The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In his will, he wrote: ...December 10, 1751, I, Johannes Van Slick, of Schenectady, farmer, being sick in body. My brother, Harme Van Slick, is to pay all debts and funeral charges. I leave to my brother Harme all my farm lying in Schenectady "about four miles from said town up the Mohawk river, on the south side of said river," between two creeks, one called Stene Kill (stony brook) and the other the Platte Kill (broad brook) and containing 20 morgens of arable or low land, and 20 morgens more of upland on the west side of the Platte Kill, and also all my plows, harrows, and horses. I leave to my brother Cornelius 4 morgens of land on the south side of the land I have given to my brother Harme, "also my pleasure sled with all tackling." I leave to Cornelius Van Slick, Jr., son of my brother Abraham, deceased, 4 morgens of land on the south side of the land given to my brother Cornelius. I leave to my cousin (niece) Clara Van Slick, daughter of my brother Hendrick, deceased, one bed and furniture. I leave to Margaret Van Slick, daughter of my brother Harme, and to Gertruy, daughter of my brother Cornelius, and to Elizabeth Visger, daughter of Johannes Visger, Esq., all the rest of my movables and household stuff, except as here given. I give to my brother Cornelius, and to Cornelius Petrus Van Slick, son of my brother Petrus, all the rest of my cattle and a negro man, and all my money, gold and silver; Also a certain sum of money which my father-in-law, Harme Van Slick, made over to his daughter Lena, my wife, deceased, by his will. I leave to Elizabeth, daughter of my brother Harme, one cow. To my niece Clara, daughter of my brother Hendrick, £30. To my niece Margaret, daughter of my brother Albert, £50. To Cornelius Antone Van Slick, son of my brother Anthony, a negro woman and a silver cup. I make my brothers, Harme and Cornelius, executors. Witnesses, Joseph Yates, Art Van Antwerpen, Johannes Peek, Jr. Proved, February 19, 1752.

To my two daughters Josentie, wife of Richard Bidder, and Elizabeth, wife of Thomas Wendover, all my household stuff and wearing apparell. Of all the rest of my estate I leave 1/2 to my daughter, Josentie Bidder, for life, and then to her two children, Anna Collister and Dorothy Bidder, widow of Richard Bidder, Jr. The other 1/2 to my daughter, Elizabeth Wendover, and I make my two daughters executors. February 1, 1763. Witnesses, David Johnson, Augustus Van Cortlandt, Bartholomew Le Roux. Proved, March 9, 1763.

Pieter Willems Slyk, with Hendrickje Lucasz, witnessed the baptism 27 April 1690 Albany Ref Ch, of Marietje, dau. of Dirk Willemsz. (No mother's name in bp. record).

In his will dated 24 March 1735, probated 16 Jan 1742, Peter Van Slyck, of Kinderhook, Albany Co., NY, mentioned his wife and his sons, Theunis, Dirck and Peter; his daughter Elizabeth, wife of Arie Gardener; his daughter Catharina, wife of Moses Ingersole; his daughter Anna, wife of John Jacob Eal [Ehle]. (FW #1802)

Another abstract of his will -- In his will, he wrote: ...March 25, 1735. I, Peter Van Slyke, of Keyserick, in Albany County, being in health. If my wife survives me she shall dispose of all that remains of my estate according to her pleasure. I leave to my son Theunis, 1 good cow in his right of primogeniture. I leave to Barentie Barhuyt, "for that she hath served me," £10. To my son Dirck, 2 negroes. I leave all the rest of my estate to my seven children, Thomas, Peter, Dirck, Elizabeth, wife of Arie Gardiner, Catharine, wife of Moses Ingersoll, Anna, wife of John Jacob ~~Ral~~ ["Ral" corrected to "Eal" in Volume XVI Corrections Vol I, The New York Historical Society, 1907, page 140], and Barentie. I make my sons executors. Witnesses, A. Van Dyke, Lambert Hyck, Joshua Hyck. Proved, January 16, 1741/2.
