The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

In his will, he wrote: ...August 17, 1741, I, David Rogers, of Huntington, in Suffolk County, miller. I leave to my wife Jane "a bed, bedstead, and bedding, which she shall choose, and such household goods as she shall think necessary and convenient for her keeping house." Also 1/3 of the proceeds of the sale of such lands as I order to be sold; I also leave her 40 acres on the north part of my land in Huntington, bounded north by John Carman, west by the road running along by Cold Spring Harbor, to be taken off from my other land in a square piece as near as can be done, All these are left to my wife during her life, and then the said 40 acres are left to my son Benjamin. "And as to the other articles, I give them to my wife to divide among my children." All the rest of my lands in Oyster Bay, Huntington, or elsewhere, are to be sold by my executors

to the best advantage. From the proceeds, all debts and charges to be paid. I leave 1/3 to my wife, and the rest to my sons, Samuel and Benjamin, and my two daughters, Jane Brush and Rebecca Brush. I make my wife, and my brother, Obadiah Rogers, and my friend, Samuel Brush, executors. Witnesses, Abraham Van Voorhees, William Brundage, Jr., Ebenezer Prime, minister of the Gospel. Proved in New York, May 31, 1758.

In his will, he wrote: ...August 26, 1749. "Know ye that I, Isaiah Rogers, of Hunttington," yeoman, being sick. I leave to my wife Dorcas a lot of cleared land south of my orchard, beginning by my mowing land, and bounded west by highway and so running east till it contains 34 acres; Also 1/3 of my orchard joining south east to my dwelling house; Also the best room in my house, and 5 cows and a pair of oxen, 20 sheep, and my best cart. All the rest of my stock and farming tackling, and all the rest "that my family don't stand in need" to be sold by my executors. I leave to my sons Zophar and Isaiah all my land lying at a place called the Long Hill, bounded west by highway, north by Philip Weekes and Jonathan Rogers, and east by the highway from Crab meadows to the Clay Pits, and south partly by highway; Also all my meadow and upland at South, on Santepogue neck; Also a certain tract of land bounded west by Daniel Whitehead, north by Moses Vail, east by Stephen Gildersleeve, and south by highway; Also a lot of land in the eighth tier of Lots, bounded south by Timothy Scudder and Thomas Rogers, west by Dicks Hills road, north by highway; Also a tract in the north tier of Lots joining to the highway west and south, and east by Thomas Bunce; Also a piece of land in the same tier of lots, bounded west by Thomas Bunce, south by highway, east by Jonathan Rogers; Also a certain piece of land formerly Eliphalet Woods, the west side joining to Thomas Bunce, north by highway, east by highway, and south by Jacob Conkling; Also a piece of land in the eastern Purchase, joining to Thomas Fleets, bounded south by highway, and west by Parritt Fleet, lying near Whitmans Hollow. All the rest of my lands I leave to my sons, Richard, Jeremiah, Thomas, and Zephaniah, viz., 1 lot, bounded north by Jonathan Wickes, east by highways, south and west by Noah Rogers; Also a lot bounded west and north by highway; Also a lot joining to the land formerly Eliphalet Woods and Jeremiah Smiths, on Cow Harbor Hills, in the Old Purchase, joining to the line that was run from the Rock, at the head of the Brook, or run, to the stone at the road; Also all my lands in the West Purchase joining to the piece aforesaid; Also a piece in the Eastern Purchase in Cow Harbor Hollow, joining north to Thomas Rogers, east, south, and west by highways; Also 1 1/4 acres on the south side of the above mentioned lands. My eldest sons, Zophar and Isaiah, are to pay to my four daughters £10 when they are of age. My eldest daughter Rhoda is to have £10, when my personal property is sold, and she is to have £10 more than her equal share, and she is to have the privilege of my back leanto, during her single life. (The other daughters not named.) I make my friends, Timothy Tredwell, Timothy Scudder, and George Weisart, executors. Witnesses, Daniel Whitehead, Edward Armstrong, George Weisart. Proved, April 3, 1750. Timothy Tredwell was then dead.

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In his will, he wrote: ...December 21, 1743, I, James Rogers, of Huntington, in Suffolk County, farmer, being very sick. I leave to my wife Mary, all my meadow and marsh by the Town Harbor that lies on the east side of the creek, and all my movable estate; Also the use of all houses, buildings, and lands until my son James is of age. I leave to my son James all lands, meadows, and buildings, except as otherwise ordered. It is my will that the two following pieces of land be sold for the benefit of my daughters, Mary, Deborah, and Rebecca; Namely, one piece of land called Daniel's field, bounded east by Obadiah Rogers, south by highway, west by James Chichester, and north by Obadiah Rogers. The other piece is a field which was formerly David Ketcham's, bounded south by highway, west by highway, north by my own land, and east by Sammis' land. These to be sold by my executors and the money paid to my three daughters when 18 years old. I make my wife Mary and my brother, John Rogers, and my brother-in-law, Jacob Rogers, executors. Witnesses, John Bryan, John Sammis, Ebenezer Prime. Proved, August 9, 1744.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Obadiah Rogers, of the town of Southampton, Suffolk County, yeoman, being in declining state of health. I leave to my son Zephaniah, my now dwelling house and barn at town with all my home lot adjoining, also my upper lot at Captain's Neck, and half of my lower close upland and meadow at Captain's Neck, and the south part of my lot at Wickapog as far as the great ditch, and half of my lot called Mill neck, and all my piece of meadow at Shinnecock, and half my woodland in the great south division, and my piece of land at the north end of town as you go to North Sea, and half my land at Pomeqwang, and one Fifty of commonage throughout the township, and half my lot beyond canoe place on the north side of the road as you go to Qwang, and half my meadow on the short point at Asup's Neck. To my grandson, Mathew Rogers, one quarter of a fifty right of woodland in the great south division. My will is that my grandchildren, Millisunt, Gabriel and Ruth, shall have a right in my house at Qwange, as a home as long as

