushing bounded east by John Rodman, North by Robert Lawrence, West by my brother, Ezekiel Rowe, and south by John Rowe. In consideration of what I have given to Lawrence he shall pay to his two brothers, Joseph and David, £800, £100 as part thereof yearly to each the first payment within one year after my decease, and so till the £800 be fully paid which will be in four years. I give all my claim to a tract in Gloster County, New Jersey, if recovered, to my sons, Joseph and David. I devise two lots of land in the Township of Flushing to my two youngest sons, Walter and Cadwalladar Rowe, bounded east by David Fowler, south by my brothers, Ezekiel and Oliver Rowe, west by the road, south by John Rowe and Cornwell, equally divided as soon as they arrive at lawful age or have lawful issue. All my moveable estate, not otherwise disposed of, my negroes included, shall be sold at Public Vendue as soon as conveniently may be, and the money therefrom disposed of as follows: £50 lodged into the hands of my son David for bringing up my youngest son, Cadwallader, the residue to my daughters, namely, Abigail Fowler, Susannah Rowe and Elizabeth Fowler, equally divided, but with this express condition that my daughter, Elizabeth Fowler, shall only be made equal with her sisters in case the value of what she has already received of me be counted as part of her portion, which said legacies shall be paid to Abigail and Elizabeth within one year of my decease and to my youngest daughter, Susannah, as soon as she shall arrive at lawful age. I appoint my sons, Joseph, David and Lawrence, sole executors. Witnesses, Robert Lawrence, of Flushing, yeoman; David Roe, Oliver Cornell, of Flushing, yeoman. Proved, Queens County, April 5th, 1785.

Some believe John Rowe married Sarah Hannah Purrier (or Mary, or Sarah, or Hannah), dau. of William Purrier & Alice Knight. She was b. 1638 Southold, Suffolk Co., NY.

John Roe, or Rowe, as the name in variously spelled, it being Rowe on his tombstone, but his descendants invariably using the former form, was born in Ireland in 1628, but was of English extraction. He emigrated to America in 1655, settled in Lynn, Massachusetts, but soon afterward went to Easthampton, Long Island, New York. Thence he removed to Setauket, now (1906) Port Jefferson, Brookhaven township, and was one of the first, if not the very first, settler in that place. The house erected by him in 1690 is still standing and in good condition, and is in use at the present time. He was one of the constituent members of the Presbyterian church of Setauket, and in his will he calls himself a "cordwainer." The original burying place has been destroyed by the laying out of new streets, and his tombstone is now to be found with those of his descendants in the public cemetery of Port Jefferson.¹

He was a signer of Treaty of the Indians; member of Train Band under Lieut. Charles Grover 1652-1653.

Torry wrote that he was referred to as 'Jans Roos' by the Dutch. "The documents relating to the colonial history of New York, vol. 14, pg. 514, mentions Jan Roo as one of the owners of land at Middleburg (Newtown), L. I., July 10, 1662." Newtown Records Vol. 1, pp. 47-48: "John Roe soldier in James forte the citted of New York sells his interest in land formerly belonging to Elizabeth Roe to Arthur Stangwish, 13 May 1668." Torrey says "It is assumed that Elizabeth was his first wife and that she was deceased when he signed the above mentioned deed." "1671 27 Apr. John Rowe and Alice his wife of Setauk sell to John Franklyne of Southampton, 15 acres at Old Mans whether upland, meadow or swamp laid out in the last division at Setauk." Suffolk County Rec. Riverhead.

In his will, he wrote: "...22 August, 1712. I, John Roe, of Brookhaven, in Suffolk County, being in health. I leave to my wife Sarah, whom I make sole executor, all my lands, messuages and tenements, that is to say, my now dwelling house, with my land, orchard, and Commonage, and all household goods during her life. I leave one half of my meadow to my eldest son John, and the other half to my son Nathaniel. I give my wife full power to give and bequeath, if she thinks fit, £25 of movable goods, "to that child of mine that carrieth itself lovingest and kindest to her after my decease." I leave all the rest of my movables to my grand daughter, Mary Clark, and to my daughters, Mary Corwin and Elizabeth Mapes. Witnesses, William Davis, John Maxwell. Proved, July 27, 1714.

