The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Daniel Janse Van Antwerpen was a deputy schout fiscal at Fort Orange (now Albany) in 1656.²

Daniel Janse Van Antwerpen was in Beverwyck in 1661, when he agreed to serve Adriaan Appel, an inn keeper in Beverwyck (Albany), for one year, for 35 beavers (112 dollars), and free board, washing and lodging during said service.² Soon after Schenectady was settled, he became possessed of the Third flat on the south side of the Mohawk River, about 8 miles above Schenectady in the area called the Woestyne, or Wilderness, at that time far into Indian territory.²

In 1706 he sold the west half of his bouwery (63a., 79 rods) to his neighbor Jan Pieterse Mebie. His village lot was on the east side of Church Street, next north of the present church lot, and was 108 feet wide in front, and 206 feet deep, wood meas-

ure. In 1676 he was one of the five magistrates; in 1701 supervisor of the town.¹

In his will, he wrote: ...I Gerritt Van Antwerpen, of Schenectady, taylor, being sickly and weak, this July 24, 1753. I leave to my eldest son Daniel, my gun, being the fowling piece of my father, Daniel Van Antwerpen, deceased; Also the lot of ground left to me by my father in his will, for my birth right; "situate in Schenectady, on the south east end thereof over the bridge, and on the north side of the road that leads from said town to Albany," containing in front along said road 65 feet. I leave this to him for his primogeniture or birthright, and he is to make no further pretence as heir-at-law. I leave to my wife Catrina all the rest of my real estate during her widowhood, and she is to keep and bring up my children, "and to give them so much Learning as possibly she can." After her death I leave to my two daughters, Ariantie and Maria, my house and lot where I now live, bounded east by the street, north by Joshua Hall, west by Cornelius De Groot, and south by Geritt Say Veeder; And they are to pay to my daughter Antye, £40. I leave to my son Daniel all my pasture ground in Schenectady, about two miles east of the town, being 1/2 of the pasture land that I and Abraham Fonda bought of Hermanus Schuyler, son and heir of Nicholas Schuyler. "And whereas my present wife Catrina is with child and most ready to lye in," If the child be a son it shall have 1/2 of said land, but if it be a daughter, my son Daniel shall pay her œ40. I leave to my son Daniel my negro woman, and he is to pay œ5 to my children. All the rest I leave to my children. I make my father-in-law, Cornelius Brower, and my brother William and my brother-in-law, Robin Horseford, executors. Witnesses, James Lythall, John Freeman, John Sanders. Proved, October 25, 1753.

In his will, he wrote: ...February 23, 1757. I, Johanes Symon Van Antwrpen, of Schenectady, wagoner, "being at the present time weak in body." I leave to my only son, Symon van Antwerpen, "my Bigg Fowling Piece or Gun, wherewith he is to be fully and entirely satisfied of any pretence that he might make for being my only son and heir-at-law." I leave to my wife Catriena [corrected from Patience] during her widowhood all my real and personal estate, lands, and tenements, with all the reversions and remainders given to me by my father, Symon Danielse van Antwerpen [corrected from Symon Dirck van Antwerpen], by his will, as may more fully appear. And she is to keep and maintain my two children until of age. My wife and executors shall dispose of so much cattle and movables as they shall judge she has no occasion for, and the money to be used to pay debts. I make my wife and my brother, Lawres van Antwerpen [corrected from Leonard van Antwerpen], and my

brother-in-law, Albert Johannes Vedder, executors, with full power to sell. After the death of my wife I leave to my son Symon all the rest of the real estate which my father devised to me, with the house, barn, and barracks. And he shall pay to my daughter Engeltje £30. I also leave her my household stuff and furniture. Witnesses, John Sanders, Eldert Groot, Nicholas Groot. Proved in Albany, March 15, 1763.
