The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

They are probably also residents with their uncle in the 1738/1731 census of Flatlands, which listed 5 males and 3 females, all over the age of 10. They are all named as executors of his will, so they were significantly over the age of ten in 1731.

- **William [Van Gelder]**, b. about 1695; d. after 20 May 1762 unmarried. In his will, dated 20 May 1762, no probate date, William Van Gelder, of the township of Flatlands, in Kings County, on Nassau Island, being in good health. All debts to be paid. I leave to my brother, Evert Van Gelder, 6 shillings, current money of New York, for his right as heir at law, and then to be wholly cut off and debarred of all my real and personal estate. I leave to my sister, Susannah Van Gelder, £15, to be paid in six weeks. All the rest of my estate, houses and lands, I leave to my brother, Abraham Van Gelder, and make him executor. Witnesses, Jan Stryker, Pieter Lott, Michiel Strycker.³
- **Hendrick [Van Gelder]**, b. about 1698; m. before 1728, **Annetje Vandervoort**
- **Ann [Van Gelder]**, b. about 1700; d. after 1732. She witnessed baptisms in 1717 and 1722.
- **Abraham [Van Gelder]**, b. about 1702; d. before 24 April 1787 unmarried. the will of Abraham Van Gelder, of Flatlands, in Kings Co., NY was dated 7 Feb 1770; probated 24 April 1787.¹
- **Susannah [Van Gelder]**, b. about 1704; d. after 1761. She witnessed a baptism in 1725.
- **Isaac [Van Gelder]**, b. about 1706; m. -?-. He had a son named Hendrick. He appears frequently in the church records at Flatlands.

He is said to have settled about 1730 at Pompton, NJ.

Catalyna's will was dated 17 Aug 1784 Pompton Plains, NJ; proved 2 Oct 1784. In it she bequeaths her wearing apparel and furniture to her daughter-in-law, Mary Van Gelder; to her son, John, "all the real and personal estate which I have heired of my father, Paul Van Derbeeck, and a negro named "York"; but John must pay his brother, Abraham, £30.: The executors were son John and grandsons, Ewout Van Gelder and John DeVow, all of Pompton Plains, NJ. (NJA:33-410)³

In his will, dated 7 Feb 1770, probated 24 April 1787, Abraham Van Gelder, of Flatlands, in Kings County, yeoman, being sick. "Knowing that it behoveth every man to set his worldly estate in such order, if possible, before he departeth this life that no strife or debate may arise about the same, after his decease." I leave to my brother Isaac £40. To my cousin, Evert Van Noostrand, £35. To my cousin, Jacobus Ketteltas, £30. To Johanna, the daughter of my brother, Evert Van Gelder, deceased, now wife of Thomas Collins, £1, for her birthright. All legacies to be paid in six months. I leave to my cousin (nephew), Hendrick Van Gelder, son of my brother Isaac, my houses, lands, barns, and all my real estate. If my negro slave, Rachel, shall not like or choose to live with my cousin Hendrick, she may seek another master, and be sold to him. I make my neighbors, John Lott and Michael Stryker, and Johannes Lott, Jr., executors. Dated February 7, 1770. Witnesses Dirck Remsen, Hendrick Lott, Johannes Remsen. Proved April 24, 1787.¹

He inherited land at Arcola from his father, but he seems to have acquired another tract, containing a pond, in what became Ramsey, Bergen Co., NJ, where he built a stone house about 1745 (still standing in 2005).

On 27 June 1772, Jacob and Johanna Billue of Franklin Township, conveyed to Abraham Van Gelder of same place, for £185.5, 92.75 acres, corner to William Stagg. Signed Jacob Billue and Johanna Billue (her mark). Witnessed by James Christie, John Van Saen, and John Fell.¹

1 May 1790 -- This Indenture made this First Day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety, Between Johannes Laroe and Margaret his wife of the Precinct of Saddle River in the County of Bergen and in the State of New Jersey, of the one part, and Abraham Van Gelder of the Township of Franklin and in the County and State aforesaid, yeoman, of the other part. Whereas the said Johannes Laroe by his bond or obligation duly executed bearing even date with these Presents stands bound to the said Abraham Van Gelder his Executors Administrator and assigns in the Penal Sum of Forty Pounds in gold or Silver Coin or Paper Money at the Value thereof at the Currency of Eight Shillings per Dollar with a condition thereunder written for the Payment of the Sum of Twenty Pounds money as aforesaid with Lawful Interest for the

