The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

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**Tallman**

The original spelling of this name was Taelman, and occasionally Talma, which literally translated means a linguist or an interpreter. The early records of the Dutch branch of the family in this country are found under the patronymics of Harmens, Harmense, Hermzen, Harmenszen, Dowsa, Douwens and Douwenszen. The first known American ancestor of this branch of the family was Douwe Harmense Taelman, who with his wife and children emigrated from the province of Friesland, Netherland, in the ship Brownfish, arriving in New Amsterdam on the 19th of June, 1658. While in the "Records of New Amsterdam" he is mentioned as having been in the courts upon different matters in the years 1658 and 1659, we have reason to believe he took up his residence at Bergen, now a part of Jersey City, soon after his arrival in this country. For we also find in the same records that in the description of a plot of land he bought on the east side of "Heere Gracht" (Broad Street), in New Amsterdam, on August 2, 1662, he is mentioned as being a resident of Bergen. And in December of the same year he subscribed six florins a year for the support of a minister at this latter place.' In an official survey of some plots or tracts of land "in the new maize lands," made by Jacques Cortelyou, C.E., for Douwe Harmense in November, 1660, lying in and about the Town of Bergen, preparatory to making an application for a patent for the same, the name of Bergen was first used; and the patent for such plots was granted by Governor Philip Carteret for some five parcels under date of May 12, 1668. This same patentee later secured a further patent for lands embracing the present village of Nyack, N. Y.

Douwe Harmense Taelman died at Bergen and was buried on the nineteenth of June, 1687. A declaration of his will was recorded in the office of the Secretary of State, at Trenton, N. J. All his property was left to his two sons, Harmen Douwenszen Taelman and Thunis Donwenszen Taelman, who soon after their father's death removed to Nyack, N. Y. The older son, Harmen, died early in life, and previous to April, 8, 1691; as on this date his widow was married to Abraham Blauvelt. The younger son, Thunis, finally came into possession of most of the estate left by his father, and died at Nyack, N. Y., July 17,

1739. From these two sons have descended most of the families bearing the name of Tallman, Talman, or Taulman. And while in their early history they resided in the vicinity of New York City, they may now be found in nearly every section of the United States. — Records of the Reformed Protestant Dutch Church of Bergen in New Jersey 1666-1788 edited and translated by Dingman Versteeg and Thomas E. "In Friesland, a northern province of the Netherlands with a language of its own, one family spelled its name Talma. Douwe Harmansen (Talma) and his wife, Dirckje Theunisse, emigrated to New Amsterdam in 1658. Their first son, Harman Douwensen, an Indian trader, seems to have been Orange County's first settler in 1675. Harman died after only two children were born to him and his wife. (A daughter of Minne Johannes, she subsequently married Abraham Blauvelt.) Harman's descendants generally use the Talman spelling, or in some lines of descent, Taulman. Harman's younger brother, Theunis, married twice and had a large family whose descendants spell the name Tallman."—Talman

They lived first at Greenbush, a small settlement near Tappan, and after the Revolution settled at what later became Tallman's (Tallman, Rockland Co., NY).

During the Revolution he was a scout in the service of the American Army and a reward of 35 guineas was offered by the British authorities for his capture. He was in the New York Militia. He is recorded as a private soldier in Captain William Sickel's company, belonging to the Orange County Regiment, from the Haverstraw precinct, under the command of Colonel A.H. Hay. This was a portion of the New York state militia which was employed in active service during the war. He received a commission from Governor George Clinton dated September 28, 1786, as ensign, No. 2, in Captain Cornelius J. Blauvelt's company of the corps of state militia of the precinct of Tappan.

Jan, or John Tallman, purchased a farm of one hundred and fifty-seven acres, receiving a deed March 23, 1797, at Tallman's, for which he paid one thousand five hundred and twenty-five pounds."

Phenny Meby, wife of John Talman, was a member of the Saddle River Reformed Church in July 1812 when it separated from the Paramus Reformed Church.

Theunis Douwes Tallman in 1690 was an ensign in the Orange Co. Militia. In 1700 he was appointed the first High Sheriff of Orange County, NY (which then included present Rockland County). He was said to have built the stone house (supp. 1678), standing until 1910, on Upper Broadway, near Tallman Place, Nyack. Additions were made at later dates.

