

-- SHUART --

The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

A Bergen County Road Return dated 9 June 1744 to "alter a four rod road at Maawier [Mahwah] in the precinct of Saddle River over the Land of Konraet Vreericks and Adolph Sioert" was recorded at the request of Adolph Sioert. Landmarks cited were the division line of Koenraet Vreericks and Johannes Slot; the highway by Samuel Bush Black Smith.<sup>1</sup>

On 3 Sep 1754, Lambert & Elizabeth Laroe, of Bergen County, NJ [sold] to Thomas Boggs, of same [for] £530, 100 acres purchased by said Laroe from William & Jane van Allen and David & Catherine Hennion 30 Sep 1758 ... corner to Adolpus Shaorts. Signed Lambert (x) Laroe and Elizabeth (x) Laroe. Wit: Joseph Watson, Johannes Ester(lin) and George Ryerse.<sup>2</sup>

On 13 September 1758, William and Gane Van Alen and David and Catrena Hennion, conveyed to Lambartus Laroe, of Ramapock, for £170, 100 acres...corner to Dolf Shut. Signed William Van Alen (his mark), Gane Van Alen (her mark), David Hennion (his mark), Catrena Hennion (her mark). Witnessed by Abel Noble, Timothy Rose.<sup>2</sup>

Adolph Shoort's will was dated 5 Feb 1753, probated 28 April 1761 (he being a yeoman of "Remopuck," [Ramapo] Bergen County, NJ). He mentioned his eldest son "Jost," the cow which he lent him; wife Margaret, use of real estate while his widow and at her decease to his three youngest sons, William, Hendrick and Johannes, and they are to pay to his eldest son, Jost, 20 pounds. Daughter Magdalena 25 pounds. If son Hendrick and daughter Jannetie should marry as the other children have, they are to have an outset. Executors were his eldest daughter and his friend Johannes Brower. Witnesses were Theodore Valleau, Daniel Brower, and Maria Brower, Probate granted to eldest daughter Magdaleen Shoort and Johannes Brower 28 April 1761.

Will of Adolphus Shurte proved 15 Apr 1840 NJ, Bergen Cty #4772B -- In the name of God Amen I, Adolphus Shurte, of the Township of Franklin in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey being not well in body but of sound mind, memory and understanding for which blessing I most devoutly thank my God-do this twenty second day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight Hundred and forty make ordain and publish this as and for my last Will and Testament in manner and form following Viz.-In the first place I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it. Trusting for salvation in the merits and atonementsof my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Andfor such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to blessing with, I do dispose of the same as follows: Item, I will and order that all my lawful debts and funeral charges and expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be after my decease by my executors herein after named out of my Personal Estate and in case if my personal estate should prove insufficient to pay my said debts (except what shall be herein after Reserved for the use of my beloved wife) then and in that case I will and order that my executors do sell so muchof my Real Estate as will be sufficient to pay all my said just debts and funeral charges and expenses as aforesaid. Item, All the rest residue and remainder of all my estate both real and personal I give and bequeath the use provide and income thereof unto my beloved wife Alida for and during the time she shall remain my widow (or lifetime unmarried) she my said widow however providing for the support and maintenance of my daughter Elizabeth for and during the time she shall remain unmarried or until she shall become possessed of her legal share or portions out of my estate and if my said daughter Elizabeth should enter into the bonds of matrimony at anytime before the death or remarriage of my said wife then and in that case I will and order that my executors provide her with an outset (or the amount she should thereof) the same as my my other daughters have had. And in case she should not better her situation by marriage and should survive my said wife than in that case it is my will that she my said daughter Elizabeth shall have an outset or the amount thereof more then my other children. Item, is my will and I do order that if in case it shall be thought most advisable and for the care and benefit of my said widow and for the advantage of my said heirs thereafter at any time after my decease (and before the decease of my said wife or her remarriage) to sell and dispose of my said real estate either at public or private sale for the best price that canbe obtained for the same and to give good and sufficient conveyance or conveyances in the law for the same as I myself could do if living and actingtherein-and the proceeds of said sale to benefit and place at interest by mysaid executors herein after named secured by Bond & Mortgage or otherwiseand the interest (or share part thereof as shall be required for the decent support and maintenance of my said widow be paid over to her yearly and her receipts shall be a good voucher for the amounts so paid to her. Item, all the rest and residue of said estate either real or personal which shall remain after my wife decease or remarriage I do dispose ofthe same as follows. Viz.-First I do give devise and bequeath unto my son Henry& to his heirs and his assigns forever five acres of land out of the southwest corner on the east side of the public road of my said farm-or the value or price thereof if my farm should be sold by my said executors-all theresidue and remainders I do give devise & bequeath to all my children equal share & share alike-and it is further my will that the share or portionwhich shall be allotted or shall be found to belong to my daughter Jane the wife -----remain the hands of my said executors & by them placed at interest and the process or interest paid over to her yearly from her own separate receipt for her own use & benefit and not to be under theconstraint of her present or any future husband nor liable for his or their said debts and after her decease the said share to be paid to the childrenequally and it is further my will and I do order that if any of my children should be indebted unto me or to myestate) at the time of my decease that indebtedness shall first be accounted for as part of their share. He was mentioned in the 3 April 1800 will of his stepfather, Isaac Gurnee. (Adolphus's mother, Lydia Conklin, m. (2) Isaac Gurnee.)

