The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

"Adriaen Gerritszen, farmer, from Utrecht, wife and five children, 13, 12, 11, 8, and 7 years old. sailed on *De Trouw* in 1662 with their five children: "De Trouw" sailed from Amsterdam on 24 March 1662.

The three older children all named a daughter Cornelia, which has led to the speculation that Adriaen Gerritszen may have had a first wife named Cornelia, who may have been the mother of the three oldest children.

The Van Vliets were at Wiltwyck [later called Kingston] by June 5, 1663. His daughter was captured by the Indians at the time of the burning of Wiltwyck (now Kingston) in 1663.

In 1680 he purchased 46 acres of land in the town of Marbletown, and later on ventured farther into the wilderness and took land grants with others in the vicinity of Rochester, Ulster Co., where he acquired considerable property.¹

In his will, he wrote: In the name of God Amen I Dirck Van Fliet of Lower Smithfield Township in the County of Northampton and in the Province of Pennsylvania, Farmer being at this time somewhat infirm in body but of sound and well disposing mind and memory...mentioned first born son Dirck the sum of Three Pounds Lawfull money of Pennsylvania for his birthright and I do give and Bequeath unto my son Dirck and my daughter Geertje the sum of Twenty Pounds money aforesaid to be equally divided between them share and share alike. And I do give and Bequeath unto my other children Namely Marytje, Judith, Anna-Catrina, Tirck Vankeuren, Jenneke, Elisabeth, Rachel, Lidia, Joseph and Cornelia the sum of one hundred and fourteen Pounds money aforesaid to be equally divided among them share and share alike. And I do further give and Bequeath unto my daughter Geertje the sum of Twelve Pounds money aforesaid being in the whole Twenty Two Pounds in full for her share or other Expectancy out of my Estate and I give and Bequeath unto my Dear wife Rachel Two Beds and bedsteads with all their appurtenances and further do I give and Bequeath all and Singular my goods and chattels and all my Lands, Tenements and Hereditaments and all my Estate Real and personal whatsoever and wheresoever unto my other Eleven Children namely Dirck, Marytje, Judith, Anna Catrina, Tirck Vankeuren, Jenneke, Elisabeth, Rachel, Lidia, Joseph and Cornelia to be equally divided among them share and share alike by my Executors after my just Debts, funeral charges, Legacies and Sums of Money be Duly paid ant it my will and desire that my Executors herein after named pay all Legacies unto my children and all debts and charges against my Estate within twelve months after my decease except to those of my children which shall be under age whose Legacies shall be put out at interest by my Executors on good Securities for the Benefit and at the Risque of my said children they accounting their expenses and reasonable charges in and about their Trust from time to time and in case any of my said children shall dye under age and without issue then it is my express will and desire that his her or their share be equally divided among the rest of them surviving children or their heirs. And further it is my express will and desire that my last named eleven children shall pay the sum of sixteen pounds unto my Dear wife Rachel towards her maintenance yearly and every year after my decease to be equally paid by my said children upon demand share and share alike. Provided always and it is my express mind and desire that my said wife Rachel do make her Last Will and Testament in writing of and concerning all the estate she shall be possessed of at the time of her decease and thereby Bequeath the same to my said children share and share alike....Appoint my son Dick and Daniel Depew Jun. of Walpack Township in the County of Susan and Province of New Jersey to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby Revoke, Annul, and Disallow all other Wills and Testaments in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy four--1774.