same on or before the first day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety One. As by the said Bond and Condition may more fully appear. And whereas John Van Voorhese late of the said Township of Franklin County of Bergen and State of New Jersey aforesaid Deceased Did in his lifetime in and by his last Will and Testament amongst other Devises and Bequests therein made, Devise and Bequeath unto his Son Adam Van Voorhese for and during the natural life time of the said Adam and After the death or decease of the said Adam, then to descend share and share alike unto the four daughters of the said Testator/ to wit / Helena the wife of Gerret Ackerman, Elizabeth the wife of Peter Post, Margaret the wife of the said Johannes Laroe and Rachel the wife of David Ackerman, and to their one every of their heirs and assigns for ever All that part of the Real Estate of the said Testator Commonly known and Called by the name of the Homestead Farm at Wykoff Containing One Hundred and Thirty Seven acres. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that they the said Johannes Laroe and Margaret his wife in Consideration of the said Debt or Sum of Twenty Pounds owing to the said Abraham Van Gelder as aforesaid and for the better Securing the Payment thereof to the said Abraham Van Gelder, his Executors Administrators and Assigns According to the Condition of the said Bond, and also in Consideration of the further Sum of Five Shillings to them the said Johannes Laroe and Margaret his wife in hand well and truly paid by the said Abraham Van Gelder at or before the sealing and Delivery of these Presents, the Receipt whereof they the said Johannes Laroe and Margaret his wife do hereby acknowledge Have Granted Bargained Sold Released and Confirmed and by these Presents Do Grant Bargain sell Release and Confirm unto the said Abraham Van Gelder and to his heirs and Assigns for ever All and Singular the Right Title Interest Property Possession Claim and Demand whatsoever either in law or Equity, which they the said Johannes Laroe and Margaret his wife now [have witness] or hereafter / to wit after the Decease of the said Adam Van Voorhese, may have or might or ought to have, in and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and Premises at Wykoff aforesaid and devised unto the said Adam as Aforesd. Together with all and Singular the Hereditments and Appurtenances. To Have and to Hold, unto him the said Abraham Van Gelder his heirs and assigns To the only Proper use benefit and behalf of him the said Abraham Van Gelder and to his heirs and assigns for ever. And the said Johannes Laroe and Margaret his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and Administrators and for every one of them the above Granted and Bargained Premises and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Abraham Van Gelder his heirs and assigns against the Just and lawful claim and Demand of all Persons shall and will warrant and for ever Defend, Provided Always Nevertheless and it is the true Intent and meaning of these Presents that if the said Johannes Laroe his heirs Exs. or Admrs. do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Abraham Van Gelder his heirs Exrs, or Admrs. the said full Sum of Twenty Pounds with lawful Interest for the same money aforesaid on or before the first Day of May next Ensuing the date hereof according to the Condition of the above in part Recited Bond or Obligation with out any Deduction or Abatement whatsoever then and from thenceforth these Presents and every matter and thing therein Contained shall Cease and be utterly null and Void anything herein Contained to the Contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding. In Witness Whereof the parties of the first part to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written. Sealed and delivered in the Presence of --- [blank]. Johannes Laroe & Margaret his wife, to Abraham Van Gelder, Mortgage [Deed?].⁴

On 1 May 1805 (recorded 24 October 1805, Bergen Co. W:7) Henry Tice of the Township of Franklin, and May, his wife, conveyed to Thomas J. Banta of the same place, for \$386.25, 30-90/100 acres in the Township of Franklin, beginning NE corner of Cornelius Pules of W bounds of land of Abraham Van Gelder. Bounded E by land of said Abraham Van Gelder; N by John Springsteen; W by Jacob Young; and S by Jacob Young and Cornelius Pules. Signed by Henry D. Tice (his mark), Mary D. Tice (her mark). Witnessed by Jacob Young, David Van Gelder.⁵

Abraham Van Gelder's Will was dated 10 July 1790, proved 20 January 1807. In it he specified that his eldest son Jonathan shall "live and dwell on that farm of mine on which he now dwells." The bequest allowed Jonathan the use of the farm to "plant and sow thereon and reap the produce thereof as long as they please and no longer." Afterwards the land was to be equally divided between sons Jacobus and Hendrick." The second son, Jacobus, received the message, tenement and 92-acre lot "on which he now lives" that Abraham had bought of Jacob Billue [1772]. Hendrick, the youngest son, was devised the homestead farm "on which I now dwell which I bought of John Hamilton containing sixty-three acres. [This was likely Abraham's second purchase from the Proprietors in 1745.] Hendrick also inherited his father's weaving loom and accessories. Hendrick and brother Jacobus were ordered to comfortably maintain their mother, Rachel, and the two brothers were also named as executors of the will.²

