The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

It is believed that Cornellis Jansen van Ceulen/Coelen (brother of Mathijs Jansen Van Ceulen), of Achtercol, and Cornellis Jansen van Coelen of the St Beninjo were the same person. Mathijs and brother Cornellis arrived in New Amsterdam together in June, 1639 aboard the *West Indische Raven* from Recife, but neither stayed. Mathijs returned to Brazil by October, 1639, and Cornellis was recorded in Amsterdam in 1641. As to the spelling "Coelen", it is another alternate spelling of "Cologne". Ceulen, Keulen, Koln, Koeln, Colen, and Coelen all refer to the city of Cologne. The spelling is a record keepers whim, and does not necessarily reflect the preference of the individual in question. It is generally more reflective of "where" the recordkeeper was educated. As to individual preference....the brothers always used "van Ceulen". I know this, because I have 22 letters written by Mathijs van Ceulen (I have posted several of them at the family website), and numerous other company communications referring to them, including the complete set of Directors minutes (Notulenboecks) for the "Amsterdam Camer, West Indische Compagnie", 1634-1636. The Notulenboeck entry for Dec 24, 1636 notes the Departure of "deHeer van Ceulen" for Recife 4 days earlier. Each of the letters is signed "M van Ceulen". In unofficial records, Mathijs was often known by the patronymic short name of "Tijs Jansen."⁵

Cornelis Jansen Coele witnessed the purchase in 1648 (?) by Arent Corssen [Stam], of land on the Schuykill in PA from the Indians. Witnesses to this transaction were: Augustin Heermans, Goovert Loockermans, Juriaen Planck, Cornelis Jansen Coele, and Sander Leendertsen.³

Cornelis Jansen Coely, along with Albert Janszen, Lysbeth Thysens, and Belitje Cornelis, witnessed the baptism 20 April 1653 NYC Ref Ch of Aert, son of Jan Aertszen [Vanderbilt] & Annetje Hendricks.

Cornelis Jansen, the Zealander was mentioned in court 5 May 1653 -- Roelof Jansen Vonck, pltf., v/s Cornelis Jansen Coele, deft/, demands pay for 49 days carpenters work on defts bark at 4 fl. a day and 12 fl. besides, earned on the galleon. Deft. says, he does not recognize pltf. in this case, as he has not employed him, but Cornelis Jansen, the Zealander, for whom pltf. has worked as hired man, showing at the same time by affidavit, that said Zealander had offered to undertake the yacht for 350 fl., and by his books, that he had already paid 427 fl. He requests therefore, that the attachment against himself and yacht be lifted or else he shall claim damages with interest. The court decides, that Cornelis Jansen Coele shall give security for the judgment, when the attachment will be lifted.⁶

25 Oct 1655 -- Sieur Joost van Beeck, pltf. v/s Corns. Jansen Coele, deft. Pltf demands that deft. be condemned to pay him the balance due on a certain bottomry land, being between 5 and 6 hundred guilders, but cannot speak for certain, as the books of his decd. brother, in which the receipts are, have not yet been opened. Deft. acknowledges to owe about so much, and is willing to pay, but requests delay, as he offered payment to the pltf's brother, which was not accepted. Pltf. replying, asks judgment and sufficient bail. Parties being heard, the Court condemns the deft. Corns. Jansen Coele, as they hereby do, to pay pltf. witjin 14 days the balance of his remaining money and give sufficient bail for the payment hereof, before his departure for Virginia.¹

18 Nov 1655 -- Sieur Joost van Beeck, pltf. v/s Mr. Roger Gillebert, deft/ Pltf prosecutes the arrest issued against the bark the *Flying Deer*, arrived in this port and employed by deft., on account and for the payment of fl. 485. 6. which is due to him the pltf. for and on account of a bottomry bond etc. from Cornelis Jansen Coele, who navigated the aforesaid bark, and having sold the same has not yet paid the above. Requesting, that the arrest on the said bark shall be declared valid, until he receive satisfaction for his afopresaid protocol, as the bark is held therefor. Deft shews by receipt and conveyance, written in English and protocolled and sealed before a Notary in Virginia on the 27th of April and the 17th Octr. last, that he purchased and paid 75 pounds sterling, for the aforesaid bark, the *Flying Deer*, to Jan Whitty in Virginia. Requesting, consequently that the arrest be declared invalid. Pltf demands copy of the aforesaid acquittance and conveyance, mantains that the same is insuf-

ficient, inasmuch as the bark was mortgaged here, whereof the writing is not now present, The Court grants pltf copy, to answer thereto by the next Court day, and orders that he present his proofs then. Meanwhile the arrest on the aforesaid bark was declared valid until the matter be disposed of.¹

22 Nov 1655 -- Joost van Beeck, pltf v.s Mr. Gillebert, deft. Pltf in default [meaning he didn't appear in court]. Deft demands costs, damages and interest, as he lies here, ready to sail, at great expense. The Court decree only default, and allows the deft. to institute any action he may think he has by the next Court day.¹

