The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

On 25 Jan 1844, Tamar Ryckman, aged 79, a resident of Williamsburgh in Kings Co., NY, appeared before the Marine Court of the City of New York, applying for a Revolutionary War pension. She stated that she was the widow of Abraham Ryckman, who was a drummer and Drum Major during the Revolutionary War in the Infantry of the State of New York under Col. Lasher, Col. George Clinton, Col. Malcolm and Major or Col. Willets; that he was apprenticed to Col. Lasher at the commencement of the Revolution and that she believed he entered the service with him as Drummer with the very first

troops raised in the City of New York. He was imprisoned, but due to the influence of his mother, he was paroled; he broke his parole to go to Fishkill, where his brother then lived. He lived in New York City at the time of his death in Feb 1812. She was married to Abraham Ryckman Nov or Dec 1784. She signed with her mark. Included were family records from Prayer Book, of births of children. Her pension claim was denied for lack of proof of service.¹

Abraham Ryckman was a Private in Capt. Van Wyck's Co., Col. Brinkerhoff's Regt., New York State Militia between 1775 and 1777.

Albert Jans Ryckman was given power of attorney by stepfather Eldert Gerbertse Cruyff, when he sailed for Holland 6 Nov 1671, to manage his business.

Albert was a brewer and constable at Albany. He was an Alderman, Indian Commissioner, and Captain of the Foot Soldiers, Justice of the Peace, and Mayor of Albany. On 12 June 1707 he deeded to sons Harmanus and Peter, the lot with the brewery and mill.

In his will, he wrote: I, Albert Ryckman, of Albany County, brewer. I leave to the heirs of my son Johanes, deceased, 5 shillings. To my daughter Magdalena all my household goods and £12. "I will that my distilling kettle, with its appurtenances, and my negro man 'Marquis,' be sold, and the money used for payment of debts." All the rest of my estate to my children, Tryntie, Peter, Harmanus, Margaret, Tobias, and Magdalena, and to the children of my son Johanes, and to the children of my daughter Mary. I make my sons Harmanus and Tobias, and Benjamin Brat, executors. Dated December 23, 1736. Witnesses, Geritt Van Ness, Cornelius Van Dyke, Henry Holland. Proved, May 1, 1739.

I make my wife Caternichie, and my father, John Ryckman, Gerritt Christopher, and Philip Keizean, executors. All estate to be sold. (Will here illegible and torn.) I leave all the rest to my wife. The house and lot of Evert Ryckman is mentioned in a deed dated 17 January 1804 (recorded 21 Jan 1804, Bergen Co. Gerardus Ryker/Ryckman was killed at Bullsken, KY in Boone's and Tyler's defeat by the Indians. He was a soldier in the Revolution, and ensign in Major Mauritius Goetschius's Battalion of NJ Militia and a lieutenant in Col. Teunis Dey's Bergen Co., Militia.¹

Jan Janse Ryckman arrived in Beverwyck (later to be called Albany) along the banks of the Hudson River, prob. before 1640. It is not known when the family arrived from Holland, but it is possible that they settled first on the Delaware River near where Philadelphia now stands. There were Swedish, English and Dutch settlements on the Delaware, very early.

Jan Janse Dyckman died before 1663 because we find Tryntje remarried to **Eldert Gerbertse Cruyff**, a surveyor, from Cruyff's will of 3 July 1663. Witness to the will: Harmen Jansz. In 1671, on 6 November, Tryntje's 2nd husband decided to return to Holland. Before leaving, he gave power of attorney to his wife and stepson, Albert Janse Ryckman to manage his business.