Abraham B. Van Gelder's will was probated 6 March 1876, and in it he devised "unto my sister Pernelpe commonly called Baletie, to her alone...all my lands given and devised to me by my father's last will and testament." He also willed to Pernelpe, all his possessions, but stipulated that she was to provide \$200 to her sister Ann, widow of John P. Goetschius.¹

On 18 April 1884, Pernelpe Van Gelder sold the homestead farm to her nephew, James R. Goetschius, for \$1500. By 1889, the aging Pernelpe, then a resident of the City of Passaic, transferred the remainder of her real estate inherited from her father David, to Andrew Swartz, also of that City. The consideration was \$1 and "other good and lawful considerations, to wit, her support and maintenance."²

David built the house at 37 West Crescent Avenue, Ramsey, Bergen Co., NJ, on land originally purchased twice (about 1737, and 1745) to insure valid title, by David's grandfather, Abraham.

David, son of Hendrick, was appointed, in 1807, one of the executors of his grandfather, Abraham's, will (because Jacobus and Hendrick, the sons and executors named in the will, had predeceased their father).

In his will, dated 23 Feb 1844 (probated 22 May 1845), David Van Gelder mentioned wife Polly, "to have all my real estate during her widowhood, also one cow and all my household furniture during her natural life." After her decease, son Abraham was to become heir to the homestead farm of 31-1/2 acres, and also 8-1/2 acres of woodland out of the 75-acre farm near the sawmill. David authorized his executors to sell his share in the sawmill to pay debts. The remainder of the 75-acre farm was to be divided between his daughters, Pernelphe who was unmarried, and Anna, the wife of John P. Goetschius. Son John received no bequest, although he was named, along with brother Abraham, as executor of the will.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Collin Van Gelder, of New York, gunsmith, being sick. I leave to my son Walter 20 shillings in bar to all claim as heir at law, "my executors are to sell all my personal estate for the most money and the greatest Price that can be got for the same," and the money put at interest until my youngest child is of age, and then divided among them all, viz., Catharine, wife of William G. Forbes, Elizabeth, wife of George Horser, Walter, Jannettie, and Johanes. My executors, with the consent of my brother, Gerritt Van Gelder, may sell the following messuages in New York: "One lot known by the name of Sarah Kierstedes Garden, opposite to the burying ground of Trinity Church." And one dwelling house and lot in the Broadway, wherein my brother Gerritt now dwelleth, between the estate of Mary Elliston and Elizabeth Slydell. "And one dwelling house and lot on Garden street, opposite the burying ground of the old Dutch Church." The money is to be put at interest for my children. I leave all the rest to my said five children. My children who are under age are to be supported out of my estate. I make my daughter Catharine and Zachariah Sickles, and my brother Gerritt, executors. Dated March 21, 1775. Witnesses, Rudolphus Ritzema, Solomon Freligh, Jacob Van Wagenen. Proved, May 5, 1775. [NOTE.--The lot known as "Sarah Kierstedes Garden" (which may indicate its ancient ownership) is now No. 96 Broadway. The house and lot on Broadway between the lots of Elizabeth Slydell and Mary Elliston is now No. 65 Broadway. The lot of Slydell, No. 63, and the Elliston lot (No. 67), formerly owned by Benjamin Payne, together with the Van Gelder lot, were all purchased by Peter Harmony. The lot on "Garden street" is on the south side of Exchange Place, about halfway between Broad and William streets.--W. S. P.]

Garret Van Gelder and wife, Anna Pulis, were members of the Wyckoff Ref Ch. A note in the membership records say, for both of them, "Left."

Garret Van Gelder, 45, farmer, and Ann, 45, his wife, were listed in the 1860 Federal Census, living in Hohokus Township, Bergen County, NJ. Listed living with them were: Abm., 22, farmer; Eliza, 18, his wife; Garret, 1; and Henry, 17, farmer.

Whereas my deceased son, Teunis Van Gelder, was at the time of his death indebted to me, a considerable sum of money, upon ballancing accounts, as would amount to more than his share of my estate. Hendrick, the youngest son of Abraham and Rachel (Laroe) Van Gelder, was devised in his father's will dated 10 July 1790, the homestead farm "on which I now dwell which I bought of John Hamilton containing sixty-three acres. [This was likely Abraham's second purchase from the Proprietors in 1745.] Hendrick also inherited his father's weaving loom and accessories. Hendrick and brother Jacobus were ordered to comfortably maintain their mother, Rachel, and the two brothers were also named as executors of the will.¹

In 1784, Hendrick was sharing the tax burden of his father's real estate, being assessed for 100 acres and by 1795 he was listed for 150 acres as well as five horses and 11 cattle.

