The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

On 3 May 1803 (recorded 22 November 1805, Bergen Co. W:178) Cornelius Van Buskirk of the Township of Bergen, and Jane, his wife, conveyed to Jacob A. Terhune and Abraham A. Terhune of Harington, for \$936.25, four lots of land and meadow in the Township of Harington between Wearimus and Saddle River: (1) 18 acres strict measure. (2) 4-3/4 acres strict measure meadowland bounded N by land of John Van Burkerk; E by Arie Teurs; S and W by aforesaid 18 acres. (3) 5 acres more or less of meadow bounded S by said John Van Buskerk; E and N by Cornelius Demarest; W by said Cornelius Demarest and partly by aforesaid 18 acres. (4) 13-3/4, 20 Rods strict measure upland beginning at SW corner of said 18 acre lot; mentioned swamp, bounded S by David Baldwin; N by Thomas L. Van Buskerk; E by said 18 acres. Signed by Cornelius Van Buskirk (his mark), Jane Van Buskirk (her mark). Witnessed by David Baldwin, Abrm. Westervelt.<sup>2</sup>

On 19 April 1804 (recorded 22 November 1805, Bergen Co. W:175) Aurie Tuers of Harington and Rachel, his wife, conveyed to Jacob A. Terhune and Abraham A. Terhune, both of the same place, for \$52.50, 1-1/4 acres and 37 Rods of woodland in Harington; mentioned swamp land; small brook. Bounded N by meadowland of said Jacob and Abraham Terhune; E and S by land of said Aurie Tuers; W by small brook. Signed by Aurie Tuers (his mark), Rachel Tuers (her mark). Witnessed by Cornelius Forshure, John Davd. Haring.<sup>2</sup>

They are listed in the 1850 Federal Census, Washington Twp., dwelling 961, family 1060. He is listed as a farmer, with real estate valued at \$6,000. Living with them are Andrew McCruin, 12, b. Albert Albertse Terhune (Terheun) was a Huguenot who went from France to Holland and then to New Utrecht, L.I.<sup>1</sup>

Albert was called "Albert the Lient-wever" (ribbon weaver). In 1654 "June 2. Order [of the court]. Albert Lintwever, not to infringe the rights of Eghbert van Borsum, who has rented the ferry, by passing people over the river." On 19 Aug 1660, there was a "Judgment. Against Albert Albertsen, *alias* Ribbon Weaver, for not removing into a village agreeably to the ordinance."<sup>5</sup>

He lived first at New Amsterdam, then in 1657 at the Nyack Patent in New Utrecht, L.I.; then after 1663 to Flatlands. Albert Albertse Terhune, with others, received a patent for 5000 acres on the Passaic River in New Jersey.

3 Oct 1662 -- Fiscal Nicasius de Sille appears in Court with Jan van Cleef and Titus Cyre stating, that they bought Jacob van Couwenhoven's horse mill and that Titus Cyre sold his share to Jan van Cleef, who sold it to Albert Albertsen Lintwever [Terhune]; on which aforesaid horse mill he paid and disbursed above his just third part the sum of two hundred and ten guilders, and that he and Albert Albersen again sold the mill, as they bought it, according to agreement therefor, to Jacobus Backer, Govert Loockermans, Jacques Cosseau, and Hendrick van de Water, and that the aforesaid Albert Albertzen has given an assignment of four hundred guilders on the abovenamed van de Water, which remarking a fearing, that he should not get his own, he directed the Court Messenger to attach the money, which being done requests the attachment to be declared valid, until it shall be found to whom the most is belonging. The Worsh. Court declares the attachment valid.<sup>6</sup>

Tuesday, 16th Oct. 1663 Court Minutes of New Amsterdam: "Abraham Pietersen Corbyn, arrestant and pltf, v/s Geertje Dircks Terhune, the ribbon weavers wife, defendant and arrested. Pltfs. wife appearing demands from deft. thirty three guilders ten stivers balance according to a/c saying, she still has an old a/c, which her husband has with him, whereby something else is also coming to her. "Deft. produces a counter account. The W. Court refers the matter in question to Hendrick Jansen van der Vin, Old Schepen of this city, and Hans Stein, to take up parties a/c, to decide and settle the same, to reconcile the parties if possible, if not to render their report to the Court, the attachment remaining so long valid, until parties shall agree among themselves."

Albert lived first at Flatlands, then moved to Hackensack in 1676. His will dated 16 Feb 1707/8, pr. 29 Sep 1709 (rec. p. 420, Lib. 7, Surr. of NY). He lived at Hackensack on land obtained by his father by a patent from Gov. Carteret. Albert was a member of the East Jersey Legislature in 1696.

