The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Abraham Alsteyn, of New York, brick layer, being sick. I leave to my wife Maritie the use of all real and personal property while she remains my widow, "towards her comfortable subsistence and maintenance during her widowhood." I leave to my son Hermanus œ5 in full bar to all claims as eldest son. All the rest of my estate I leave to my children, Hermanus, Johanes, Abraham, Bridgit, wife of Thomas Warner, and Margaret, wife of Richard Harris. I make my sons Hermanus, Johanes, and Abraham, executors. Dated September 7, 1744. Witnesses, Thomas Hallock, Johanes Van Antwerpen, John Chambers. Proved, March 5, 1753. At that time Johanes Alsteyn was the surviving executor.

In a notarial record dated 24 May 1658 they are referred to as "Jan Martens ende desselfs huijsvrouw Dirckje Harmans Boertjens dochter van Meppel" [Jan Martens and his wife, Dirckje Harmans Boertjens from Meppel]

Jan Martense Van Alstyn was in New Amsterdam as early as 11 Dec 1646, when his name appears as a buyer, with Hendrick Jansen, on the bill of sale of a yacht from Thomas Hall and Jan Peterson. He probably was plying the Hudson from New Amsterdam to Beverwyck (Albany) because he began to buy land at the latter place within the decade after the bill of sale record. He also bought land in Ulster County, NY, and "behind" Kinderhook, NY. In 1657 he owned a lot in Albany lying on the east of Broadway, north of Columbia street. He owned this as late as 1693. He had a grant of two pieces of land in Ulster county. He lived there until his death about 1698. In 1695 he deeded his home farm to his son Abraham, who agreed to pay the other heirs certain sums of money.

He was an early inhabitant of Kinderhook, which means "Children's Point," so named for the Indian children who ran out on the point of land to observe Henry Hudon's ships.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Matthew Van Alstyne, of New York, merchant, being of sound mind. All debts to be paid in six weeks. My executors are to make an inventory. I leave to my wife Sarah the use of my dwelling house, in which I now live, and the lot, "during so long a time as she remains my widow," and the use of all the rest, to maintain herself and my children. I leave to my son Abraham £5, in lieu of his birthright. I having already advanced to him the sum of £500 or upwards. I leave to my executors £500 for the use of my son Matthew, when 21, if my executors shall judge him prudent and fit to manage his legacy, and if otherwise, my executors are to put it at interest for him. I leave to my daughters, Sarah, Helena, and Catharine, each £400, being the sum which I advanced to my daughter Mary when married. My executors shall sell all estate at vendue, if all agree. From the proceeds, I leave to my wife the use of £400. Of the remainder I leave 1/7 to my wife. To my daughter Mary the use of 1/7. To my son Abraham 1/7. To my daughters, Sarah, Helena, and Catharine, each 1/7, and to my son Matthew the use of 1/7. I leave my house and lot and the £400 left to my wife to my 5 children. I make my wife Sarah and my daughters, Sarah and Helena, executors. Whereas my son, Abraham is indebted to me with Jeronimus Remsen for various sums, his part is not to be paid till his debt is discharged, but if he pays all, then he is to be one of the executors. Dated September 3, 1767. Witnesses, Jeronemus Alstyne, John Wylley, John McKesson.