On 11 April 1806 (recorded 14 May 1806, Bergen Co. Y:22) Thomas S. Banta of the Township of Franklin, yeoman, and Margaret, his wife, conveyed to William P. Ramsey of the Township of Franklin, for \$150, 10 acres in the Township of Franklin in the Ramapough tract, beginning at lot of John Springsteen; Van Gelder's land; Jacob Young; land of Peter P. Ramsey; heirs of Henry Van Gelder, deceased. Signed by Thomas S. Banta, Margaret Banta. Witnessed by William Tracy, Peter Ramsey.⁴

From 1827 to 1835 he bought parts of his grandfather's farm near New Durham, where he spent his entire life.

Mark Dewsnap, 48, farmer, and Phoebe Dewsnap, 40, were listed in the 1870 Federal Census, living in Washington Township (Saddle River P.O.). Living with them were Jesse Van Gelder, 68 (b. NJ); and Amelia House, 15 (b. NJ).

In his will, dated 6 Dec 1867, probated 31 May 1875, Jesse Van Gelder, of the Township of North Bergen, NJ, directed that his real and personal property be sold and daughter, Phoebe Ann, to have \$100; daughter Mary Jane, \$1000, and son John \$1000. The balance of the estate was to be held in trust and the income to be divided equally between son, John, and daughter, Mary Jane, for life and then distributed to their heirs. Executors were his brother, Henry Van Gelder, and son-in-law, James Dewsnap. James Van Gelder, 130 Peony St, NYC, and Isaac Romaine of Academy St., Bergen, NJ were witnesses.²

Johannes Van Gelder was a carpenter and wood turner.

Neeltje's father wrote, in his will: July 10, 1732. I, Garrit Onckelbag, of New York, distiller, being in health of body. My debts are to be paid. The rest of my estate, real and personal, I leave to my daughters, Nelly, wife of John Van Gelder, and Rebecca, wife of Burgher Sipkins, and to their heirs and assigns, and I make them and their husbands executors. Witnesses, John Tilton, Walter Hyer, Hendricus Brevoort. Proved, May 21, 1733. At that time Burgher Sipkins was dead. His widow Rebecca was confirmed as one of the executors.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, John Van Gelder, of New York, Gentleman, being weak in body. I leave to my wife Nelyte the use of all my movable estate so long as she remains my widow. I leave to my eldest son, Gelian (Gulian) Van Gelder, 20 shillings. If my wife marries, my movable estate is to be divided into three shares. In case my wife should sell any part, she shall be obliged to make good the same, according to an inventory which must be made in six weeks. I leave to my wife a silver Teapot. I leave to my eldest son, Gelian, "a silver Tankard which was my father's." I leave to my youngest son, Gerritt, "another silver Tankard, which was his grandfather, Onkelbo's"; Also my vise and hand saw and all my tools. And the rest of my personal estate I leave to my wife and two sons. I leave to my wife the use of real estate, but with no power to sell. After her death I leave all my real estate to my two sons, Gelian and Gerritt. I make my wife and sons, executors. Dated February 18, 1756. Witnesses, Josiah Bagley, John Slidell, Tallow chandler, Frederick De Voe, Tallow chandler. Proved, January 22, 1776. [NOTE.--The "grandfather Onkelbo" was Gerritt Onckelbog, whose daughter married John Van Gelder. He lived on the south side of "Garden Street," now Exchange Place, a little west of William Street.--W. S. P.]

In his will, he wrote: October 28, 1732. Whereas, William Van Gelder, of Flatlands, in Kings County, "being deaf and dumb, yet of perfect mind and memory as appeared by his utterances through means of three interpreters, which are his neighbors, viz., Peter Monfoort, Johannes Sluycher, and Stephen Schenck, expressed himself as follows: That he was sensible that it was appointed for all men to dye, and as he was arrived to a great age, he expected that his Time could not be long in this worlde." He leaves all his lands and estate in Flatlands to his "cousins" (nephews and nieces), my brother's children, viz., William, Abraham, Isaac, Sarah, Anne, and Susanah Van Gelder, with whom I now live, as they have taken special care of me. "I leave to my cousin (nephew), William Van Gelder, because he is named after me, all my silver buttons as is upon my coat." And I make the above named "cousins" executors. Witnesses, Peter Monfoort, John Strycker, Stephen Schenck, Jan Monfoort, S. Gerritsen. Proved, February 28, 1738.

I leave to my sister, Susannah Van Gelder, £15, to be paid in six weeks. All the rest of my estate, houses and lands, I leave to my brother, Abraham Van Gelder, and make him executor. Witnesses, Jan Stryker, Pieter Lott, Michiel Strycker. (No Probate.)