In Hackensack, he built a home (torn down in 1952 for a parking lot for the Sears Roebuck store in Hackensack) and a grist mill, possibly a tide-water mill, probably located between what is today Hackensack and the area known as New Bridge.<sup>1</sup>

In a will dated 3 Oct 1704 (but later superseded), Albert Terhuynen of Hackensack in the province of East New Jersey, husbandman, gives to wife Weyntye Terhuynen all estate real and personal during the term of 14 years from and after my decease, and at the expiration of said 14 years she shall make a perfect inventory of my personal estate and deliver one-half part thereof unto my children by names John, Stephen, Anntie, Gerbring, Williamke, Maritye, Rachel, Albertus, and Geertruyd in equal proportion and the other half part thereof unto my said wife Weyntye for and during her natural life. And if my said wife happen to remarry before the expiration of said term of 14 years, then before the consummation of said marriage she shall give a perfect inventory of all my personal estate unto my said executors hereinafter named, and give a sufficient security to them for the delivery of the half part thereof unto my children at the expiration of said 14 years if they then be of age, but if not, when they shall be severally of age or married....Son John £5 for birthright. Executors wife Weyntye and brothers Capt. John Terhuynen and Jacob Wallingse. Witnesses: Henry ffilkin, Derick Amertman, and Johannes Slyngerhaut. (Recorded Liber 3, Kings County Conveyances, p. 13)<sup>1</sup>

Albert A. Terhune's will dated 16 Feb 1707-08 was proved 20 Sep 1709. In his will, he wrote: In the name of God, Amen, the 16 February, 1707/8. I, Albert Terhunes, of Hackensack, in the county of Essex, in the Province of New Jersey. I appoint my brother, John Terhunes, of Flatlands, in Kings County, and my brother-in-law, Albert Stevens, of Hackensack, tutors of my children. Provision is made for wife Mary, who is to have, among other things, a gold ring, "being in weight and price £1." All the rest of estate to children John, Stephen, Gertruyd, Willementie, Maritie, Rachel, Albertus, Johanes, Dirck, Wyn-tie, and Annettie. My wife is to have the northwest chamber in the house, and firewood, and a piece of ground for a garden, and 10 schepples of corn and 6 schepples of wheat yearly. "Done at my common dwelling house in Hackensack, in the cellar chamber at 9 of the clock in the evening." Witnesses, William Borthoff, Claas Rugen, Albert Scerens, John Conrad Codwin. Proved, September 20, 1709.

By deed dated June 10, 1711, Roeloff Terhuynen and Marike his wife, and Albert Terhuynen and Aetkie his wife, after reciting that there was a certain message, - describing the one by the Strom Kill in substantially the same language as the language of the deed from Coert Stevensen the patentee and Marretje to Gerrit Coerte - and other property, describing it, 'with the rights and priveleges of commons within said township, said message containing' about 168 acres, and reciting that the land described was late in the possession of Gerret Coerte, late of Flatlands, deceased, and was bequeathed by him 'to his six children in equal proportions,' with other recitals, conveyed to 'Coert Van Voorhuys' two equal sixth shares in the lands and rights of common mentioned in the recitals. (Liber 3 of Conveyances, p. 230.)<sup>4</sup>

Albert made his will at Flatbush 11 April 1721 and it was proven 18 Dec 1721. In his will he wrote: In the name of God, Amen. April 11, 1721. I, Albert Terhunen, of Flatbush, in Kings County, being sick. I leave to my wife Altie all my estate of houses, lands and meadows in Flatbush during her life. But if she marries, she is to have the use of the estate for bringing up my children, so as she can best agree with the major part of my executors. When my eldest son is of age he shall possess all houses, lands and meadows, and he shall pay rent for bringing up the younger children, and he shall pay to his mother £100 yearly. And after her decease the £100 shall go to my five children, John, Geritt, Arme, Willimentie and Sarah. And my son John shall pay to the other children £260. It is my will that all that tract of land at Princeton, in New Jersey, which I have bought from Mr. Walter Thong, of New York, shall be sold for the payment of debts. My son John is to have £5 for his birth right. I make my wife Altie and my father-in-law, Peter Nevius, and my brother, Roelof Terhunen, and my brother-in-law, Koert Voorhees, my executors. Witnesses, Peter Wyckhoff, John Elbertsen, S. Gerritsen. Proved, December 18, 1721.

It is probably this Albert Terhune who bought 330 acres (prob. in present Upper Saddle River) on 27 Oct 1746 from Isaias Valleau and Leah his wife. This property was bounded north by land of Jacobus debane; east by Saddle River; south by land

of John Verwey; and west until it makes up the full quantity of 330 acres.

Albert probably built, in the 1760s, an earlier house on the southwest corner of Lake Street and West Saddle River Road in Upper Saddle River, Bergen Co., NJ where the later Terhune-Hopper-Taylor House stood (part of the old house probably became the kitchen wing of the new house on the site). Stone salvaged from this earlier house was probably used in the 1820s in building the Harmon Terhune house up the road on the corner of Holly Drive.<sup>1</sup>