Adolphus was one of a group of men who petitioned the State of NY to allow them to purchase the land in the Patent of Wayawanda in Orange County [now Rockland] upon which they resided and had made improvements. This act was passed by the NY state Legislature 28 Mar 1800. [Wayawanda abutted Kakiak Patent] The act allowed the petitioners to purchase 100 to 400 acres of land for no less than 25-¢ per acre. [This source does not state how much, if any land Adolphus purchased. --Tompkins, A, "Historical Record to the Close of the Nineteenth Century of Rockland County, New York"; 1902]

Sioert Olferts came from [Heerenven] Friesland in *De Statyn*, 27 Sep 1663, with his wife [Ytie Roelofs] and child, 2 years old [Olfert], and his servant Foppe Johannis. Sioert Olferts settled in New York City and is the ancestor of the Sioerts or Shourd family.

Seurt Olphertsen, en syn huysv. Ytie Roelofse, were listed in the 1686 Dominie Selyns list of members of the NYC Ref Ch. They were living on Broadway. Listed before them were: ...Evert Aertsen [Willem Aertsen], en syn huysvr. Styntie Nage; Olphert Seurt, en syn huysvr. Margareta Kloppe; Helena Pieterse, h. v. Abraham Mathysen; Geurt Gerritsen, en syn huysv. Elisabeth Cornelis. Listed after them were: Anneken Mauritz, wed. v. Dom. Wilhelmus van Nieuwenhuysen; Tryntje Bickers, h. v. Walter Heyers; de Hr. Francois Rombout, en syn h. Helena Teller; Isaac Stephensen, en syn h. Margareta van Veen; Lucas Andrieszen, en syn h. Aefje Laurence; etc.<sup>3</sup>

"Sourt Olphertszen, Wed' Van —[Blank], en Heyltje Pieters, Wed' Van —[Blank], beyde woonende alhier," were married NYC Ref Ch with license 26 Sep 1697. On 26 September 1697, when the widower Soert Olfertsz married the widow, Heyltje Pieters, Soert was marrying his married children's mother-in-law.

An agreement (recorded in New York Wills) was made between Shuart Olpherts and his second wife, Heyltie Pieters: This Indenture, made this 23d of September, 1697, between Shuart Olpherts and Helike Clopper, widow of Cornelius Clopper, late of this city, blacksmith. The said Shuart Olpherts agrees that he will, before the first day of October next, "marry and take to wife, the said Helike Clopper, if the law of the Church will permit the same, and she the said Helike Clopper shall consent thereto." And the said Helike Clopper also agrees to marry the said Shuart Olpherts. In consideration of this, he agrees that if she survive him, his executors shall pay to her £150, in full of all dower rights. And she grants to him during his life, "a certain house and lot of ground on which she now dwells, being the corner of Maiden Lane fronting to Queen street, and ranging with Maiden Lane as far as the west side of the next lot adjoining to her garden." If he remarries then the house and lot shall go to her children. And she is to retain full control of all the rest of her property, and to dispose of it by will or otherwise.<sup>2</sup>

"Luke Suoerts, also called Shourd, was a "mariner", as were others of his race, at a later day. The name is evidently derived from the Swedish Christian name Shute. The ancestor, Sioert Olfertsen, emigrated from Heerenven, a large village eighteen miles southeast of Leuwarden, and for its beauty called the Friesland Hague. He sailed from Amsterdam September 27, 1663, in the ship *Statyn*, and with him his wife, Itie Roelofs, their child, Olfert, and servant, Foppe Johannes. In the same vessel came Minne Johannes, also from Friesland, whose descendants in Rockland County have borne the name of Minne or Manny. Sioert was a mason, and hence usually called Sioert de metselaer. He and wife joined the church in New York August 24, 1671. at the first communion under Dominie Nieuwenhuysen. He was assistant alderman in 1688 and 1689. He married, secondly, in 1697, Heyltie Pieters, widow of Cornelius Clopper, and again, in 1701 Janneke Snediker. He died in 1702, leaving all his property to his son Olfert. His daughter, Maria, born 1664, married Johannes Clopper. Olfert Sioerts, as called, born in Heerenveen, in 1661, took his father's trade, a bricklayer, but abandoned it for the sea. He married in 1682, Margaret, daughter of Cornelius Clopper, and in 1703, Hillegond, daughter of Skipper Lucas Andriessen. Captain [Olfert] Sioerts died in New York in 1710. His children that reached maturity were Mary, born 1686; Heyltie, born 1688; Sioert, born 1691; Aeltie, born 1695; Johannes, born 1701; Luke, born 1704; and Cornelius, born 1707. Heyltie [Olferts] married Johannes Roosevelt and has many descendants. Luke married Catherine Benson, January 6, 1728, but within five years left her a widow. Some of this family removed to Rockland County long prior to the Revolution."<sup>1</sup>

