The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

I leave to my second son John, 178 acres of land next to Cornelius Blewfields, and he is to pay to his two sisters £20 each. I leave to my eldest daughter (not named), wife of John Aber, 138 acres of land where she now lives, and she is to pay to my two youngest daughters, Janakie and Leah, £20 each. I make my wife, Catharine Strought, executor. Signed, Derick X Strought. (his mark). Witnesses, Reynier Keyserick, John Ellison, Henry Ludlow. William Cosby, Esq., Captain-General, and General-in-Chief of the Provinces of New York and New Jersey. To all to whom these presents may come. Know ye, that at New York, on the 2nd day of August, 1732, before Frederick Morris, thereto delegated, the will of Dirck Straut Mogerer was proved. [Note.--In the above will the testator is called Dirck Strought, but it is indexed as Stroutmaker.--W. S. P.]<sup>1</sup>

On 18 December 1804 (recorded 12 March 1805, Bergen Co. U:62) John Straat of the Township of Franklin, farmer, and Susannah, his wife, conveyed to Jacob Straat of the same place, for \$267.50, 15 acres strict measure in Franklin Township, beginning at road near the bridge. Signed by John Straat (his mark), Susannah Straat (her mark). Witnessed by Jacob Bamber, Elizabeth Bowman (her mark).<sup>1</sup>

Peggy Wanamaker, wife of Jacob Straut, was mentioned in a Petition: dated: 7 December 1832, filed: New City, Rockland Co., NY. Derick Wanmaker died at Hempstead, now Ramapo, about sixteen or seventeen years ago leaving a son Cornelius Wanmaker and three daughters, Rachel, widow of William Bush, Polly wife of Casperus Barbaro, and Peggy wife of Jacob Straut.

She also having a right to will those [to will those] articles to her own children..... Item: I do further will and bequeath my real estate and residue of my personal estate which is not herein before bequeathed to my four sons, namely in manner and form following Viz: Item: I give and bequeath unto my son Jacob Straut all the land which lies on the South end of my farm wherin I now live lying on the South side of a line which runs Parralel with the North line of a lot of ground sold by my said son Jacob Straut to James Carlough both on the West side of said lot and on the South end of said lot, lying South of the said northernmost line of the said lot sold by my said son Jacob Straut to the said James Carlough containing twenty two acres and sixty five hundrends of an acre.....Item 5: I give and bequeath to my son James.....Item 6: I give and bequeath to my son Richard..... Item 7: I give and bequeath to my son John.....Item 8: I give and bequeath to my said sons, Jacob, John, Richard and James Straut all my personal estate.....Item 9: I order and direct my four sons to pay unto my oldest daughter Margarete, the wife of David Van blarcum the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, and to my daughter Sarah, wife of George Carlogh the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars and to my daughter Susanna, wife of Jacob May, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars..... Executors: Four sons. [Signed by X 'his mark'] Witnesses: Garret A Zabriskie, Adolphus Shurte, David Christie.<sup>2</sup>

A true and perfect inventory....John Straut. Dated 26 July 1828. Purse and appareal \$13.00; House hold goods \$60.35; Goods found in the celler \$18.25; Goods found out of Doors \$22.68; Cows, Sheep, Swine and fowls \$37.50; Bonds, Notes (Estimated[?] good) \$446.07; Outstanding Debt in the Hands of David Van Blarcum \$2.00. Amount \$604.85 Appraised by David Christie and Adolphus Shurt.<sup>2</sup>

Susanna's will, dated 7 February 1839, mentioned her dec'd husband John Straut; sons, Richard, John, and James; dau. Susannah, wife of Jacob May; and her dec'd brother Michael Ryer. In her will, Susanna wrote about her son John not paying certain debts, and also wrote: "And whereas in the settlement of the Estate of my deceased Brother Michael Ryer deceased I did account for ? pay off a note for seventy five Dollars given by my said deceased Husband in his life time to the said Michael Ryer bearing date the first day of May A.D 1822 - which I accounted for & paid"
