The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

Daniel Thew of Pond Marsh, in Orange County, was a member of the New York Assembly in 1792-1793.¹

Peter De Wint Smith, of Clarkstown, was granted Letters of Administration on the Estate of Daniel Thew, Nov. 2, 1811. In the inventory of the decedent's personal estate, dated Nov. 10, 1811, the following item appears: Pleasure carriage, \$250.00.

In "An Act for the relief of the legal representatives of Daniel Thew, deceased. Passed February 28, 1812," Elijah Hunter and Caleb S. Riggs were guardians of the persons and estates of the "infant children of Daniel Thew, late of the town of Clarkstown..." The guardians were given the right to sell the real estate for the maintenance and education of the children, but allowing one third of the profits to Rachel Thew, in dower right, as mother of Daniel Thew.²

On 10 August 1800, Peter and Nancy Ward, of Bergen County, conveyed to James Thew of Franklin Township, for \$250, 23.85 acres purchased from William and Elizabeth Teusbury, 15 May 1798. Signed by Peter Ward, Nancy Ward. Witnessed by John Felter, Cornelius Carr.¹

On 3 March 1804 (recorded 12 March 1804, Bergen Co. R:390) James Thew of the Township of Franklin, and Sarah, his wife, conveyed to Harmanus Van Zile of same place, for \$1500, two tracts: (1) 216-38/100 strict measure being 7 equal twelfth parts of One undivided Moiety or equal half part of tract of land in Bergen County being part of tract of land called the Ramapock Patent and known in a map thereof by Farm or Lot No. 172, beginning SW corner John Verway's tract of Saddle River; conveyed to said James Thew by Henry Van Wert and Hannah, his wife, 18 Oct 1798. (2) 230 acres and a quantity of land granted to contain 23-85/100 acres, and also equal half of 5 equal 24th parts pf said Lot No. 172. Signed by James Thew, Sara Thew. Witnessed by Abrm. Westervelt, Jacob Stoltz.³

In his will dated 28 Feb 1784, probated 5 April 1784 NYC, "John Thew, yeoman, of Haverstraw Precinct, Orange County" mentioned wife Elizabeth; son Jacobus (by my present wife); sons by first wife; son Thunis; [son] John; mentions five sons to share estate equally (but does not name them). Makes brother Abraham and brother-in-law Johannes Blauvelt executors. Witnesses were Isaac Sherwood, Thomas Lawrence of said precinct, yeoman; David Pye.

Another abstracted version: John Thew, yeoman, of Haverstraw Precinct, in his will dated Feb. 28, 1784, probated Apr. 5, 1784 in New York City, Weak in body, Mentioned Wife, Elizabeth; Son, Jacobus, to have two years schooling, a son by my present wife, -- to have colt from the race mare; Son, Thunis, to have the race mare on condition that he help pay for (son ?) John's horse about £13; (Son?) John; Speaks of sons by my first wife; Leaves all estate to his five sons. Executors: Brother Abraham Thew and brother-in-law Johannes Blauvelt. Signed John Tu.¹