On 31 October 1705, Tunis Dowson and Breghe Talman, of Orange County conveyed to Matthias DeMott, blacksmith, of Bergen County, for £2.5, near Bergen behind Christian Patterson...between Garret Corteen and Caspar Stynmott...between Adrian Post and Derick Tunison Jr., patented 12 May 1668 by Dow Harmansen. Signed Tunis Dowson Talman (his mark), Breghe Dowson Talman (her mark). Witnessed by Casparus Danole van Boskerk, William Huddlestow, David Provoost.<sup>1</sup>

He married (2) after the death of Brechtje (who apparently died in childbirth, giving birth to triplets), 11 January 1710

In his will, he wrote: ...I, William Talman, of Flushing, in Queens County, being this 2 day of June, 1766, in a weak state of health." My executors are to pay all debts. I leave to my wife Mary the rents and profits of all my houses, lands, meadows, and my grist-mill, until my eldest son, John, is of age; And if she continues my widow, she is to have the use of two thirds until my son William is of age, and then she is to have the use of one third until my youngest son, Oliver, is of age; Also the use of all my negroes and live stock, to enable her to carry on the farming business. When my sons are of age they are each to have one third, and my wife is to have the use of my west dwelling-house, with chamber and lean-to on the north side, and the use of barn, and sufficient firewood, and two cows, to be kept on my farm winter and summer, and a horse and riding-chair, "and bread corn of all sorts, and meat of different kinds," and two good feather beds, so long as she remains my widow, "and no longer." If she marries, she is to have £500, and a horse and riding-chair, and a negro woman, "and my large Looking Glass in the west room." I leave to my three sons my negro man "Samuel." My executors may sell "the house and land where Elizabeth Smith now lives, and which my father, John Talman, deceased, bought of Benjamin Farrington, deceased, and which formerly belonged to John Man, deceased, lying in Flushing." I leave to my three sons all my houses, lands, buildings, and mill, and rights of land and meadow. My eldest son, John, is to have the dwelling-house and buildings where I now live, and enough land to make his share one third. My youngest son, Oliver, is to have my grist-mill. "My sons and daughters are to be well brought up, educated, and well schooled, suitable to their circumstances." I leave to my three sons £3,000, to be put at interest. I leave to my eldest daughter, Anna Talman, a negro girl and £1,000; To my youngest daughter, Jane Talman, £1,460 when she is 18 or married. I leave to my wife 1/3 of household goods, and the rest to my daughters. All the rest of my estate to my 5 children. I leave to each of my sons a negro man and a horse, and my daughters are to dwell in the house and be supported till married. "My will is that my son William shall have Common Learning at our Common School, and after that he shall be put out to a Grammar School, to learn Latin, Hebrew, and Greek, and qualifie him to Learn the Law, and when he is fit for the Law to put him to the Study of the Law with an able Lawyer, the expense to be taken out of his share." I make my wife, and my loving brothers, Valentine Hewlet Peters, John Rodman, and Samuel Willis, of Jericho, executors. Witnesses, Thomas Foster, Cornelius Monfort, Jr., Peter Monfort. Proved, July 16, 1766.

He came to Allendale, Bergen Co., NJ about 1884. In 1890 plans were being drawn up for his new house, to be built by Van Blarcom. In 1905 he sold his house. They lived on Myrtle Avenue at the time of the 1910 Federal Census (and in 1920, in a house they owned). They lived at 106 Powell Road at the time of her death in 1933. William C. Talman owned the house at 106 Powell Road in 1940.

She lived at Rutherford at the time of their marriage.

He was listed in the 1900 Federal Census as a superintendent in a drug house. Living with them at the time of the 1900 Federal Census was his mother, Emma L. Talman, b. Sep 1835 NY, widow, mother of 4 children, 2 then living. In June 1905 they were living in a rented house on Franklin Turnpike (near Ilsley), and his mother, Emma, was living with them.

He was president of the Allendale Board of Education, charter vice-president of the Allendale Fire Association in 1910; secretary of the Orvil Building & Loan Association (elected April 1898).

She was an Allendale Borough Councilwoman, a county committeewoman, president of the Allendale Woman's Club, and was on the Allendale Library Board. She was an acting librarian in Nov 1921, was secretary of the Allendale Library Association, and signed the certificate of incorporation of the Library in 1923.

About 26 May 1923 William C. Talman and his wife conveyed to William H. Hoffman and wife, a lot near Talman Place.

On 29 August 1967 (Hackensack 5088: 408) the premises at 106 Powell Road were conveyed from Ruth Epstein-Honig, Executrix of the Last Will and Testament of M. Genevieve Talman, deceased, Ruth Epstein-Honig, widow, Renee T. Buhlman, widow, Marie Arnold, widow, Ruth Heidrich and Harold E. Heidrich, her husband, Florence Maeder and William Maeder, her husband, Hazel Dempster, widow, Florence H. Carlson [dau. of -?- Vreeland & Anna Rachel Vreeland; Anna Rachel Vreeland was Henrietta L. Vreeland's sister] and Alfred Carlson, her husband, to William E. Horton and Avonne K. Horton, his wife.

*---children of William C. Talman & Henrietta L. Vreeland:*

- **Mary Genevieve Talman**, b. May 1895 East Rutherford, NJ; d. April 1967 Allendale, Bergen Co., NJ; buried Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson. She never married. She graduated from the Allendale Grammar School in 1909. She was a teacher, and a retired principal of the Franklin School in East Rutherford. She lived at 106 Powell Road, Allendale at the time of her death. She apparently left the house to a number of relatives, friends and neighbors (see transaction cited above).
- **William Vreeland Talman**, b. May 1901 NJ; d. before April 1967. He graduated from the Allendale Grammar School in 1919.
