In his will, he wrote: ...I, Exbarth Somerdick, of Rombout Precinct, Dutchess County, January 12, 1765. I leave to my wife Elizabeth £100, in lieu of dower, to be paid in three months. I leave to my son William £15, in lieu of his Birthright, to be paid as soon as he shall come of age or be married. My executors are to sell all my estate, real and personal, and the money and all the rest of my money to be put at interest and paid to my wife yearly, while she remains my widow or until my children, Sarah, William, and Jacob, are of age, "to be applied for bringing up and educating them, and then to my three children equally." I make my good friends, Mr. Tunis Somerdick, of New York, Mr. Joseph Harris, and Zacharias Van Voorhis, all of Dutchess County, executors. Witnesses, Nathaniel Sackett, Isaac Terbush, Thomas Ludlow. Proved before Samuel Van Kleeck, Esq., Judge of Common Pleas, and James Duncan and William Humfrey, Justices, June 11, 1765.

In his will, he wrote: ...I Jacob Somerindick, of the Out Ward of New York, yeoman, being sick. I leave to my eldest son Tunis £25, in satisfaction of all demands as heir at law. I leave to my wife Amarantie 1/7 of all the remainder, and all the rest to my sons, Tunis, Albert, Ann, Abigail, John, and Jacob. My son Albert is to pay £50 to my wife and the rest of my children. I make my wife and my son Tunis, executors. Dated October 7, 1750. Witnesses, Benjamin Stout, Bernardus Savage, John Van Cortlandt. Proved, March 11, 1751.

In his will, he wrote: ...February 8, 1759. I, Tunis Sommerindike, of Greenwich, in the Out Ward of New York, yeoman, being weak in body. After payment of debts, I leave to my wife Gertry all my estate, real and personal. I make my wife and William Burnham, gardener, executors. Witnesses, Jellis Mandeville, John Crygier, innholder, G. Furman. Proved, May 8, 1760. February 8, 1759. [NOTE.--The farm of Tunis Sommerindike, and his father Jacob before him, was the tract of land afterward known as "Chelsea." He and his father sold it to Captain Thomas Clarke, August 16, 1750. It contained 94 acres. It extended from 21st street to 28th street, and from the Hudson river to a line between 6th and 7th Avenues. Captain Clarke died in 1777, and left it to his widow, who left it in turn to her daughter Charity, wife of Rev. Bishop Benjamin Moore, from whom it descended to their son, Clement C. Moore, famous as a scholar, but still more famous as the author of "The Night before Christmas." The Episcopal Theological Seminary stands on this tract.-- W. S. P.]

In her will, she wrote: ...June 6, 1760. I, Gertrey Sommerindike, widow of Tunis Sommerindike, late of Greenwich, in the Out ward of New York, being sick. I direct all debts and funeral charges to be paid. I leave to my brother, Joseph Harris, the gun that was my late husband's. I leave to my brother in law, John De Wyt, the hunting saddle of my late husband. To my cousin, Nicholas Sommerindike, £5. To Margaret Horne £5, also my household furniture that was my late husband's mother's. To my sister, Sarah Brown, one silver table spoon and a tea spoon, to be delivered at the discretion of my sister, Anne De Wyt. I leave to my cousin, Catharine De Wyt, one silver table spoon and tea spoon, and the same to my cousins, Catharine Harris and Anne Sommerindike. To my sister, Anne De Wyt, my best bed and furniture. All the rest of my estate, real and personal, I leave to my sisters, Anne De Wyt and Elizabeth Sommerindike. I make my uncle, John Cregier, and my brother in law, John De Wyt, executors. Witnesses, Peter Van Norden, Jacob Horne, George Furman. Proved, July 21, 1760.

In his will, he wrote: I, Teunis Somarindick, of the Seventh Ward of New York, farmer, being weak and sick. All debts to be paid. I leave to my wife Cornelia, to be at her disposal, one horse cart, one horse, and two cows, as she shall choose, and all my hogs and fowls. And I leave to her during her natural life, the use of the whole house wherein we now live, with all the furniture, and barn and orchard, and four acres of land adjoining the house, with wood for fuel, and pasturage on any part of my farm, for a horse and two cows, with those of my son Richard. My will is that at the end of three months, my son Richard and my daughter Sarah shall pay to my widow £2, 10s. and they shall each of them pay to her the like sum at the end of every three months. I leave to my wife a negro man, and a negro woman. I leave to my daughter Sarah all that parcel of land sold to me by Jacobus Myer on July 28, 1761, containing 26 acres, 2 roods, 24 poles, as by deed. I leave to my son Richard all the rest of my lands, houses, and barns, and my salt meadow lying on the Jersey shore. My black woman, Jane, and her children are to be sold, but she shall have the privilege of choosing places for them. The rest of my cattle are to be sold, and the money to be divided among my sons and daughters. I make my son, Richard, and James Striker, executors. Dated March 21, 1796.
