The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Dr. Beekman Van Beuren first practised medicine in NYC. At some time during the Revolution he moved to Bergen County and at the close of the war he bought a number of confiscated estates from the commissioners of forfeiture. In the deeds for these properties he is called Beekman Van Beuren of Hackensack, surgeon.

“Dr. Beekman Van Beuren and Elizabeth Vreeland [sic], his wife” wit. bp. 26 Dec 1798 at Schraalenburgh Ref Ch, of Beekman Van Beuren Van Saan, child of Isaac Van Saan and Catharina Van Beuren.

With his three wives he had 21 children!

On 2 May 1794, Jacob and Alltie Campbell, mariner, of Hackensack Precinct, conveyed to Doctor Beekman Van Beuren, yeoman, of the same place, for £125, 10 acres...line of Jacob Quackenbush and Abraham Brown. Signed Jacob Campbell, Alltie Campbell (her mark). Witnessed by Jacob Terhune, David Terhune.¹

On 6 May 1794, Jacob and Alleda Campbell, of Hackensack Precinct, conveyed to Doctor Beekman Van Beuren, yeoman, of the same place, for £130, 2 acres bounded by Joost Demarest. Signed Jacob Campbell. Witnessed by Archibald Wade.¹

On 16 June 1806 (recorded 19 June 1806, Bergen Co. Y:119) Beekman Van Bueren of the precinct of Hackensack, Physician, conveyed to John Christie of the same place, Blacksmith, for \$575., 10 acres near the Old Bridge in the precinct of Hackensack; said John Christie; Abraham Quackenbush; Jacob Quackenbush; conveyed by Jacob Campbell and Altia, his wife, to said Beekman Van Bueren. Signed by Beekman Van Bueren. Witnessed by Henry Van Dalsem, John Adam Boyd.

In his will, dated 7 March 1811, probated 4 June 1812, Beekman Van Beuren of the Township of Hackensack in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, mentioned sons John (deceased), William, Anglebert Cammena, Peter, Thomas, and Michael; and his daughters, Elizabeth, Mary, Caty, Castina, Margaret, Rachel, Highly, and Sarah. Cornelis Maesen (Maertz, Maertsz, Martsen, Maessen), from Buymalsen {Buurmalsen, in the province of Gelderland} sailed for New Netherland as a farm laborer in 1631 on the ship *d'Endracht*, having been engaged by the patroon on May 27th, for the term of three years, and went back to Holland shortly after 2 Aug 1634, on which date he is charged in the colony with f12:18 for clothes and brandy.

15 Aug 1636, he entered into a new contract with the patroon and the same year he sailed by the *Rensselaerswyck*, accom-

panied by his wife Catelijntje Martens and a servant by the name of Cornelis Teunisz, from Westbroeck. On the voyage, 30 Jan 1637, a son was born named Hendrick Cornelisz. Cornelis Maesen arrived in the colony the second time about 17 Apr 1637. From that time till his death, some time before 8 Apr 1648, he occupied a farm on or near Papscaene Island (Papsknee). Cornelis Maesen and his wife were buried the same day; their effects were sold at auction Shrove Tuesday, 1649.¹

Cornelis Theunisz Bos [aka Westbroeck] and Theunis Direxsx [Van Vechten] were guardians for the children, and trustees for the estate, as there were minor children.

On 12 Aug 1662, Hendrick Cornelisen Maessen and Marten Cornelisz Maessen, brothers, for themselves and for Maes Cornelisen Maessen, Syntie Cornelise Maessen and Tobias Cornelissen Maessen, their minor brothers and sister, all living in the Colony of Rensselaerswyck and children of the late Cornelis Maessen and Catalyntje Martense, who died in this country, and formerly lived at Bueren Malsen in Gelderland, executed a power of attorney to gerrit Cornelissen living at Tricht in Gelderland to receive an inheritance left by their uncle, Hendrick Maessen, who died at Cuij-Ontorch.²

John Dash Van Buren graduated from Columbia College in 1829 and then studied law in the office of Hugh Maxwell, and was admitted to the New York bar. He was a member of

the New York Assembly from Orange Co. in 1863, and in that year was appointed Paymaster-General of the New York State troops, with the rank of Colonel and held the office until 1865.¹