At the age of eight years he went to live with his maternal grandfather, Thaddeus Seeley, and after his death lived with his son, Gabriel Seeley, in Chester, where he remained until his marriage. After his marriage Mr. Roe rented a farm for ten years, and then purchased a farm, upon which he remained a few years. In 1855 he bought another farm consisting of 200 acres, upon which he built a substantial farm residence in 1867. This property showed to the passer-by the handiwork of a careful, thrifty and intelligent farmer. He started out in life without pecuniary assistance, and by self-reliance, industry and judicious management was safely classed among the leading agriculturists of his town. Mr. Roe served as assessor for three years, beginning in 1856, and represented it in the board of supervisors in 1877. Director in the Chester Bank, 1878-81. Both he and his wife were members of the Presbyterian Church at Chester, of which he was an elder for many years. He was one of the incorporators of Goshen and Munroe Turnpike Company, 1823-4.

In his will, he wrote: December 26, 1780. William Roe, yeoman, of Flushing, Queens County, New York. All my just debts and funeral charges be well paid by my son John, one of my executors. To my wife Martha, my best bed and furniture, six of my best sitting chairs, six of my best puter plates, two of my best puter platters, my best iron pot, my best iron kettle, my best cow to be kept on my said farm, half dozen knives and forks, my looking glass, my riding chair and my black mare called the chair mare, to be kept on my said farm; all the above I give her to her own disposal in lieu of her dower or thirds of in and out of all and singular my houses, lands, tenements and real estate whatsoever and wheresoever; Also the interest of £200 to be paid to her half yearly, by my son John, one of my executors, from the day of my death and to be continued during her remaining my widow and no longer, and my wife shall have the best room in my house rent free and the use of my black girl named Hannah, during her remaining my widow and no longer; at her death or remarriage I give said negro girl Hannah, to my daughter Elisabeth; should she have a child or children in the time my wife should have her in possession, in that case I give and bequeath the said child or children to my daughter Elisabeth and her heirs forever. To my son Oliver, my lot of land lying by Joseph Wrights and also a piece of salt meadow adjoining Samuel Cornells and David Roes salt meadow to him and his heirs forever. To my daughter, Ann Cornell, my second best bed and furniture which she now has the use of; Also the sum £25 to be paid her one year after my decease. To William, my son, £100 to be paid him one year after my decease. To my son Thomas £100, my son Thomas' legacy to draw interest from the day of my death until he shall arrive at age of twenty-one or marry. Also I give him my negro boy named Pompey. To my loving daughter Elisabeth £100, this legacy to draw interest from the day of my death till she arrive at the age of eighteen years or marry; Also my third best bed and furniture. To my daughter, Ann Cornell, my negro girl Violett and the heirs of her body forever. To my son John and his heirs forever all my real and personal estate which I have in Flushing, excepting what I have already given, upon condition that he shall pay all my just debts and funeral charges and also pay my daughter, Ann Cornell, one year after my death her legacy; Also pay my son William his legacy, and also my son Thomas his legacy with what interest may be due as he shall arrive at the age of twenty-one years or marry; Also pay my daughter Elisabeth her legacy with what interest may be due when she shall arrive to the age of eighteen years or marry. I desire that guardians appointed hereafter to be over my two sons, John and Thomas, to be put to good trades and let my house be a home for them when it seems to be convenient to them until they arrive at the age of twentyone years; Also to keep and support my daughter Elisabeth with suitable food and raiment until she arrive at the age of eighteen years or marry; Also if my son John should die and leave no issue, then I give to my son Thomas, all my real and personal estate which I have given to my son John upon conditions of him performing my will as have ordered my son John to perform, or that part that may be unsettled, and if my son John should die and leave one or two children or more, my son Thomas is to pay to the child or children, £200, three months after the father's death, and also if my executor shall recover the one third part of three hundred acres which I may have a right to in West Jersey, Gloster County, near Delaware River. If the value of this land amounts to four hundred pounds or under I give it to my two sons, Oliver and William and their heirs forever. If the valuation be more than £400, the overplus to be paid to my two sons, John and Thomas, equally divided between them and their heirs forever. My wife shall not take any person or persons into that part of the house that I allow her during her widowhood without the consent of my son John or son Thomas which ever may possess my farm; but she shall be sup-

plied with fuel for her fire at all times during her widowhood at the expense of the occupier of my possessions. I appoint my sons, John and Thomas, Executors, but at present under age and if I should die before they or each of them be at age I appoint David Haviland and Caleb Haviland, executors or guardians over my two sons, John and Thomas, my sole executors, until one or both arrive at the age of twenty-one years. Dated December 26, 1780. Witnesses, George Barwick, yeoman; Daniel Hitchcock, Abigail Haviland. Proved, November 5, 1782. The same day David Haviland qualified as executor. On April 11, 1786, John Roe was duly sworn as executor.
