The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvment of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In his will, he wrote: ...June 12, 1745, I, Aaron Van Nostrant, of the town of Hempstead, joiner, being aged and infirm. I leave to my wife Gertruy, £20, and the use of all my housing, barns, orchards, and lands during her widowhood, but she shall not commit any waste of timber, etc. I leave all my personal estate to my children and grand children, viz., Jacob Albert, John, Aaron, Moses, William, Isaac, Everitt, ~~Daniel~~ [corrected to David], Anne, ~~Litche~~ [corrected to Alche], Gertruy, Mary, Elizabeth, and Yanaca, and my grand children, the children of my daughter, Jane Alburdis, deceased, and to the children of my daughter, Heliche Hendricksen, deceased. My executors are to sell all real estate after the death of my wife, and divide the money among my children and grand children. I make my son Jacob and my brother in law, Evert Van Gelder, and my friend, John Hegerman, of Flushing, executors. Witnesses, Willinde Hendricksen, Michael De Mott, Richard Everitt. Proved, July

I leave to my cousin, Anthony Van Noostrand, "all that he oweth to me, for my living with him and taking care of me." Also all my carpenter and turning tools. I leave to the two daughters of my brother, Albert Van Noostrand, deceased, viz., Altie Golder and Elsie Smith, each £10. "My will is that the above legacies be not sodenly paid, but as soon as the money can conveniently be collected." I leave all the remainder to my cousin, Anthony Van Noostrand. I make my brother William and my kinsman, Anthony Van Noostrand, and John Hendrickson, executors. Witnesses, Lettice Hedges, Isaac Remsen, Abraham Van Wyck. Proved, November 6, 1770.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Aaron Van Nostrand, of Jamaica, in Queens County, "being ill and in great pain of body." I leave to my son Isaac £10, and £10 to my granddaughter Ann. I leave to my son Aaron all the tools of the Turners' trade and all my carpenter tools. I leave to my 2 youngest daughters Janettie and Antie one dozen cherry wood chairs. To my daughters Aultie, Gretie, Sarah, Janettie, and Antie, each a linnen wheel and all my linnen and woolen yarn. My flax is to be divided into 7 parts. My son Aaron is to have 2 parts and the rest to my son Isaac. All my beef, pork, and other family provisions I leave to my son Isaac and my 5 daughters. In his will, he wrote: ...I, Albert Van Nostrant, of New York, in the Montgomerie Ward. I leave to my son George £25, also my silver Tankard, and 9 silver table spoons, and my large Bible. "Whereas I myself and my beloved wife Eve have agreed and promised each other that after my decease my children should have all my movable goods that I possessed before my marriage with my said wife, and I also promised my said wife that she should take all the goods that are in being at my decease that she brought with her into my family, the chief of which are a negro wench, and a chest of drawers, a looking-glass, and chairs and other furniture, my executors are to allow them to her." I leave to my daughter Mary a bed, with all its furniture, a cupboard and linnen, and a small looking-glass, "all of which were her mother's." I leave to my two children George and Mary all the rest of my movable estate. I leave to my wife Eve 1/3 of all my lands and houses in New York or elsewhere during her life, and the other 2/3 to my children. My executors may sell all my lands and houses in New York "at auction." I make my brother, Garrett Van Nostrant, and my friends, Jacob Duryee and Isaac Nicoll, executors. Dated February 28, 1764. Witnesses, Richard Fletcher, school master, Adrian Bogert, baker, Isaac Johnson, house carpenter. Proved, May 14, 1766.

Witnesses, Hendrick Abramse, Jacob Strycher, Roel-off Martins, Clerke. Proved April 1, 1690.

Whereas Peter Hansen died on a voyage to Barbadoes, and left a will but no executors, Letters of administration are granted to his brother Geritt Hansen, June 26, 1692. [Will of?] Peter Hansen. Written in Dutch. Dated November, 1691. Makes his brother Geritt Hansen, and his son Peter Geritts his sole heirs. Letters of administration on estate of Peter Hansen granted to Geritt Hansen eldest son by the late wife of John Johnson, June 17, 1692.

Hans Janszen Van Noorstrand had two living sons named Jan.

Remsen, the infant children of Jacob Remsen late of the said town of Flatlands Yeoman deceased and committed the said Bonds or Obligations into the custody of Rem Lefferts of Bedford in the town of Brooklyn in the said County of Kings Yeoman, and the Guardian of the said Infant Children for and during their minority; - And Whereas the said Cornelia L. Nostrand one of the said infant children of the said Jacob Remsen deceased has attained the age of twenty-one years; and the said Rem Lefferts the Guardian as aforesaid hath now made up an account with the said Stephen L. Nostrand and Cornelia L. Nostrand his wife, of the said Bonds or Obligations and of all monies received and paid by the said Rem Lefferts in pursuance of the said Guardianship and upon the adjustments of such account the sum of Six hundred and fifty eight dollars and twenty cents is due to the said Cornelia L. Nostrand as her full share and proportion which said sum is now paid over by the said Rem Lefferts to the said Stephen L. Nostrand and Cornelia L. Nostrand his wife.
