The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

He built, on water lots purchased from his father-in-law, by 1728, a wharf known as Schermerhorn's Wharf in the area known later as Fulton's Market. He apparently had business difficulties about March 1733 and Aug 1734 which led to his removal to Charleston, SC. From there, on 21 Jan 1733, Arnout Schermerhorn, late of the City of New York, but now of Charles Town in the Province of South Carolina, executed a full power of attorney to his wife Mary.

Jacob Janse Schermerhorn came out to Beverwyck in 1638. He made a visit to Amsterdam, where his father was residing, in 1654, leaving his large estate and business under the charge of Capt. Volckert Janse Douw, his attorney, during his absence. He was a prominent trader & brewer in Beverwyck. He made his will 26 May 1688, and died soon after in Schenectady.

Jannetje came to Rensselaerswyck in 1643 with her brothers, sisters and parents Cornelis Segers (called van Egmond and van Voorhout) and Bregje Jacobs.

Jacob Janse Schermerhorn was arrested at Fort Orange (Albany) in 1648 on Gov. Stuyvesant's orders on the charge of , with his business partner, Jacob Reynsen, obtaining arms and ammunition from the West India Company and selling them to the Indians.

John Schermerhorn, like his father and grandfather, was a merchant and mariner, and probably owner of vessels trading between New York and Charleston, S.C.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, John Schermerhorn, of New York, mariner, being at present sick. All personal goods, chattels, and slaves to be sold by my executors. I leave to my son Arnout £20, as being my eldest son. I have already given to my son Arnout £150 "towards advancing in the World," and I further give him £150. I leave to my children, Simon, Peter, Adam, Cornelius, Sarah, and Catharine, £300 when 21. My executors are to put £300 at interest, and the interest to be used for the support of my daughter Mary and her children, and after her death, it is to go to the children. My executors may sell all my lands when they think best, "and the reason why I leave the time and manner of selling to them is because I rely upon their Judgment, Prudence, and care." The money is to be divided among all my children, and the underaged children are to be supported out of the estate. I make my good friends, Jeremiah Brower, Laurence Kortright, and Isaac Sears, and Luke Van

Ranst, executors. Dated September 8, 1768. Witnesses, Evert Bancker, Benjamin Kissam, Nicholas Roulet, Jr. Proved, September 29, 1768.

In his will, he wrote: I, John Schermerhorn, of the township of Schenectady, farmer, being weak in body, this 28 of October, 1752. I leave to my son, Reyer Schermerhorn, £5, "for his primogeniture, or elder sonship"; I leave to my wife Engeltje the use of one third of my lands and grist-mill, during her widowhood, and the house where I dwell; also all the money that I may have, and my negro wench, and household furniture. I leave to my daughter Adriantie, wife of Claas De Groff, £100; to my daughter Gesina, wife of Philip van Petten, £100; to my daughter Catlyna, wife of John Dodde, £80; to my daughter Nieltje, wife of Claas Vielen, £100; to my daughter Magdalena, £130. I make my sons, Reyer, Symon, and Jacob, executors. Witnesses, Hendryckes Feder, miller, Jacob Vrooman, Hermanus Terwellgen. Proved, July 27, 1767, in Albany, before William Hanna, Surrogate.

Ryert Schermerhorn was one of the five patentees of Schenectady, granted in 1684. In 1690 he was a member of the Provincial Assembly at Albany. In 1700 he was appointed an associate judge of the court of Common Pleas.

In his will, he wrote: I, Ryert Schermerhorn, of Schenectady, Esq., do make this my last will and testament. I leave to my eldest son, John Schermerhorn, £5, in lieu of all demands or pretensions he might hereafter make to any part of my estate by virtue of priority of birth. I leave to my wife, Aryantie, all my real and personal estate during her life, and after her death I leave to my son John all my lands where I now live at Schenectady. And he is to convey and confirm unto John Wemp's three children, viz., Myndert, Ryert, and Ariantie, "procreated on the body of my deceased daughter, Catalina, late wife of John Wemps," the one half of the house and farm where my said son John now lives, on the north side of the Maques River above the town of Schenectady, and the other half to my daughter Juneke, the wife of Valkert Symonsen. I give to my son John the lot of ground lying in Schenectady and adjoining to the lots of ground of Hendrick Vroman and Barent Wemp. "I leave to my son Job, 8 morgen of the hindermost lot called No. 2, bounded east by land of Samuel Bratt; Also 5 1/2 morgen of woodland, bounded by the lots of Samuel Bratt and the woods; Also part of the lot in the town of Schenectady where he now lives, and which shall be 70 feet broad at the front, to be taken in the middle of the whole lot, which is 170 feet wide, and it is to keep the same width to the end of the lot, "Joyning westerly by the street, by the house now in the possession of Josias Swart." I leave to my son Arent, all that farm of land, called the Second Flatts, where Simon Groot, Jr., lately lived, with the woodland thereto belonging; Also one lot of ground in Schenectady lying on the west side of the lot belonging to Dow Antas De Frieze, being 50 feet wide in front, and 200 feet in length. "But it is my will that the 18 scheppels of wheat yearly forever to be paid for the ground rent of the said Second Flatts, are to be paid equally by my sons John, Job, and Arent." I leave to Ariantie Wemp, daughter of John Wemp, one lot of ground in the town of Schenectady, on the west side of the lot heretofore given to my son John, "being broad in front 50 feet, and long 160 feet. I leave to my daughter Janeke, wife of Volkert Symonsen, one half of my land in the Raritans in East Jersey. And I give the other half to my 3 grandchildren, Myndert, Ryert, and Ariantie Wemp, "with the condition that my youngest brother Lucas Schermerhorn shall enjoy the same for six years at the annual rent of one pepper corn." I also leave to my brother Lucas all my cattle on said land. I leave to Wilhelminus Symonsen, son of Geritt Symonsen, the lot of pasture ground, lying on the south side of the town of Schenectady, next to the lot of said Geritt Symonsen. I leave to Hannah Symonsen, daughter of Geritt Symonsen, "my lot in the Jerseys, called the Garsnegat." I leave to my son John my old negro man "Tom," and my negro boy "Abraham." To Ariantie Symonsen, wife of Daniel Daniels, I give one cow. I leave all the rest of my estate to my 4 children and to the children of my daughter Catalina deceased. Symon Schermerhorn removed to New York City in 1691, where he appears to have become the owner of a craft navigating the Hudson River.
