The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Andrias Van Lewen, of Marblatown, in Ulster County, yeoman, being well in body. My wife Mar-

garet is to remain in full possession of all my estate, real and personal, so long as she shall remain my widow. I leave to my eldest son, Johanes, "the choice of my guns, over and above his share." I leave to my four sons, Johanes, Christopher, Elias, and Eleza (Eleasar) all my real estate; and they are to pay to my daughter Meribah £20, to be paid six weeks after my wife's decease. I make my wife Margaret and my brother, Guisbert Van Lewen, and my brother-in-law, Petrus Van Lewen, executors. Witnesses, John Van Lewen, Ephraim Chambers, Thomas Schoonmaker, Jr. Proved, August 25, 1770. Confirmed, December 7, 1770. The widow Margaret was then Margaret Beattys.

In the Flatbush Ref Ch record of their marriage and banns, they were: Frederijk Hendriksz van Leeuwen, young man from Utrecht, in the Netherlands, with Dina Jans, young lady from N. York; both at Jamaica.

They lived in Jamaica, Queens Co., NY. He purchased property in Middlesex and Somerset Counties, NJ, 17 Nov 1701.

In his will, he wrote: November 19, 1712. I, Frederick Hendricksen Van Leaw, of Jamaica, in Queens County, Gentleman, being weak in body. I leave the use of all my estate, real and personal, to my wife Dinah, which is not already given to my sons by deed of sale, also £150, and she is to have an equal proportion with my daughters in all my estate, to be at her disposal, "but among my children." And she shall pay to my daughters, Greta, Dinah, Elizabeth, and Analche, when they are married, or of age, equal to what my daughter Mary Probasco hath received. After my wife's decease my house and lands and meadows and rights are to be sold at vendue among my children. If my wife should die before my youngest daughter is capable of earning her own living, "something is to be allowed for her bringing up." If either of my sons, John, Henry, and Frederick, should die without issue, the rest shall inherit his share. As I have given to my son Frederick by deed, land in the Jerseys I leave him, £5, "and when he shall come of age to work upon his land in ye Jerseys, my son Henry is to allow him a year's board if he is single." My estate in Holland, if ever it be obtained, is to be divided among my children. Witnesses, Rem Dorland, Hannah Dean, Benjamin Woolsey. Proved, June 6, 1726.

In her will, she wrote: I, Dinah Hendricksen Van Leow, of Jamaica, in Queens County, widow of Fredrick Hendricksen Van Leow. I leave all my estate to my children, Johanes, Mary, wife of Jacob Probasco, of New York, Henry, Geritie, wife of John Striker, of New York, Dinah, wife of Volkert Dircksen, Fematie, Elizabeth, wife of Evert Van Wicklen, and Altie, wife of John Dorland. And whereas by the will of my husband, dated November 19, 1712, my daughter Altie, wife of John Dorland, may have some difficulty in having her share, as she has no children, my other children are to secure her 1/6 of the estate. My two old negroes are to choose which of my children they will live with. I make my son Hendrick and my sons-in-law John Dorland and John Striker, executors. Dated June 4, 1736. Witnesses, Abraham Lott, Benjamin Hinchman, Isaac Lott. Proved, December 30, 1740

In his will, he wrote: I, Frederick Van Leaw, of Jamaica, in Queens County, yeoman, being now sick. My executors are to pay all lawfull debts and funeral charges, and to sell movable estate for that purpose. I leave to my wife Mary my silver tankard and five large silver spoons, and six tea spoons, and my best bed and furniture, and the use of my dwelling house and lands and the rest of my movable estate so long as she continues my widow, for the support and maintainance of my children.