In his will, he wrote: ...March 31, 1755, I, Thomas Rogers, of the town of Huntington, in Suffolk County, blacksmith. I leave to my wife Phebe the choice of rooms in my dwelling house, and the use of 1/3 of all lands and meadows, and 1/3 of my movables, "so long as she continues my widow, and in that character abides in my house, but if she marries and removes away, she shall have nobenefit of this bequest." I leave to my son Thomas, who is now in a weak, declining state, if he shall live to have another child, I give him my house and home lot where I now dwell, and 1/3 of all my other lands and meadows, except my swamp lot given to my son Josiah, out of which I give to my son Thomas 4 rods square adjoining to his tan house for the convenience of his tannery business. But if he does not live to have any more lawful issue, then the said lands are to go to my son, Josiah Rogers, except my house and home lot, which I give to my grand son, Stephen Rogers, son of my son Thomas. I leave to my son Thomas 1/6 of all movable estate. I leave to my son Josiah my swamp lot, and the house in which he dwells, and the shop, and the dam on the said lot, and 1/6 of all movable estate. I leave to my daughter, Abigail Foot, of Branford, Connecticut, 1/3 of movable estate. I leave £15 for the use and support of a Presbyterian minister in Huntington, to be put at interest for that purpose. I make my friend, Augustine Bryan, and my son, Josiah Rogers, executors. Witnesses, Thomas Oakes, Richard Platt, Ebenezer Prime. Proved, April 12, 1759.

The Rodgers/Rogers family lived in the Ringwood/Erskine/Boardville area of Pompton Twp. in the 1830's and 40's. The NJ 1830 census has Thomas Rodgers and probably a brother, David listed. Thomas died about 1835 and had 4 sons; William and John (probably the 2 on the 1840 census) and Jacob and Nickolas. He also has one daughter on the 1830 census, Mary Ellen, who married James Riley (they are also on the 1840 census) and maybe 2 others, Harriet (married David Babcock) and Ann (these may be David's, who also appears to have a son John on the 1840 census). Thomas was a blacksmith, as was James Riley, and family lore has them working at Ringwood Manor.¹

William Rogers owned land at Wethersfield, CT by 1640; In 1644 he was at Southampton, Long Island, NY, where he was one of the earliest settlers. He had a house on main street in 1648 which the family continued to own for seven generations. He was a freeman at Southampton on 6 March 1649. By 1655 he seems to have turned his house in Southampton over to his son Obadiah, and removed to Huntington. On 30 July 1656, the Matinecock Sachem and other Indians deeded to William Rogers, Jonas Wood, and Thomas Wilkes, the land needed for the settlement of Huntington, Long Island.¹

In his will, he wrote: ...I, William Rogers, of the town of Southampton, Suffolk County, yeoman, being in a weak and declining state of health. I leave to my wife Rhoda, £20 and a cow, "my will and order is that my sons William and Jonathan shall maintain my wife with all necessary medecines and comforts for her support, and she shall have the use of my west room, I also give her one silver spoon and a cow, summer and winter." I leave to my son, Jonathan Rogers, my dwelling house and buildings lying on the north side of the road, with my home lot and all the land adjoining to said home lot, bounded east by Nathaniel Rogers and Abraham Rose, northwest and south by the highway; Also my lot of land at Mill Stone Swamp, that I purchased of the heirs of Samuel Haines, and 8 acres of woodland in the Great Division, bounded west by my orchard, south by Nathaniel Rogers, east by Matthew Jagger. I leave to my son, William Rogers, all my land on the west side of the highway, commonly called the Neck, And all my Great Division land except the 8 acres left to my son Jonathan, and except the land ditched in with the Orchard. I also give him my land at Lots Orchard. I leave to my two sons my rights on Montauk, and my Commonage, and all the rest of my lands. I leave to my daughter, Hannah Halsey, œ26 and a silver spoon. To my daughter, Mary Halsey, £8 and a silver cup and spoon. To my daughter, Phebe, £4 and a spoon. To my daughter Esther, 5 shillings. I make my two sons executors, and they are to pay all debts and legacies. Dated November 10, 1775. Witnesses, Maltby Gelston, Nathaniel Rogers, Hannah Leonard. Proved, December 29, 1775.
