The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

On 3 April 1800, Andries and Sarah Van Dien, yeoman, of Franklin Township, conveyed to David Au. Demarest, yeoman, of Harrington Township, for \$1650., 37 acres...corner Hendrick Van Voorhees, John Zabriskie, and Richard Cooper...and 6.48 acres...line of John Lozier and John Van Boskerk. Signed Andries Van Dien, Sarah Van Dien. Witnessed by John Van Wagener, Helmech Van Wagener.¹

On 4 May 1802 (recorded 14 Oct 1803, Bergen Co. R:57), Casparus Van dien and Mary, his wife, of Franklin Township, conveyed to Cornelius Van dien of same place, for \$235, 6-1/2 acres in Franklin Township, beginning at middle of Road, and bounded N by John Westervelt; S by Andrew Van Dien; W by middle of public Road; E by Abraham Westervelt. On 5 May 1802 (recorded 14 Oct 1803, Bergen Co. R:60), Andrew Van Dien of Franklin Township and Sara, his wife, conveyed to Cornelius Van Dien of same place, for \$226.50, 6-1/4 acres in Franklin Township, beginning by a stake on land of said Cornelius Van Dien. Bounded N & E by said Andrew Van Dien; S by Cornelius Van Dien; W by Peter Van Blarcom. Signed by Andrew Van Dien, Sarah Van Dien. Witnessed by Casparus Van Dien, John Davd. Haring.²

In his will, dated 19 Aug 1811, pr 16 Aug 1813, "Andries Van Diene, of Franklin Twsp., Bergen Co." mentions wife Sarah, daus., Mary (wife of Cornelius H. Zabriskie), Teuntje (wife of Peter P. Lutkins), Elizabeth (wife of Andrew J. Van Buskirk), Sarah (wife of Abraham H. Zabriskie), and Hester (wife of John I. Westervelt); and only son Dirrick. Executors were wife Sara and friends Richard Van Dien and Peter I. Terhune. Witnesses were Cornelius G. Vandien, John Van Norstrand, Abraham Westervelt.

An inventory of the estate (valued at \$1,410.18) was made 25 Aug 1813 by Albert Zabriskie and Albert G. Hopper.

Dirck Gerritsz Van Dien, a farmer from Tricht, County of Buren, arrived in New Amsterdam, two months before his marriage, on 4 Mar of 1660, on the ship *De Liefde* [The Love].

In the NYC Ref Ch marriage record, they are "Dirck Gerritszen Van Tricht, in't Graefschap Van Buuren, en Geertje Hendricks, Wede Van Andries Hoppe." In New Jersey he was known as Van Duyn; his children wrote the name **Van Dien**.

Geertje Hendricks was probably the sister of Belitje Hendricks, the first wife of Cornelis Aarsen (Van Schaick) and also the sister of Annatje Hendricks (native of Bergen, Norway), who m. Jan Aertsen Vanderbilt.

Dirck Gerretse obtained a patent from the Director-General of New Netherlands 14 Sep 1661 for a farm at Bergen, NJ; and on 12 May 1668 a patent from Philip Carteret, Governor of NJ, for the same premises.

12 May 1668. Philip Carteret sold to Dirck Garretse [Van Dien], three parcels of land lying in and about the Town of Bergen. Previous to his death, Dirck Gerritszen Van Dien sold land to Baltus Barentsen Van Kleek. Van Dien received the money, but before the transfer was completed he died, leaving a widow, Geertje Hendricks, and one son, Garret Van Dien. His widow, then living in Hackensack, carried out the sale on 13 October 1686. (History of Land Titles in Hudson County, NJ 1609-1871, by Charles H Winfield, p. 101)