In her will, Hilletie Clopper Soerts wrote: New York, October 14, 1700. Helike Clopper "late widow of Cornelius Clopper; being sicke." "Whereas my husband Shuart Olpherts hath with me signed certain deeds, at my instance, for the better satisfaction of purchasers and my children, my children are to give him security to be held harmless in the same." Leaves all the rest of estate to her children or their heirs, namely 1/6 to the 3 children of my eldest son Johanes Clopper, Eightie, Cornelis and Anatjie. 1/6 to my son Cornelis Clopper. 1/6 to my daughter Margaret, wife of Olphert Shuarts. 1/6 to Catalina, wife of John Stevens. 1/6 to Peternell, wife of Albertus Van de Water. 1/6 to Dinah, wife of Wm. Cooley. My son in law Olphert Shuarts is to have the ground adjoining his lot as far as Nicholas Autom Bogart's land extendeth. Proved (???), 1700. Witnesses, Zacharias Sickles, Wm. Huddleston.<sup>2</sup>

In his will, he wrote: ...This 19th day of August, 1702, I, Shuart Olpherts, of the city of New York, being sick." Makes his son Olphert Shuarts sole heir to all his estate. Witnesses, Cornelius Clopper, Stephanus Bockenhoven, William Huddleston. Proved, October 5, 1702, before Dr. John Bridges.

In her will, Jannetje Snedeker Soerts wrote: In the name of God, Amen. Be it known that I, Jarminaye Sieurs, of New York, widow. I leave to my son in law, Hendrick Veghten, on the Island of Nassau, planter, my large silver tankard, weight about 40 ounces, and marked S. A. I. I leave to James Snediker a silver cup, weight about 8 ounces. I leave to my daughter Janeye, wife of Hendrick Veghten, my Bible with silver clasps, and my gold rings and one half of my clothes. I leave to my grand daughter, Janeye Veghten, a gold ring and two gold breast hooks. I leave to my grand daughter, Hilley Veghten, my silver cup with two ears. To my grand children, Reynier, Simesse, and Gretie Veghten, each a silver spoon. To my grand daughter, Janeye Albertse, daughter of Albert Stevense, a gold ring and a couple of gold breast hooks. To my grand daughters Cornelia

and Willimentie, daughters of Albert Stevense, each a silver spoon. To my grand son, Peter Jansen, son of Jan Stevense, a negro boy. To my grandson, Stephen Jansen, son of Jan Stevense, a large silver beaker or goblet. All the rest to my daughter Janeye, wife of Hendrick Veghten, and to the children of Jan Stevense and Albert Stevense. I make Hendrick Voughten and Jan Snediker executors. Dated October 1, 1709. Witnesses, David Provoost, Abraham Gouverneur. Proved, November 26, 1709.<sup>2</sup>

I leave to, my wife Hillegonde, all houses, lands and tenements, and immediately after my death she shall expose the same for sale at an open outcry or public vendue, and after payment of debts, the rest to my wife and children. Shuart, Hon. William Dean, was born in the town of Mendon, Monroe county, August 11, 1827, received an academic education, and attended Genesee Wesleyan Seminary at Lima, N.Y. He read law with D. G. Shuart, George P. Townsend and Smith & Cornwell, of Lyons, N. Y., and afterwards entered the Law School at Ballston, Spa, from which place he was graduated and was admitted to practice in Schenectady, N.Y., in 1850. The following year he opened a law office in Rochester, and in 1863 was elected city attorney by the Common Council. In June, 1864, he was commissioned in the army as paymaster,

with rank of major, served until the close, and mustered out at Louisville, Ky., in November, 1865. He returned to Rochester and resumed his practice, and in 1867 was nominated and elected surrogate of Monroe county, twice re-elected, and served in all sixteen years. January 1, 1884, he formed a partnership with Hon. William A. Sutherland, under the firm name of Shuart & Sutherland, to which Hon. Arthur E. Sutherland was subsequently admitted but has since withdrawn. Mr. Shuart is a very successful practitioner, is authority on all cases involving the settlement of estates, and his decisions while surrogate were seldom reversed by higher courts, and is one of the most popular men and promising lawyers in Western New York.<sup>1</sup>