22 Nov 1655 -- Jacob van Couwenhoven, pltf/ v/s Mr. Gillebert, deft. In case of arrest. Whereas Cornelis Jansen Coele sold to Daniel Barwick, merchant in Virginia, by contract dated 13 August 1654 his certain brak called the *Flying Deer*, whereupon is still due 7800 lbs tobacco, payable in two months after date of the said contract, for which the said Barwick still remains in default notwithstanding he has been divers times applied to in Virginia by attorney therefor; and as the said bark, now lying in port in this city, is specially held for the fulfillment of the same, so he Jacob van Couwenhoven, as attorney for sforesaid Cornelis Jansen Coele, requests that the arrest on said bark be declared good for the payment of the aforesaid remaining merchandize with interest thereon, free of costs and damage. Deft persists in his answer given in the case of Joost van Beeck, that he bought and paid for the bark. The Court having seen the demand and obligation, declared the arrest on the bark valid and ordered that deft. be granted copy of the papers in the suit to answer thereto in writing by the next Court day.¹

21 Feb 1656 -- Joost van Beeck appeared in Court, exhibiting judgment against Cornelis Jansen Coele and requests, as he has thereupon arrested Cornelis Jansen, on his departure, that he be authorized to put the said J. C. Coele in prison, giving security for costs. Endorsement:--At the request of Joost van Beeck made to the Court relative to the execution of the aforesaid sentence, the Court decided, that said judgment shall have its full effect, and acciordingly consented, on request of pltf., that he imprison the aforesaid Cornelis Jansen Coele, on security the costs.²

27 April 1660 -- Hands Dreper, pltf v/s Cornelis Janzen Coele, deft. Defts 2d default [he didn;t appear in Court]. Pltf demands from deft. twenty seven guilders two stivers for consumed board. The Court order the deft. to deposit the money with the Secretary of this State within thew times four and twenty hours.⁴

In his will, he wrote: May 27, 1742. I, Dirck Van Keuren, of Kingston, in Ulster County, being infirm in body. I leave to my wife Maritie the use of all estate during her life. I leave to my son Matthew, the land he now lives upon, "and the mill lying and being in Duches County, on the north side of a run of water named Specken Kill," and he is to pay £300 to my other children, deducting 1/12. I leave to my son Benjamin, and my daughter Sarah, wife of William Van Vliet, all the land I bought of Thomas Saunders, in Duches County, on the south side of my son Matthew's land, as they have it now in possession; and they are to pay £300, deducting 1/12. I leave to my sons Abraham and Jacobus, my dwelling house, barn, barracks, and smith shop, and the ground thereto belonging, in Kingston; Also the land I bought of my father, and Hendrick Ten Eyck, and the orchards lying on both sides of the King's highway that leads to Hurley Town. I also leave to them a bond due to me from Jacob Rutsen, also one from William Harris, and they are to pay £400, deducting each 1/12. All of my children who as yet have had no out set from me, shall have it equal in value to those which have already had it. I leave to my daughters, Janeke, wife of Dirck Westbrook; Katie, wife of Joseph Du Bois; Catharine, wife of Arnold Vielen; Maritie, wife of Petrus Louw; Rachel, wife of Dirck Van Vliet; Elizabeth, and Lydia, the sums of money which are to be paid by my sons as above. All the rest of my estate I leave to all my children, and I make my wife and my sons, executors. Witnesses, Dirck De Witt, Adam Persons, Cornelius Persons. Proved, September 22, 1742.

Mathijs Jansz, was on the South American Colonies Governing Council from 1636-1641, based in Recife, Brazil.

Matthys Jansen was a trader on the Hudson. Matys Jansz received a grant from Director Kieft of 50 morgen of land in or near what became Harlem, NY, patented 18 Aug 1646 (he probably never occupied this land, living at the time of the patent in Fort Orange). He lived at Fort Orange and later, at Esopus.

He was the progenitor of two Ulster Co. families: Jansen and Van Keuran (corrupted from Van Keulen). Matthys himself seems never to have used the "Van Keulen" surname, but is found in the records using variants of "Matthys Jansen, Matys Jansz, etc.). The Van Keuren surname appears in the Kingston Ref Ch records for the first time in 1716 at the baptism of Marytjn (dau. of Mathys Van Keure & Tryntje Slegt).

Page 834, "Journals of Killaen van Rennselaer", lists the death of his former partner, Mathijs, as between 13 Oct and 16 Oct, 1648. The manifest of the West Indies Raven, July, 1639, places Mathijs in New Amsterdam in 1639. He was also recorded later in 1639 present at the land owned by brother Conraet Jansen van Keulen in North Harlem. It is unknown exactly when he came to America, or when he first traveled to Fort Orange, but he was married with 1 child in the winter of 1640, at Fort Orange. Youngest son Matthys, named in honor of his father, was born in 1648 just after the death of his father. Brother Jan Matthyssen was age 20 on June 25th, 1666, when he petitioned the courts for a waiver to allow him to take possession of his patrimonial estate from his guardian, Roloef Swartwout. His reason for the waiver was that he was betrothed and would need the land to support his future wife and family. It was noted that sister Annetje was already "of age", but was still under the guidance of Guardian Roloef, as she was yet unmarried. Annetje would have been born 1634 or early 1645. All 4 children of Mathijs van Keulen and Margrietje Hendrickse were born at Fort Orange, and are recorded in the van Rennsalaer Journals. Catryn was born @ 1640, being age 20 when she married Jan Jansen van Amersfoort in Oct, 1660.¹
